Space Commercialization

Pursuant to the Economic Policy Council memorandum of February 9, 1988, the President has included in his Space Commercialization Initiative a directive for NASA to begin the process for contracting for microgravity services in a private space facility on an accelerated basis, with a mid-summer target for awarding a contract. This facility should be available by the end of FY 1993.
