Back from Europe, I found your letter of December 17th kindly thanking me for the book I had sent you to wish you a happy 1983. Minutes later, I found the same book returned to me with a second letter informing me that you could not accept it because of the White House rules.

In Europe, alas, it is not. We Europeans do not consider books as vehicles of corruption attempts. On the contrary, we consider them as an intellectual exchange and an intellectual tribute to those who keep culture and good taste in high respect.

Thanks anyway for an experience which, though negative, has enriched my knowledge as a writer, as a journalist, as a civilized person. Someday I should write about it.
