I have reviewed Dr. Macdonald's Personal Data Statement and Financial Disclosure Report (SF-278) in connection with his position as Special Assistant to the President and Director, Drug Abuse Policy Office. Dr. Macdonald is also the Administrator of the Alcohol, Drug Abuse, and Mental Health Administration at the United States Department of Health and Human Services, a PAS position he assumed in July 1984.

Nothing reported in the referenced statements reveals any conflicts of interest or other difficulties with his position at the White House.

He is a member of the National American Red Cross Board of Governors, the American Red Cross Committee on Youth, Alcohol, and Drug Problems, and the American Bar Association's Advisory Commission on Youth Alcohol and Drug Problems. All of these memberships began after Dr. Macdonald was confirmed as ADAMHA Administrator. All are public service health oriented organizations. Dr. Macdonald's memberships are not inconsistent with his White House position. However, Dr. Macdonald should be careful not to give the appearance that the groups might receive preferential treatment.

It is my understanding that other members of Counsel's staff have researched the question of the propriety of Dr. Macdonald filling two positions and found it to be acceptable. I also understand that Dr. Macdonald is receiving only one salary for the two positions.

Accordingly, no conflicts or other difficulties appearing in Dr. Macdonald's disclosures, I am returning the materials to you for further processing. I have signed the SF-278 as Deputy Ethics Official.
