THERE IS AN INCREASING PERCEPTION THAT THE USG HAS NO FIRM PLAN FOR USE TO COPE WITH AMERICAN CITIZENS WHOSE LIVES MAY BE IN DANGER. THE MEDIA, BUT MORE IMPORTANTLY, THE PARENTS AND CONCERNED RELATIVES OF THE MED SCHOOL STUDENTS ON GRENADA CONTINUE TO DEMAND INFORMATION ON THIS SUBJECT.

- 3. THE CANADIANS HAVE ATTEMPTED TO CHARTER AN AIRCRAFT LOCALLY TO EVACUATE THEIR CITIZENS. SAME FOR THE BRITISH. 


