PARTICIPANTS: THE PRESIDENT (BRIEFLY), DONALD T. REGAN, JOHN POINDEXTER, LARRY SPEAKES, DENNIS THOMAS, PATRICK BUCHANAN, THOMAS DAWSON, JAMES HOOLEY.

TOPIC: PROPOSED MEETING OF PRESIDENT REAGAN AND GENERAL SECRETARY GORBACHEV IN ICELAND OCTOBER 11-12.

THE FOLLOWING POINTS WERE DISCUSSED AND AGREED UPON AND CONSTITUTE THE ESSENCE OF MEETING ABOARD AIR FORCE ONE:

REGAN, POINDEXTER TO CO-CHAIR ICELAND MEETING PLANNING GROUP.

THOMAS, KEEL TO CO-CHAIR WORKING GROUP.

POINDEXTER/KEEL HAS LEAD ON SUBSTANCE, REGAN/POINDEXTER HAVE LEAD ON FORM OF MEETINGS, ALL WORK ON PUBLIC RELATIONS ASPECTS AND COORDINATION.

ASSUME MINIMAL PARTICIPATION IN MEETINGS OTHER THAN TWO PRINCIPALS PER SPIRIT OF GORBACHEV LETTER. QUESTIONS REMAIN AS TO OTHER CONCURRENT MEETINGS, EXPANDED MEETINGS, ETC.

STAFF/ADVISOR PARTICIPATION TO BE LIMITED, DUE TO SPIRIT AND INTENT OF MEETINGS AS WELL AS LOGISTICAL PROBLEMS, PER REGAN.

THEME OF MEETINGS TO BE FRAMING AGENDA FOR A SUMMIT IN U.S.; DEFINITE DESIRE FOR LOW EXPECTATIONS/SPECULATION; PRESIDENT HOPES TO RESULT IN SUMMIT DATE, NO AGREEMENT OR SUBSTANTIVE RESULTS LIKELY; THEREFORE, NEED TO LOWER EXPECTATIONS BY MEDIA, AND TO LOW-KEY SPECULATION BY WHITE HOUSE STAFF, STATE OFFICIALS, ETC. IN MEDIA.

DESIRABLE TO HAVE RIGHT PEOPLE SAYING RIGHT THINGS ON SUNDAY NETWORK SHOWS ON NOV. 5 AND NOV. 12: SHULTZ? POINDEXTER? MACFARLANE? KISSINGER?

REGAN, POINDEXTER TO CO-CHAIR ICELAND MEETING PLANNING GROUP.

THOMAS, KEEL TO CO-CHAIR WORKING GROUP.

POINDEXTER/KEEL HAS LEAD ON SUBSTANCE, REGAN/POINDEXTER HAVE LEAD ON FORM OF MEETINGS, ALL WORK ON PUBLIC RELATIONS ASPECTS AND COORDINATION.

ASSUME MINIMAL PARTICIPATION IN MEETINGS OTHER THAN TWO PRINCIPALS PER SPIRIT OF GORBACHEV LETTER. QUESTIONS REMAIN AS TO OTHER CONCURRENT MEETINGS, EXPANDED MEETINGS, ETC.

STAFF/ADVISOR PARTICIPATION TO BE LIMITED, DUE TO SPIRIT AND INTENT OF MEETINGS AS WELL AS LOGISTICAL PROBLEMS, PER REGAN.

THEME OF MEETINGS TO BE FRAMING AGENDA FOR A SUMMIT IN U.S.; DEFINITE DESIRE FOR LOW EXPECTATIONS/SPECULATION; PRESIDENT HOPES TO RESULT IN SUMMIT DATE, NO AGREEMENT OR SUBSTANTIVE RESULTS LIKELY; THEREFORE, NEED TO LOWER EXPECTATIONS BY MEDIA, AND TO LOW-KEY SPECULATION BY WHITE HOUSE STAFF, STATE OFFICIALS, ETC. IN MEDIA.

DESIRABLE TO HAVE RIGHT PEOPLE SAYING RIGHT THINGS ON SUNDAY NETWORK SHOWS ON NOV. 5 AND NOV. 12: SHULTZ? POINDEXTER? MACFARLANE? KISSINGER?

IMPORTANT ISSUE WAS AGREEMENT BY ALL TO NEWS BLACKOUT SIMILAR TO GENEVA DURING MEETINGS ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY. POINDEXTER WILL COORDINATE WITH SOVIET SIDE FOR SAME. AGREEMENT BY ALL ON VALUE IN GENEVA, ABSOLUTE NECESSITY IN ICELAND.
