Dear Sonator Glenn:

Your communication transmitting a letter from Rouben Embroa has been referred to me. Mr. Embroa in again requesting a Pederal investigation of what he feels are discrepancies in the plotting of certain property on county tax maps.

As you may have noted, Mr. Embrac's allegations have been reviewed in the White House, the office of the Vice President, the United States Attorney's office, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the Criminal Division of the Department of Justice Without finding any basis for a Federal investigation. Such an investigation may be undertaken only when there is evidence that a violation of Federal law has occurred, and it is the unanimous view of all who have reviewed his allegations that no such violation exists.

A private attorney can advise Mr. Embree and the citizens who have signed his patition what civil remedies may be available to them. The courts provide the appropriate forum for litigating Mr. Embree's claims that his constitutional rights have been in some way denied. Again, a private attorney can best advise him.

I am sorry, but there does not appear to be any way in which the Pracutive Branch of the Federal Covernment may appropriately be of assistance to Nr. Embree. Your enclosures are returned as requested.

This is an open, certified, restricted delivery letter to Ronald Reagan, the President of the United States. Whoever signs must assume the responsibility for its delivery to President Reagan. 191936

After four years fighting a cover-up, I am tired of trying to get a federal investigator sent to Lincoln County, Oregon. Mr. President, I am sure you are not involved, but every ruse in the book is being used to keep you from being informed of deliberate violations of the fifth and fourteenth constitutional amendments, which were committed by public officials.

On behalf of the signers on the enclosed petition, I am asking you to personally send a trusted federal investigator to Lincoln County, Oregon. He must protect witnesses, lawyers and the plaintiff's from intimidation and harm.

One of several cases is to have an investigation of an Oregon State Board of Engineering Examiners Report, which was made and sent to the Governor of Orego at the Governor's request.

It has been deliberately falsified. The reasons for the cover-up will be easy to understand, if the investigation is made in an open and honest manner. It is important to let the voters know about their public officials, and how well they can PERFORM in a cover-up.

We have documented evidence for indictments and are sure a thorough investigation will produce several more.

I will be sending copies of this letter to the media in the hopes of finding someone who is more interested in honest government and constitutional rights, than trying to protect their political cronies.



Dear Senator Glenn:

On behalf of one hundred thirty signers of a petition asking for a federal investigation involving public officials, I am asking you to personally contact President Reagan. Several state and federal laws have been broken and the violations are varied.

The county and state governments have refused to investigate the problems, and a cover-up has prevented letters from being delivered to U. S. Attorney General Smith, Vice-President Bush or President Reagan.

One hundred sixteen certified letters have been written to various agencies, officials, newsmen and others. These letters have not produced results.

The cover-up started before a property dispute report made by the Oregon State Board of Engineering Examiners was sent to the Governor of Oregon. There is documented evidence proving this report had been deliberately falsified.

When this was brought to the Governor's attention, he stated by letter that he was satisfied with the report. He did not answer my certified letter asking for an investigation of the falsified records.

Several Senators and Representatives failed to answer certified letters, others evaded the issues. Not one Congressman would contact the President on our behalf in order to have a federal investigator sent to Lincoln County.

To protect witnesses from possible intimidation, it is best that the investigator be from some area other than Oregon. This is a small part of the problems in Lincoln County.
