The San Francisco Consular Corps is the second largest in the world and California has more consulates than any other state. The presence of these consulates in California serves to expedite the flow of international trade and commerce, a large factor in California's prosperity. The jurisdiction of most consulates covers the entire western United States. Exporters in most other states do not enjoy the advantage of having a consulate immediately available. It might be appropriate to emphasize the importance of international trade in California's total economy and therefore the function of foreign consuls in facilitating the flow of such trade.

Many of the consuls stationed in California have been ambassadors in other countries, and many of those who leave San Francisco go to embassies in other parts of the world. As a matter of fact, some of the consulates in this area have larger staffs than many embassies in other parts of the world.
