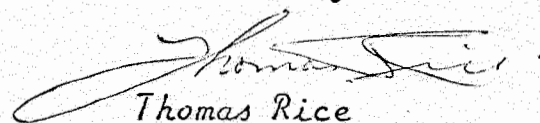
I urge you to withhold distribution of the funds for the Office of Economic Opportunity that is now up for consideration.

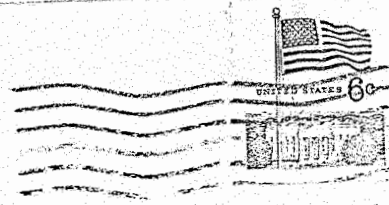

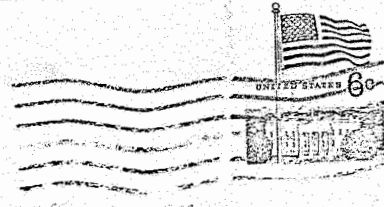

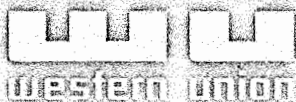
