DEAR YASU:

FOR MYSELF AND FOR THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, I WOULD LIKE
TO CONGRATULATE YOU UPON BEING CHOSEN AGAIN AS PRIME
MINISTER OF JAPAN. I AM VERY PLEASED PERSONALLY TO KNOW
THAT I CAN CONTINUE TO COUNT ON YOUR COUNSEL AND SUPPORT
IN THE MONTHS AHEAD. AS I SAID IN THE SPEECH THAT I WAS
HONORED TO MAKE BEFORE YOUR DIET, IF THE UNITED STATES
AND JAPAN COOPERATE, TOGETHER THERE IS NOTHING THAT WE
CANNOT ACCOMPLISH. I LOOK FORWARD TO CONTINUED WORK WITH
YOU IN BUILDING THE VITALLY IMPORTANT PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN
OUR TWO NATIONS.
