This letter responds to the President's two messages of November 12 concerning relations with the USSR and East-West economic relations. In his reply, the Prime Minister discusses the management of relations with the Soviets during the period of leadership transition in Moscow and urges the importance of a summit between the President and General-Secretary Andropov. Speechwriters have cleared the message. Naur Robb, and Bailey concur. Dobriansky is out of town.

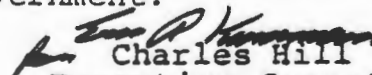
