IN A CONVERSATION WHICH DCM HAD WITH ELYSEE FOREIGN AFFAIRS ADVISOR VEDRINE ON MARCH 31, IT WAS APPARENT THAT SHARP DIFFERENCES PERSIST BETWEEN THE QUAI AND THE ELYSEE OVER REGIS DEBRAY'S ABORTED TRIP TO CENTRAL AMERICA. VEDRINE INSISTED THAT HE (AND, HE THOUGHT, DEBRAY) HAD NOT BEEN INFORMED OF THE USG DECISION NOT TO RECEIVE DEBRAY AT THE END OF A CENTRAL AMERICAN TOUR (AS INDICATED IN PARA 7 OF PARIS 10984, WE LEFT THIS MESSAGE WITH THEIR -- SHARED -- SECRETARY LAST WEEK).
- 3. VEDRINE REACTED WITH SOME "PERSONAL" HEAT. HE SAID THOUGHT OUR DECISION NOT TO RECEIVE DEBRAY WAS "VERY FOOLISH" AND "SHORTSIGHTED". HE ADDED THAT IT PUT INTO QUESTION WHETHER THE FRENCH SHOULD MAKE A GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO INFORM US IN ADVANCE OF SUCH INITIATIVES. IN PASSING HE STATED THAT HE KNEW "CHEYSSON THINKS DIFFERENTLY ON THIS," BUT VEDRINE NEVERTHELESS FELT IT WAS AN UNFORTUNATE DECISION.

4. COMMENT: VEDRINE MADE IT CLEAR THAT HIS WAS A PERSONAL REACTION, BUT WE BELIEVE IT REFLECTS HIS (AND NO DOUBT DEBRAY'S) FRUSTRATION AT THE TURN THIS INCIDENT TOOK. IT ALSO UNDERSCORES THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE ELYSEE AND THE QUAI ON THIS KEY ISSUE.

- 2. DEFENSE MINISTER HERNU CALLED ME APRIL 2 TO SAY HE HAD SOMETHING CONFIDENTIAL TO TELL ME, AND ASKED IF HE COULD SEND HIS AIDE, FRANCOIS HEISBOURG, OVER TO GIVE ME THE MESSAGE.
- 3. HEISBOURG DULY ARRIVED AND REPORTED THAT, PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN PRESIDENTS REAGAN AND MITTERRAND. HE WISHED TO INFORM US THAT THE NEXT DELIVERY UNDER THE NICARAGUA ARMS SALE CONTRACT WOULD TAKE PLACE IN THE NEAR FUTURE AND WOULD CONSIST OF TWO ALLOUETTE HELICOPTERS.
- 4. IN RESPONSE TO MY QUESTIONS, HEISBOURG TOLD ME:
 A. HE DID NOT THINK THE HELICOPTERS WOULD BE EQUIPPED WITH ROCKET LAUNCHERS: THEY NORMALLY ARE SHIPPED SEPARATELY:
- B. NEAR FUTURE MEANS SOMETIME BETWEEN TWO AND FOUR WEEKS;
- HE WAS NOT AWARE OF PILOTS BEING TRAINED IN FRANCE AND SAID THERE WERE CERTAINLY NONE IN ANY ARMY TRAINING

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

SITES, ALTHOUGH IT WAS SOSSIBLE THAT SOME CIVILIAN TRAINING WAS BEING DONE. IN ANY CASE, HE PROMISED TO CHECK ON THE MATTER AND COME BACK TO US.

- 5. HEISBOURG SAID THE FRENCH WOULD NOTIFY US IN THE SAME MANNER WITH RESPECT TO ALL FUTURE SHIPMENTS, THE NEXT PROBABLY BEING ROCKETS AND ROCKET LAUNCHERS. THE LAS THE LAST SHIPMENT WOULD PROBABLY BE THE BOATS WHICH WILL TAKE 12 - 13 MONTHS TO BUILD.
- HEISBOURG SEEMED TO WANT TO MAKE A POINT THAT THE FRENCH WERE FULFILLING THEIR BARGAIN; HE WAS VERY FRIENDLY. I REMINDED HEISBOURG THAT THE AGREEMENT INCLUDED NO FUTURE CONTRACTS FOR ARMS SALES AND HE READILY AGREED THIS WAS TRUE. GALBRAITH

YOUR MONDAY MORNING MEETING WITH CHEYSSON TO DISCUSS EVENTS IN CENTRAL AMERICA PROVIDES THE RIGHT OPPORTUNITY TO REPEAT OUR CONCERNS ABOUT THE COURSE OF FRENCH POLICY IN CENTRAL AMERIÇA. YOU SHOULD BEGIN YOUR CONVERSATION WITH CHEYSSON BY PASSING ON TO HIM THE FOLLOWING ORAL MESSAGE FROM ME.

GERGORIN SAID THAT ALTHOUGH THE REAGAN ADMINISTRATION APPROACH TO THE MITTERRAND GOVERNMENT IS, IN GENERAL, VERY ADEPT, THE FACT THAT WE ARE IGNORING REGIS DEBRAY IS A SERIOUS MISTAKE. 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

3. BEGIN TEXT:

DEAR CLAUDE,

AS YOU ARE AWARE, THE FRONT LINE STATES ALONG WITH NIGERIA AND KENYA PLAN TO MEET IN DAR IN THE VERY NEAR FUTURE, PERHAPS AS EARLY AS MAY 4, IN CONNECTION WITH OUR PROPOSAL TO SWAPO ON THE CONCLUSION OF PHASE ONE OF THE NAMIBIA NEGOTIATIONS. IT IS CLEAR THAT WE HAVE REACHED A CRUCIAL

MESSAGE (CONTINUED) :

CROSSROADS IN THE NEGOTIATION. IF WE ARE TO HOLD TO OUR GOAL OF BEGINNING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF UNSC RESOLUTION 435 IN 1982, WE NEED TO MOVE AHEAD TO PHASE TWO AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE. IN THAT REGARD, I PLAN TO TELEPHONE SALIM AND AUDU TO URGE THEM TO USE THEIR INFLUENCE TO MOVE EVENTS

IN THE PROPER DIRECTION. I HOPE YOU WILL JOIN ME BY CONTACTING PERSONALLY SOME OF THE FLS LEADERS. YOU AND YOUR GOVERNMENT MAY HAVE A SPECIAL CREDIBILITY WITH OUR AFRICAN COLLEAGUES IN THIS NEGOTIATION. I URGE YOU TO USE IT ON THIS IMPORTANT OCCASION. I AM ALSO ASKING HANS-DIETRICH TO HELP US ON THIS ONE.
