





Enclosed for your information is a copy of a letter from Prime Minister Trudeau to President Reagan on East/West relations. I delivered the original of this letter to Ken Dam at State Department yesterday.

The letter sets out 10 points which Prime Minister Trudeau believes could form a basis on which East and West could build to improve relations. The Prime Minister indicates that "public acceptance" of these ideas by the superpowers would be an important first step in establishing a political framework that is central to productive negotiations. A similar letter has been sent to Mr. Chernenko and in the next few days the Prime Minister will be writing to other world leaders on the same subject.
