Jeff MacNelly's last cartoon

On the editorial pages of most major newspapers across the country, syndicated cartoonists come and go. At The Plain Dealer, for instance, we complement the work of our staff editorial cartoonist, Ray Osrin, with the work of five syndicated editorial cartoonists from other newspapers.

But none has had the effect of Jeff MacNelly, the editorial cartoonist from Richmond, Va. Simply put, MacNelly has been the best editorial cartoonist in the United States. And most of the young cartoonists today copy the style of MacNelly. At 34, he has won two Pulitzer prizes.

It is with a sense of sadness that we note MacNelly's decision this week to stop drawing his cartoons and to devote his time to his comic strip, "Shoe," and to other ventures. We still have a few MacNelly cartoons in our files for future use, but the cartoon above is the last one MacNelly drew for the Richmond News Leader.

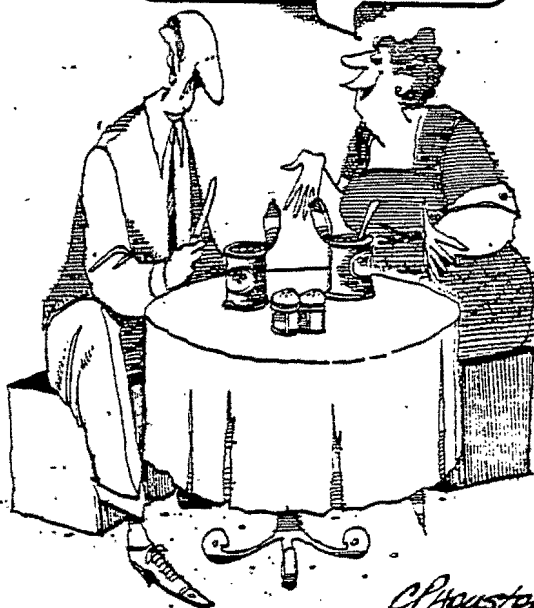
