Chiefs of Mission, Ambassadors at Large and Ministers

Each individual nominated by the President to be a chief of mission, ambassador at large, or minister shall, at the time of nomination, file with the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a report of contributions made by such individual and by members of his or her immediate family during the period beginning on the first day of the fourth calendar year preceding the calendar year of the nomination and ending on the date of the nomination. The report shall be verified by the oath of the nominee, taken before any individual authorized to administer oaths. chairman of the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate shall have each such report printed in the Congressional Record. As used in this paragraph, the term "contribution" has the same meaning given such term by section 431(8) of title 2, and the term "immediate family" means the spouse of the nominee, and any child, parent, grandparent, brother, or sister of the nominee and the spouses of any of them. (22 U.S.C. 3944(b)(2).

The term "contribution" includes -- (i) any gift, subscription, loan, advance, or deposit of money or anything of value made by any person for the purpose of influencing any election for Federal office; or

(ii) the payment by any person of compensation for the personal services of another person which are rendered to a political committee without charge for any purpose. (2 U.S.C. 431(8)(A).

# GSA chief denies alleged lunch ploy

General Services Administrator Gerald Carmen denied yesterday that he had instructed one of his top aides to take a GSA whistleblower, Bert Berube, out to lunch on May 19, 1983, and not to bring him back for three hours.

The aide testified to the contrary last week.

Mr. Berube, who was fired by Mr. Carmen at the end of last year, claims the aide was instructed to take him to lunch for the purpose of getting him drunk. The scheme, according to Mr. Berube, was that he would either come back to a scheduled news conference and be discredited, or that he would be unprepared for the news conference.

The purpose of the news conference apparently was for Mr. Carmen to assure the public that GSA was doing the best it could on maintenance of federal buildings, and that Mr. Berube's report—which had been leaked to the press

a few days earlier and which stated that because of budget cuts and lack of trained personnel hundreds of federal buildings were badly in need of repair — was an exaggeration.

Mr. Carmen, who was on the witness stand all day yesterday at a hearing of the Merit Systems Protection Board, said he had never instructed his aide. Steven Hammer, to take Mr. Berube to lunch.

Mr. Hammer testified last week that he had been directed by Mr. Carmen to take Mr. Berube to lunch and not to return for three hours.

Mr. Carmen says Mr. Berube's lawyer, Jerry Shaw, tried to blackmail him by proposing to Mr. Carmen that if Mr. Berube were restored to his former position as head of GSA's National Capital Region, Mr. Berube would not continue to say publicly that federal buildings were in a state of perennial disrepair.

Mr. Berube and Mr. Shaw deny the accusation of blackmail.

The President today announced his intention to nominate Gerald P. Carmen, of New Hampshire, as the Representative of the United States of America to the European Office of the United Nations, with the rank of Ambassador. He would succeed Geoffrey Swaebe who is now Ambassador to Belgium.

Mr. Carmen was with Carmen Automotive, Inc., in Manchester, New Hampshire in 1944-1959 beginning as stock clerk and advancing to vice president. In 1959-1979 he was the Owner of Car-Go Home and Auto Centers, Inc., and in 1979-1982 was in consulting and real estate with Mach I, Inc., in Manchester. In 1980 he served as Transition Team Leader at the Department of Housing and Urban Development in Washington, D.C., and since 1981 has been Administrator of the General Services Administration.

Mr. Carmen received his B.A. in 1952 from the University of New Hampshire. He is married, has two children and resides in Washington, D.C. He was born July 8, 1930 in Quincy, Massachusetts.
