Dear Mr shaheen,

I hope by now you have had time to initiate an individual investigation into the travesty of Justice which I was the target of by the U.S. Attorney in the Western District of Pennsylvania.

Since I was sent to see you by John Roberts of the White House I feel the truth will now surface and the people involved will be dealt with appropriately and the crime will not be swept under a convenient carpet.

I have taken the precaution of delivering a set of documents, such as the ones you received, to three U.S. Senators and one U.S. Congressman in order to observe your progress while not getting involved as I feel any involvement other than yours at this time would be out of order.

Your work load may be heavy but when a citizen has been the subject of prosecutorial misconduct such as was carried out in this case I think your instant action is needed as the situation is now "out of control" and those with the power could do anything needed to try to protect themselves.

If I believed the situation came about without evil minds being involved in the strategy I would not be as intent in my desire to have you act immediately. Awaiting your response I remain.
