PRESIDENTIAL REMARKS: WHITE HOUSE CORRESPONDENTS DINNER
SATURDAY, APRIL 23, 1983

Nancy, just think, we could have been at Camp David.

Well, from the looks of this crowd I can put away my
evangelical speech.

As you may know, for the Gridiron Dinner I sang. For this
crowd I think I'll just juggle.

I won't say this evening has been long, but why do we have
to wait 'til midnight to turn the clocks ahead?

Of course, we all know the Correspondents dinner is a very
special occassion. It's for all those who can't get tickets to
the Gridiron.

As we say in Hollywood, welcome to the Son of Gridiron, Part
II.

The Correspondent's dinner isn't as prestigious as the
Gridiron. The Soviets didn't even send an Ambassador.

They do have a representative her tonight disguised as a
chair.

Do you know how I can tell the Correspondent's dinner lacks the class of the Gridiron? I've been here over an hour and not one person has asked me to sing. . . . no applause please.

John Glenn sure surprised everyone at the Gridiron Dinner. He showed up.

A lot of us were shocked at how funny John was . . . considering he didn't even have to read any of his campaign promises.

Some people feel it isn't dignified for the President of the United States to be telling jokes. I figure I can tell them. For the past 50 years the Congress has been passing them.

Baker, Deaver, and Meese urged me not to sing at the Gridiron Dinner. They said the President should not make a fool of himself. That's why there's a Secretary of the Interior.

Richard Strout has been reporting for over 62 years. He is the only person here tonight who knows the true identity of Deep Throat from the Teapot Dome scandal.

For 40 years Dick Strout has written a column under the title TRB. Sometimes I wish I'd made a few of my movies under an alias.

I'll tell you what's so frightening about Dick Strout's longevity. Can you imagine putting up with Sam Donaldson for 62 years?

That's enough to even turn my hair gray.

I'm often asked how I remain calm under tough questioning from Donaldson. I just pretend he's Woodruff.

Is Al Hunt here tonight? Don't you think he looks like Tip O'Neill's grandson?

Former President Nixon no longer admits the press when he's making a speech. At least I have something to look forward to.

They say I have a slight hearing problem. No wonder. You would too with Sam Donaldson yelling at you.

In fact, sometimes we bring Sam out on the South Lawn just to scare away the starlings.

My doctor says there's one thing that can improve my hearing at press conferences -- easier questions.

With my job, I have to watch the intellectual shows on TV -- McNeil Lehrer, William F. Buckley, Different Strokes.

I asked Nancy if the ratings were very good when she appeared on Different Strokes. She said, "Dear, they were eight points higher than your innauguration."

Maybe I should have chosen Gary Coleman instead of George Bush.

John Herrington, the White House efficiency expert, has been evaluating the jobs people have been doing . . . Jim Baker says I can stay anyway.

Learned the secret of the Deaver Diet. You only eat on days the senior staff get along.

I'm prepared to tell the truth about the Libyan hit squad now. The reason I gave Baker, Deaver, and Meese security was to protect them from one another.

It scared poor Ed Meese to death. He thought a terrorist group called the pragmatists were after him.

When I go out I seem to draw more and more protestors. In fact, I can't even go on the Mall anymore. Jim Watt says I attract the wrong kind of people.

If Jim Watt ever leaves Interior, he still has his other job to fall back on -- President of the Wayne Newton Fan Club.

Secretary Watt is not sitting here at the head table, but he is out there in the audience -- once again, a voice in the wilderness.

Politics is funny business. One day you're on top, the next day, well, you know that fellow in Pittsburgh who handed me a resume . . . that was Bert Lance.

The right wing really is going to be mad at me when they find out I'm in such good health because of The Jane Fonda Workout Book.

Many of you have wondered why I've spent so much time at my ranch just clearing brush and chopping wood. Well, can you imagine the Soviets' faces next time they develop their satellite photos and see the message, "Lennin's a schmuck."

Critics claim I twisted arms to get the confirmation of Kenneth Adelman. That's not true. I just told the leadership if I didn't get Adelman, I would appear on the floor of the Senate and sing . . . and sing . . . and sing.

It worked better than any write-in campaign I ever had.
