1. CONFIDENTIAL - ENTIRE TEXT.

2. DURING MR. DEAVER'S VISIT WE WILL ARRANGE AN APPOINT-MENT FOR HIM WITH MONS. ACHILLE SILVESTRINI WHO IS THE VATICAN'S DE FACTO FOREIGN MINISTER. SILVESTRINI UNDERSTANDS ENGLISH WELL AND SPEAKS IT FAIRLY WELL. THE MEETING SHOULD BE KEPT VERY SMALL. NO TRANSLATOR WILL BE NEEDED. MY ASSISTANT, MICHAEL HORNBLOW WILL BE THE NOTETAKER.

3. WE SUGGEST MR. DEAVER COVER THE FOLLOWING SUBJECTS DURING THE MEETING:

- (A) THE PRESIDENT'S CAREER AND PERSONALITY: THE POPE WILL WANT TO DEVELOP A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THE PRESIDENT. WE SUGGEST DEAVER BRING WITH HIM A BRIEF BIOGRAPHY OF THE PRESIDENT TO GIVE TO SILVESTRINI AND DESCRIBE THE PRESIDENT'S PERSONALITY TO SILVESTRINI.

- (B) ADVISE SILVESTRINI THAT DURING HIS AUDIENCE WITH THE POPE THE PRESIDENT MAY INVITE HIM TO VISIT THE WESTERN PART OF THE U.S.

MR. DEAVER SHOULD BE PREPARED TO ADVISE SILVESTRINI OF THE APPROXIMATE SIZE AND PROBABLE COMPOSITION OF THE PRESIDENTIAL DELEGATION.

(D) MR. DEAVER COULD ALSO RAISE WITH SILVESTRINI THE DESIRABILITY OF A CONCURRENT MEETING BETWEEN SECRETARY HAIG AND CARDINAL CASAROLI AND DESCRIBE WHO WOULD BE INCLUDED IN HAIG'S GROUP.

(E) FINALLY WE SUGGEST DEAVER REVIEW WITH SILVESTRINI THE PROBABLE SCHEDULE OF THE PRESIDENT IN ROME. SILVESTRINI WILL BE PARTICULARLY INTERESTED IN KNOWING OF THE PRESIDENT'S PLANS AFTER HE DEPARTS THE QUIRINALE AND AFTER HE LEAVES VATICAN CITY. WILSON
