MEETING WITH PRESIDENT MITTERRAND

TALKING POINTS

- WELCOME. Sorry you were not able to make it for a bilateral meeting in Washington with more time to talk. I have valued our correspondence, and hope we can keep in communication. Look forward to welcoming you for State visit next year.
- SUMMIT OBJECTIVES. I hope Williamsburg will send a unified signal of realistic optimism to the world, since we are so united on the essentials of Western values and economic objectives.
- DEVELOPING WORLD. Thank you for your message about Mrs. Gandhi. An intriguing idea, but I did not think it was quite appropriate to invite her here. We certainly want to talk about our relations with the developing world.
- INF. This evening at dinner we will talk about INF and other arms control issues. We certainly appreciate the strong support you have given to the two-track NATO decision. Only when they respect us will the Soviets deal with us.
- MITTERRAND'S PROPOSAL FOR A NEW BRETTON WOODS. George Shultz told me of your proposal for a future conference on the monetary system. Although this proposal may be premature, we certainly need to continue work on the international financial system.
