California Rural Legal Assistance, one of the nation's largest and most controversial legal service agencies, will receive a \$1.8 million grant to operate in 1971.

The grant was announced in Washington by Donald F. Rumsfeld, director of the Office of Economic Opportunity.

In announcing the grant, the poverty agency said the CRLA is "commonly recognized as one of the best legal services programs in the country."

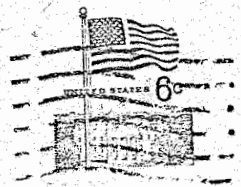
The CRLA often has aroused the anger of Gov. Reagan, who has charged that the agency uses federal funds to pursue court actions against various government agencies.

The CRLA was formed in 1966 by James D. Lorenz Jr., a young Harvard lawyer. After receiving the largest legal aid grant ever awarded by the OEO, the program became a

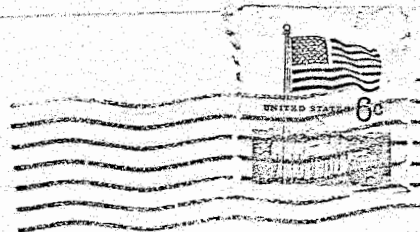

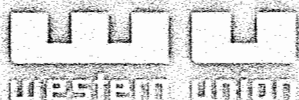

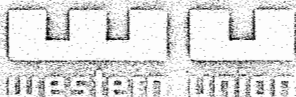
