Re: Communications with Federal Republic of Germany Regarding Hamadei Case

Dear Ambassador Adams:

Pursuant to your request of July 2, 1987, we are providing a written description of the channels of communication which the Department of Justice believes should be used in the Hamadei case.

The information and material which the German prosecution team will need during the ensuing months is in the hands of the Department of Justice and the FBI. They are materials which we have gathered during our two year-long investigation of the case. As we stated during our meeting, experience demonstrates that the German prosecutors, although obviously conversant with their own law and their own evidentiary needs, are not necessarily familiar with U.S. investigative methods, and certainly do not know what evidence is in our files or the form it takes. Thus, extensive communication will be necessary in order for us to understand what the German prosecutors need and to explore methods by which we can make our evidence "fit" those needs within a time frame which will cause minimal delay (or, hopefully, no delay) in the Germans' efforts to bring Hamadei to justice. Indeed, even in ordinary cases there are frequent direct contacts between the Department of Justice and German prosecutors or the Federal Ministry of Justice. 1/

^{1/} The assistance of the Embassy has been obtained to facilitate such contacts.

As a result of the foregoing, we believe and propose that Department of Justice prosecutors in the Criminal Division in Washington should maintain direct contact (telephonic, secure telephonic, and face-to-face) with the State of Hesse prosecutors who have responsibility for the prosecution of Hamadei. As you know, to date we have had two such contacts which have been very fruitful in terms of avoiding delays and understanding the Germans' needs. The German prosecutors should be instructed to make all of their requests for information or material (and access to witnesses) directly to the Department of Justice. We do not anticipate that the Department of Justice would be in contact with Federal Republic of Germany federal authorities until such time (if ever) as those authorities assume prosecutorial responsibilities.

Department of Justice prosecutors 2/ would discuss evidentiary/ legal needs with the German prosecutors and, with the FBI, would respond to those needs expeditiously and to the maximum extent possible. The FBI Legat in Bonn will serve as a facilitator when and if necessary. He will not have day-to-day responsibilities in this matter.

The Department of Justice prosecutor would memorialize (by dictation) all such contacts and immediately advise an appointed individual at the Department of State (in Washington) and an appointed individual at the FBI. Those entities would then communicate information concerning the contact, as they deem appropriate, to their other components. We envision that, at a minimum, the Department of State would cable its Embassy in Bonn and the FBI would cable its Legat in Bonn. State would transmit via Exdis Cedar channel and the FBI would cable via Legat channel. These two channels would be expanded for these communications so that the Department of State would receive Legat channel communications and the FBI would receive Exdis Cedar. 3/

Similarly, Embassy Bonn would send cables to the Department of State promptly reporting the results of its contacts with the Federal Republic of Germany authorities. 4/ Embassy Bonn would, of course, maintain its role as political and diplomatic arm of the United States government. In this regard, Department of Justice prosecutors would recognize issues, requests,

or questions posed by the German prosecutors which have any political overtones and would report them to the Department of State so that an appropriate response could be formulated, after consultation with other involved U.S. agencies. We would err on the side of caution in our recognition of political matters or issues which could evolve into political matters and thus would not provide a substantive response to them. For example, issues concerning Germany's fulfillment of its international legal obligations, the timeliness and vigor of the German investigation and prosecution, and the United States' reaction (public or private) to the Germans' prosecutive efforts are all matters to be addressed by the Department of State after consultation with other interested U.S. agencies.

Since the proposed channels of communication do not anticipate the involvement of Department of Justice prosecutors in "federal-federal" contacts (because contact with federal level German officials would be reserved to the Embassy), the role of the Embassy is obvious, to wit, to continue to encourage the Federal Republic of Germany to effectively and quickly bring Hamadei to justice. The fact that the Department of Justice will have direct contact with the prosecutors, and the Embassy will continue its diplomatic contacts with federal officials, will give the United States a "cross-check" system, i.e., we will be able to compare the observations which we make on the state level with those we make on the federal level.

We believe that this system will satisfy the interests of all U.S. agencies and will be most effective in ensuring that Hamadei is swiftly brought to justice.

BEIRUT, LEBANON (AP) SEVEN GUNMEN SEIZED A WEST GERMAN IN SYRIAN-POLICED WEST BEIRUT ON WEDNESDAY. A RADIO REPORT SAID A SHIITE MOSLEM MILITIA LEADER ORDERED THE ABDUCTION TO PRESSURE WEST GERMANY INTO FREEING HIS TWO JAILED BROTHERS.

THE KIDNAPPING OCCURRED AS MOHAMMED HAMADI, ACCUSED IN A TWA HIJACKING, TOOK THE STAND IN THE DUESSELDORF TRIAL OF BROTHER ABBAS HAMADI, WHO ALLEGEDLY ABDUCTED TWO WEST GERMANS IN BEIRUT LAST YEAR IN A BID TO FREE HIM.

THE THIRD BROTHER, ABDUL-HADI HAMADI, HEADS THE SECURITY APPARATUS OF HEZBOLLAH, THE MOST MILITANT PRO-IRANIAN FACTION IN LEBANON.

RALPH RUDOLF SCHRAY, 30, WAS GRABBED AS HE WALKED ACROSS A SIDE STREET OFF THE HAMRA COMMERCIAL THOROUGHFARE AT 11:05 A.M., SAID A POLICE SPOKESMAN, WHO BY REGULATION CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED.

THE STOCKY, BLOND SCHRAY WORKS FOR AN ENGINEERING COMPANY AND HAS LIVED IN LEBANON FOR MOST OF HIS LIFE. POLICE SAID THE KIDNAPPERS HAD CALLED SCHRAY'S PALESTINIAN UNCLE, BUT MADE NO DEMANDS. THE UNCLE REFUSED TO TALK TO REPORTERS.

''THE KIDNAPPERS DID NOT STATE ANY DEMANDS,'' THE POLICE SPOKESMAN SAID, ADDING THAT IT WAS NOT CLEAR WHO THEY WERE.

HOWEVER, A HIGH-RANKING OFFICIAL WITH ABDUL-HADI HAMADI'S MILITIA INFORMED A RELATIVE OF SCHRAY THAT ABDUL-HADI ORDERED THE ABDUCTION ''TO PUT PRESSURE ON BONN SO THAT IT WOULD RELEASE HIS TWO JAILED BROTHERS,'' THE CHRISTIAN-RUN VOICE OF LEBANON QUOTED THE RELATIVE AS SAYING. IT DID NOT NAME THE RELATIVE.

EARLIER, THE JUDGE IN THE HAMADI TRIAL WARNED THAT IF THE SCHRAY KIDNAPPING WERE LINKED TO THE PROCEEDINGS, 'IT COULD MAKE THE SITUATION TOUGHER HERE.''

THE UNITED STATES CONDEMNED SCHRAY'S KIDNAPPING AND CALLED FOR RELEASE OF ALL HOSTAGES HELD IN LEBANON.

'THE CONTINUED DETENTION OF THESE PEOPLE BRINGS NO SYMPATHY OR HONOR TO WHATEVER CAUSE THE CAPTORS PROFESS TO ESPOUSE,'' SAID STATE DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN CHARLES REDMAN IN WASHINGTON.

SCHRAY WAS THE FIRST FOREIGNER ABDUCTED IN MOSLEM WEST BEIRUT SINCE JUNE. HIS KIDNAPPING BRINGS TO 22 THE NUMBER OF FOREIGNERS HELD HOSTAGE IN LEBANON. ONE OTHER WEST GERMAN IS A CAPTIVE, AND HIS ABDUCTORS HAVE DEMANDED THE RELEASE OF MOHAMMED AND ABBAS HAMADI.

SHRAY'S KIDNAPPERS WERE IN THREE CARS AND SOME WORE POLICE UNIFORMS, THE POLICE SPOKESMAN SAID, ADDING THAT THEY ''PUSHED SCHRAY INTO ONE OF THEIR CARS AT GUNPOINT AND SPED OFF.''

WITNESSES SAID SCHRAY LATER LEAPED OUT OF THE CAR WHEN IT WAS SLOWED BY TRAFFIC, BUT WAS GRABBED BY ONE OF THE GUNMEN AND FORCED BACK INTO THE AUTO.

''I HOPE HE'LL BE RELEASED SOON,'' SCHRAY'S LEBANESE WIFE, RANA MOUNLA, TOLD REPORTERS, HER EYES BRIMMING WITH TEARS.

''RALPH NEVER CONSIDERED HIMSELF A GERMAN. HE HARDLY SPEAKS A FEW WORDS OF GERMAN,'' SHE SAID. 'HE ALWAYS CONSIDERED HIMSELF LEBANESE. HE DIDN'T PANIC WHEN VARIOUS WAVES OF FOREIGNERS' ABDUCTIONS HIT WEST BEIRUT. OTHERS FLED, BUT HE INSISTED ON STAYING.''

SCHRAY WAS BORN IN BEIRUT IN 1957 TO A WEST GERMAN FATHER AND A PALESTINIAN MOTHER, SAID A RELATIVE WHO SPOKE ON CONDITION OF ANONYMITY. BONN OFFICIALS SAID HE HAS A WEST GERMAN PASSPORT.

IN WEST GERMANY, MOHAMMED HAMADI, 23, REFUSED TO TESTIFY AT THE

TRIAL OF HIS 29-YEAR-OLD BROTHER ABBAS.

ABBAS HAMADI IS CHARGED WITH KIDNAPPING WEST GERMANS RUDOLF CORDES AND ALFRED SCHMIDT IN BEIRUT LESS THAN A WEEK AFTER HIS BROTHER'S JAN.

13, 1987 ARREST AT FRANKFURT AIRPORT.

SCHMIDT WAS RELEASED IN SEPTEMBER. CORDES REMAINS A CAPTIVE.
MOHAMMED HAMADI IS WANTED IN THE UNITED STATES ON CHARGES OF AIR
PIRACY AND MURDER IN THE 1985 HIJACKING OF A TWA JETLINER TO BEIRUT.
THIRTY-NINE AMERICANS WERE HELD HOSTAGE AND A U.S. NAVY DIVER WAS
KILLED IN THE 17-DAY ORDEAL.

IN FRANKFURT ON WEDNESDAY, WEST GERMAN FOREIGN MINISTER HANS-DIETRICH GENSCHER MET WITH AND ASKED HIS IRANIAN COUNTERPART TO USE ''ALL HIS INFLUENCE'' TO WIN THE RELEASE OF CORDES AND SCHRAY, THE FOREIGN MINISTRY SAID.

IT ADDED THAT THE IRANIAN FOREIGN MINISTER, ALI AKBAR VELAYATI, "PLEDGED TO DO WHAT HE COULD WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF HIS POSSIBILITIES."

KHALIL DEEB, A SYRIAN JANITOR OF A NEARBY APARTMENT BUILDING, SAID THERE WERE FIVE ABDUCTORS IN TWO CARS INVOLVED IN WEDNESDAY'S ABDUCTION. HE SAID SCHRAY WAS PUSHED INTO A MERCEDES AND 'REPEATEDLY SCREAMED THROUGH THE WINDOW AND THE KIDNAPPERS KEPT PUSHING HIS HEAD DOWN.''

WEDNESDAY'S ABDUCTION WAS THE SECOND KIDNAPPING NEAR A SYRIAN ARMY CHECKPOINT SINCE DAMASCUS DEPLOYED 7,500 TROOPS IN BEIRUT 11 MONTHS AGO TO HALT MILITIA FIGHTING. THE FIRST WAS U.S. JOURNALIST CHARLES GLASS, WHO WAS ABDUCTED ON BEIRUT'S SOUTHERN EDGE JUNE 17. HE GAINED FREEDOM AUG. 18.

A GROUP CALLING ITSELF HOLY WARRIORS FOR FREEDOM CLAIMED JULY 8 IT WAS HOLDING CORDES, 53, AND SCHMIDT. SCHMIDT WAS FREED SEPT. 7, AND THE GROUP SAID HIS RELEASE WAS INTENDED AS A GOODWILL GESTURE AIMED AT WINNING THE FREEDOM OF THE HAMADI BROTHERS.

AMONG THE FOREIGN HOSTAGES IN LEBANON ARE ANGLICAN CHURCH ENVOY TERRY WAITE, WHO VANISHED LAST JANUARY DURING A MISSION TO MEDIATE WITH THE KIDNAPPERS, AND EIGHT AMERICANS. THE HOSTAGE HELD THE LONGEST IS TERRY ANDERSON, CHIEF MIDDLE EAST CORRESPONDENT FOR THE ASSOCIATED PRESS, WHO WAS ABDUCTED IN WEST BEIRUT ON MARCH 16, 1985. AP-NY-01-28-88 0052EST=

ON WEDNESDAY, JUDGE AREND TOLD THE COURT TRYING ABBAS HAMADI, ''IF THE SAME CIRCLE OF KIDNAPPERS (AS ARE UNDER DISCUSSION AT THE DUESSELDORF TRIAL) IS INVOLVED (IN SCHRAY'S ABDUCTION), IT COULD MAKE THE SITUATION TOUGHER HERE AND LEAD TO THE OPPOSITE EFFECT OF WHAT COULD HAVE BEEN POSSIBLE AT THIS TRIAL.'' HE APPEARED TO BE WARNING THAT FURTHER KIDNAPPINGS WOULD NOT FORCE WEST GERMAN AUTHORITIES TO ADOPT A MORE LENIENT STANCE TOWARD TERRORIST SUSPECTS

MOHAMMED HAMADI TOOK THE WITNESS STAND WEDNESDAY AND RAISED HIS FISTS DEFIANTLY AFTER REFUSING TO TESTIFY. UNDER WEST GERMAN LAW, RELATIVES OF DEFENDANTS CANNOT BE FORCED TO TESTIFY.

HE IS WANTED IN THE UNITED STATES FOR THE JUNE 1985 HIJACKING OF A TWA JETLINER TO BEIRUT IN WHICH U.S. NAVY DIVER ROBERT STETHEM WAS KILLED AND 39 AMERICANS WERE HELD HOSTAGE FOR 17 DAYS.

ABBAS HAMADI, 29, IS ACCUSED OF ARRANGING THE KIDNAPPINGS OF WEST GERMANS ALFRED SCHMIDT AND RUDOLF CORDES IN BEIRUT LAST JANUARY IN AN ATTEMPT TO GAIN THE RELEASE OF HIS BROTHER.

SCHMIDT WAS RELEASED IN SEPTEMBER. CORDES IS STILL IN CAPTIVITY. WEST GERMANY REJECTED A U.S. REQUEST FOR MOHAMMED HAMADI'S EXTRADITION AND SAID HE WOULD BE TRIED IN A WEST GERMAN COURT INSTEAD.

ABBAS HAMADI'S TRIAL HAS BEEN ADJOURNED UNTIL NEXT WEEK. THE ADJOURNMENT WAS UNRELATED TO THE KIDNAPPING OF SCHRAY. AP-NY-01-28-88 0106EST=

SUBJECT: "FIGHTERS FOR FREEDOM" ORGANIZATION ISSUES COMMUNIQUE

FOLLOWING IS AN UNOFFICIAL EMBASSY TRANSLATION OF A COMMUNIQUE FROM THE "FIGHTERS FOR FREEDOM" ORGANIZATION WHICH APPEARED IN MARCH 3 ISSUE OF AN-NAHAR. NEWS OF SCHRAY'S RELEASE WAS REPORTED IN BEIRUT MID-MORNING MARCH 3.

BEGIN TEXT:

IN THE NAME OF THE LORD OF THE FREEDOM FIGHTERS. BETWEEN ADVICE AND WARNING...BETWEEN ALERTING AND THREATENING...BETWEEN THE DESIRE FOR A DIALOGUE AND YEARNING FOR THE USE OF FORCES THE GERMAN HOSTAGE RALPH SHRAY IS BEING HOSTED TO TRY TO GET AT THE FACTS... AND SO THEY WOULD UNDERSTAND WHAT SO FAR THEY HAVE NOT UNDERSTOOD BY OTHER MEANS (...) IT SEEMS WE ARE STILL AT THE BEGINNING OF THE ROAD AND THERE IS, APPARENTLY SOME DETERMINATION BY THE OFFICIALS OF GERMANY TO PROLONG THE STORY. HOWEVER, WE ARE SURE AND WE PROMISE THAT, IF IT TAKES ANY LONGER, THIS PATH WILL BE VERY DIFFICULT AND TERRIFYING FOR THE OTHER PARTY AND THE STORY WILL BE EXTREMELY TRAGIC AS WELL.

WHILE WE VIE WITH THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT IN TREATING THE SUBJECT OF THE HOSTAGES AND THE HAMADI BROTHERS, THE MEDIATION OF FRIENDS IN SYRIA AND IN THE PERSON OF PRESIDENT ASSAD COME ALONG TO GIVE A NEW CHANCE WITH A NEW ROUND OF COMMITMENTS AND PROMISES. THIS MADE THE ISSUE OF SHRAY MAKE ITS WAY TO A SOLUTION DURING THE COMING HOURS IF THE CONDITIONS OF THIS ROUND ARE COMPLETED.

WE MUST DRAW ATTENTION TO FUNDAMENTAL ISSUES THAT MUST BE CAUTIONED ABOUT:

FIRST: THE HAMADI BROTHERS ARE STILL IN GERMANY AND THE RELEASE IS THE INITIATIVE NUMBER 2. (COMMENT: PRESUMABLY SHRAY'S RELEASE WOULD BE THE SECOND INITIATIVE BY THE KIDNAPPERS. END COMMENT.) MANY FACTORS HAVE ACCUMULATED AND LED TO A PEACEFUL ENDING KNOWING THAT THIS COMMUNIQUE WAS DEDICATED TO ANNOUNCING THE DEATH OF SHRAY AND SENDING HIM LOADED TO THE

CHANCELLOR (HELMUT) KOHL AND (WEST GERMAN FOREIGN MINISTER) MR. GENSCHER. ALL THE WAGERING ON A CHANGE OF CIRCUMSTANCES AND THE POSSIBILITY OF EXERTING PRESSURE ON US AND RESTRICTING OUR MOVES IS NOT ONLY NOTHING, BUT ON OUR PART, WILL ALSO LEAD IN THE FUTURE TO A SETTLEMENT OF THE CORDES CASE. WE CHALLENGE GERMANY TO HURT THE HAMADI BROTHERS.

SECOND: WE ARE PRACTICING A LEGAL RIGHT FOR A STRUGGLE AGAINST AMERICA. BROTHER MOHAMMED HAMADI IS ONE OF THE FREEDOM FIGHTERS IN THIS PATH. HE SHOULD BE TREATED WELL AND RELEASED. IF THIS ROUND WAS USELESS, WE AFFIRM THAT GERMANY WILL COMPLY BY FORCE. THEREFORE, THIS CHANCE MUST BE USED.

THIRD: WE ARE STARTING TO APPROACH A NEW SITUATION WHICH WILL DETERMINE THE KIND OF REACTION WE SHALL HAVE. WE REMIND THAT WE NOW HAVE A SET OF GERMAN TARGET THAT WILL PROBABLY BE STRUCK. WE ALSO HAVE AN ARM EXTENDED FOR DIALOGUE.

FINALLY, WE APPEAL TO CHANCELLOR KOHL AND GENSCHER TO CONSIDER, TO RESPECT WHAT HAD BEEN AGREED UPON AND TO MAKE USE OF THE NEW CHANCE FOR A SOLUTION NOT PROCRASTINATION.
