We have still not received anything new from the State Department and, with Monday a holiday, the earliest we will get a paper to comment on will be Tuesday. I, therefore, am sending the attached reworked version of the original State paper which I thought might be helpful in preparing your final document.

We have tried to keep as much of State's original language as possible. The sections marked in red are the new language. We have replaced the old sections five and six with a new section five, keeping as much of the old language as possible but adding issues of primary importance to Treasury.
