2. AMERICAN LIVES ARE AT STAKE IN THE TURMOIL IN GRENADA -- 500 TO 1000 OF THEM. THEIR SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT. THEY COULD BE TAKEN HOSTAGE. AS IN IRAN: THEY COULD GET CAUGHT IN THE CROSSFIRE. INDEPENDENCE MUST BE TAKEN, AND IN MY JUDGMENT THEIR PEOPLE ARE LIKE-MINDED. THE EASTERN CARIBBEAN NATIONS WILL SUPPORT US MATERIALLY AND MORALLY IN WHATEVER WE RESOLVE TO DO. NOW AND AFTER THE FACT. IN THE LAST HOUR I HAVE SPOKEN PERSONALLY WITH ALL THE PRIME MINISTERS. THEY ARE UNANIMOUSLY HORRIFIED AND OUTRAGED AT THE BARBARITY (TOM ADAMS' WORD) OF THOSE WHO HAVE SEIZED GRENADA. THEY ARE VERY WORRIED ABOUT WHAT THIS MEANS FOR THEIR OWN ISLAND MINI-STATES. EXCEPT FOR BARBADOS. THEY ARE NEARLY DEFENSELESS. TOM ADAMS HAS PERSONALLY TOLD ME THAT HE STANDS READY TO ASSIST IN ANY EFFORT. INCLUDING THE MILITARY USE OF THE BARBADOS DEFENSE FORCE, THE REGION'S ONLY TRAINED MILITARY UNIT. 5. I AM NOT COMPETENT TO ASSESS THE MILITARY SITUATION. I CAN ONLY OFFER MY STRONG CONVICTION THAT IF WE MUST. AND WE MAY HAVE TO. WE SHOULD: (1) EVACUATE AMERICAN CITIZENS, BY FORCE IF NECESSARY AND (2) DEPOSE THE THUGS WHO HAVE TAKEN OVER, AND (3) RESTORE GRENADA AS A FREE SOCIETY.

6. IF IT COMES TO IT, IN MY JUDGEMENT, SUCH AN ACTION WOULD MEET OVERWHELMING APPROVAL IN THE COMMONWEALTH CARIBBEAN. I BELIEVE THAT SENTIMENT IN EASTERN CARIBBEAN FOR ACTION IS NOW SO STRONG THAT IT MIGHT BE POSSIBLE TO ELICIT A PUBLIC INVITATION FROM THE REGION'S COLLECTIVE LEADERSHIP TO THE U.S. TO ACT FOR THE SAKE OF HUMAN DECENCY AND HUMAN RIGHTS. (ASSUME DEPARTMENT IS CONSULTING ALLIES AND OTHERS, AS APPROPRIATE.) I DID NOT DISCUSS THE PROSPECT WITH THE HEADS OF GOVERNMENT, BUT I BELIEVE THAT THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES MIGHT WELL AGREE TO BE THE MULTINATIONAL UMBRELLA UNDER WHOSE AEGIS A PEACEKEEPING INTERVENTION MIGHT BE MOUNTED. 1. KS - ENTIRE TEXT). WE HAD TWO LENGTHY CONVERSATIONS WITH CHARLES MODICA. CHANCELLOR OF (AND A MAIN INVESTOR ALONG WITH HIS FATHER, LOU MODICA, IN) THE ST. GEORGE'S UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE. NOTING THAT SOME 80 PERCENT OF THE AMERICAN CITIZENS IN GRENADA ARE STUDENTS OR STAFF AT THE SCHOOL. WE ASKED MODICA, WHO HAS BEEN IN CONSTANT CONTACT VIA TELEX AND PHONE WITH THE SCHOOL, IF HE THOUGHT HIS PEOPLE WERE IN DANGER. HE SAID STAFF WAS TRYING TO NOTIFY EVERYONE TO BE SURE THEY KNEW ABOUT THE CURFEW (SINCE RADIO FREE GRENADA WAS OFF THE AIR MOST OF THE DAY, SOME MIGHT NOT HAVE GOTTEN WORD OF THE SHOOT-ON-SIGHT CURFEW). ON BALANCE HE FELT THAT THE QUOTE REVOLUTIONARY MILITARY COUNCIL UNQUOTE WOULD NOT HARM AMERICANS, SO AS TO AVOID GIVING THE USG A PRETEXT FOR INTERVENTION. ON THE OTHER HAND, HE FEARS A VIOLENT BACKLASH, WITH THE POPULATION RISING AGAINST THE SECURITY FORCES AND SOME STUDENTS

MODICA DESCRIBED SITUATION AS ONE IN WHICH STUDENTS WERE ON EITHER OF TWO CAMPUSES SOUTH OF CAPITAL CITY OF ST. GEORGE'S OR AT THEIR PRIVATE HOMES IN VARIOUS SUBURBS. THE UNIVERSITY HAS NO EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS ARRANGEMENTS WITH INDIVIDUAL STUDENTS, ALTHOUGH IT DOES HAVE A PLAN FOR ASSEMBLING THOSE WHO RESIDE ON THE TWO CAMPUSES AND MOVING THEM TO AREAS DESIGNATED AS POSSIBLE HELICOPTER LIFT SITES.
- 5. MODICA SAID THAT HE OBSERVED SITURKBSA TO BE SUF-FICIENTLY TENSE AND THREATENING SO THAT IF IT WERE SIMPLY A MATTER OF EVACUATING THOSE RESIDENT ON CAMPUSES. HE FELT USG SHOULD MOVE AS QUICKLY AS CIRCUMSTANCES DICTATED. BUT HE HAS A NUMBER OF CONCERNS. FIRST. RADIO FREE GRENADA HAS REPORTED A MARTIAL LAW DECREE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW IN EFFECT UNTIL 6 P.M. MONDAY. OCTOBER 24, WITH A THREAT THAT ANYONE ON THE STREETS IS LIABLE TO BE SHOT. THIS WILL MAKE COMMUNICATIONS WITH AND AMONG POTENTIAL EVACUEES DIFFICULT. IF NOT IMPOSSIBLE. SECOND, IN MODICA'S JUDGEMENT, VIOLENT REACTION BY BISHOP'S SUPPORTERS SHOULD BE EXPECTED WITHIN A WEEK OR SO -- IF NOT WITHIN THE NEXT FEW DAYS. MODICA DOES NOT BELIEVE AMERICAN STUDENTS WILL BE SELECTED AS TARGETS IN SUCH VIOLENCE, BUT THEY MIGHT BE AT RISK IN CROSSFIRE, ESPECIALLY THOSE WHO ARE NOT ON THE CAMPUSES. HE REPEATED HIS OBSERVATION THAT THE GROUP NOW TAKING POWER, WHILE VICIOUS AND INHUMAN, WOULD NOT WANT TO GIVE THE U.S. AN EXCUSE TO INTERVENE ACTIVELY BY DIRECTLY THREATENING AMERICAN STUDENTS.

2. AMBASSADOR IS REQUESTED TO SEEK URGENT APPOINTMENT AT HIGHEST APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF GOV TO EXPLORE GOV INTENTIONS CONCERNING PROTECTION/EVACUATION OF VENEZUELAN CITIZENS FROM GRENADA. AMBASSADOR MAY EXPLAIN THAT WE ARE HIGHLY CONCERNED OVER SAFETY OF APPROXIMATELY 1,000 U.S. CITIZENS LOCATED ON ISLAND AND HAVE BEEN PONDERING WHAT WE MIGHT EFFECTIVELY DO TO ASSURE THEIR SAFETY. INCLUDING POSSIBILITY OF EVACUATION. SINCE THERE ARE NUMBERS OF VENEZUELAN CITIZENS ON ISLAND. FROM OUTSIDE THE CARIBBEAN AREA AND THAT SOME ORGANIZATION OF GRENADIANS WOULD HAVE TO PUBLICLY REQUEST SUCH OUTSIDE INTERVENTION IF THERE WAS TO BE ANY CHANCE TO OUST THE CURRENT REGIME.

- DR. ALEXIS STATED THAT WHILE THE GDM WAS LOOKING FOR OUTSIDE INTERVENTION TO REMOVE THE CURRENT REGIME, THEY WOULD NEVER CONSIDER A RETURN TO THE GAIRY GOVERNMENT. HE WAS CLEAR THAT THIS WOULD NOT BE USED AS AN OPPORTUNITY TO RETURN GAIRY TO POWER. HE THEN STATED THAT HE HAD ISSUED A PRESS RELEASE, WITH GDM COUNCIL APPROVAL, WHICH ANNOUNCED HIM AS THE PRESIDENT OF THE GDM AND WHICH INCLUDED A PARAGRAPH CALLING FOR INTER-VENTION IN THE SITUATION IN GRENADA WHICH THEY BELIEVED WOULD SATISFY PM ADAMS SUGGESTIONS. HE PROMISED THE GDM WOULD NOT ALLOW THE USG TO BE THE SCAPEGOAT SHOULD ANYTHING GO WRONG IN AN ULTIMATE INTERVENTION ACTION.
- 5. AS PROBABLY ALREADY EXPLAINED TO ARA/CAR BY WASHINGTON BASED MEMBERS, ALEXIS CHARACTERIZED THE GDM AS BASED ON 100 ACTIVE, DEDICATED MEMBERS, ALONG WITH SCORES OF OTHERS. THE STRONGEST CHAPTERS BEING IN WASHINGTON, NEW YORK CITY, AND PORT OF SPAIN. ABOUT 25 OF THE ACTIVISTS ARE IN PORT OF SPAIN AND BRIDGETOWN. HE CHARACTERIZED OTHER GROUPS, SUCH AS THOSE EARLIER URGING PM ADAMS TO INTERVENE, AS "MAKESHIFT" GROUPS WITH NO REAL FOLLOWING IN GRENADA. AMONG THE DETAINEES IN GRENADA, ALEXIS CITED WINSTON WHYTE, LLOYD NOEL, TILLMAN THOMAS AND LESLIE PIERRE AS POTENTIAL MEMBERS OF A GOVERN-MENT OF NATIONAL RECONCILIATION. (NOTED IN GDM FACT SHEETS ALREADY DISTRIBUTED.) ALEXIS FEARS THERE HAVE BEEN KILLINGS OF DETAINEES, A REPORT WE ALSO HAD TODAY FROM THE BRITISH HIGH COMMISSION -- THE WIFE OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVE IN ST. GEORGE'S THOUGHT SHE HEARD GUNSHOTS AT RICHMOND HILL PRISON EARLIER TODAY.
- 6. ALEXIS SAID RELATIONS OF THE GDM WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO HAD IMPROVED OVERNIGHT SINCE THE COARD POWER GRAB IN GRENADA. HE WAS SURE T AND T WOULD HELP THE MOVEMENT NOW. STILL, HE INSISTED THE GDM HAD CONCLUDED THERE WAS "NO CARIBBEAN FORCE" POWERFUL ENOUGH TO DISLODGE THE REGIME IN ST. GEORGE'S, HENCE A FERVENT APPEAL TO THE U.S. IN THIS TIME OF NEED.
- 7. SECURITY: ALEXIS SAID HE AND DR. REYNOLD BENJAMIN IN TRINIDAD HAD TAKEN CERTAIN SECURITY PRECAUTIONS. HE SAID GRENADA HAS "HIT MEN" IN THE EASTERN CARIBBEAN WHO ARE NOT TO BE TAKEN LIGHTLY. HE THEN OUTLINED A DISTURB-ING REPORT: SOMEONE PHONED PM ADAMS MOTHER, LADY ADAMS,
