
It is my understanding that the budget for the California Rural Legal Assistance Program will soon be coming before you for review. I strongly urge you to veto the use of State funds for this program.



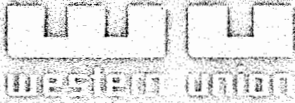

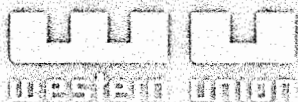
