1. THE FOLLOWING TEXT HAS BEEN PROVIDED BY USIA FOR VOA ENGLISH LANGUAGE SERVICE, WHICH COVERS THE CARIBBEAN, THE MORNING OF TUESDAY, OCTOBER 25 IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING A NATIONWIDE ADDRESS BY PRESIDENT REAGAN WHICH IS SCHEDULED FOR 0900 E.D.T.

2. WHILE THE PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS IS DIRECTED TO A U.S. TELEVISION AND RADIO PUBLIC, THE VOA COMMENTARY IS SPECIFICALLY AIMED AT GRENADA. THE OBJECTIVE IS TO CALM THE ANXIETIES OF THE GRENADIANS, SPECIFICALLY THE GRENADIAN MILITARY AND THOSE ASSOCIATED WITH THE REVOLUTIONARY MILITARY COUNCIL, AND TO HELP INSURE A PEACEFUL AND ORDERLY TRANSITION TO THE FORMATION OF A PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT.

QUOTE: THIS MORNING AT 0900 EDT, PRESIDENT REAGAN ANNOUNCED THAT THE UNITED STATES WAS PARTICIPATING IN A MULTINATIONAL EFFORT ORGANIZED AT THE INITIATIVE OF THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES. THESE CONCERNS HAVE FOCUSED ON THE POTENTIAL HAZARDS FOR NATIONAL AND FOREIGN RESIDENTS ON GRENADA, WITH MOUNTING INDICATIONS OF CONTINUING DISORDER ON THE ISLAND, AS WELL AS THE IMPLICATIONS FOR THE EASTERN CARIBBEAN AS A WHOLE.

THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES ACTION IS DESIGNED TO PUT AN END TO THE VIOLENCE SO UNCHARACTERISTIC TO THIS PART OF THE WORLD, AND THE CHAOS AND UNCERTAINTY RESULTING FROM RECENT TRAGIC EVENTS IN GRENADA. OECS SPOKESMAN HAVE EMPHASIZED THEIR FIRM INTENT TO COOPERATE WITH THE GRENADIAN PEOPLE IN RESTORING ORDER.

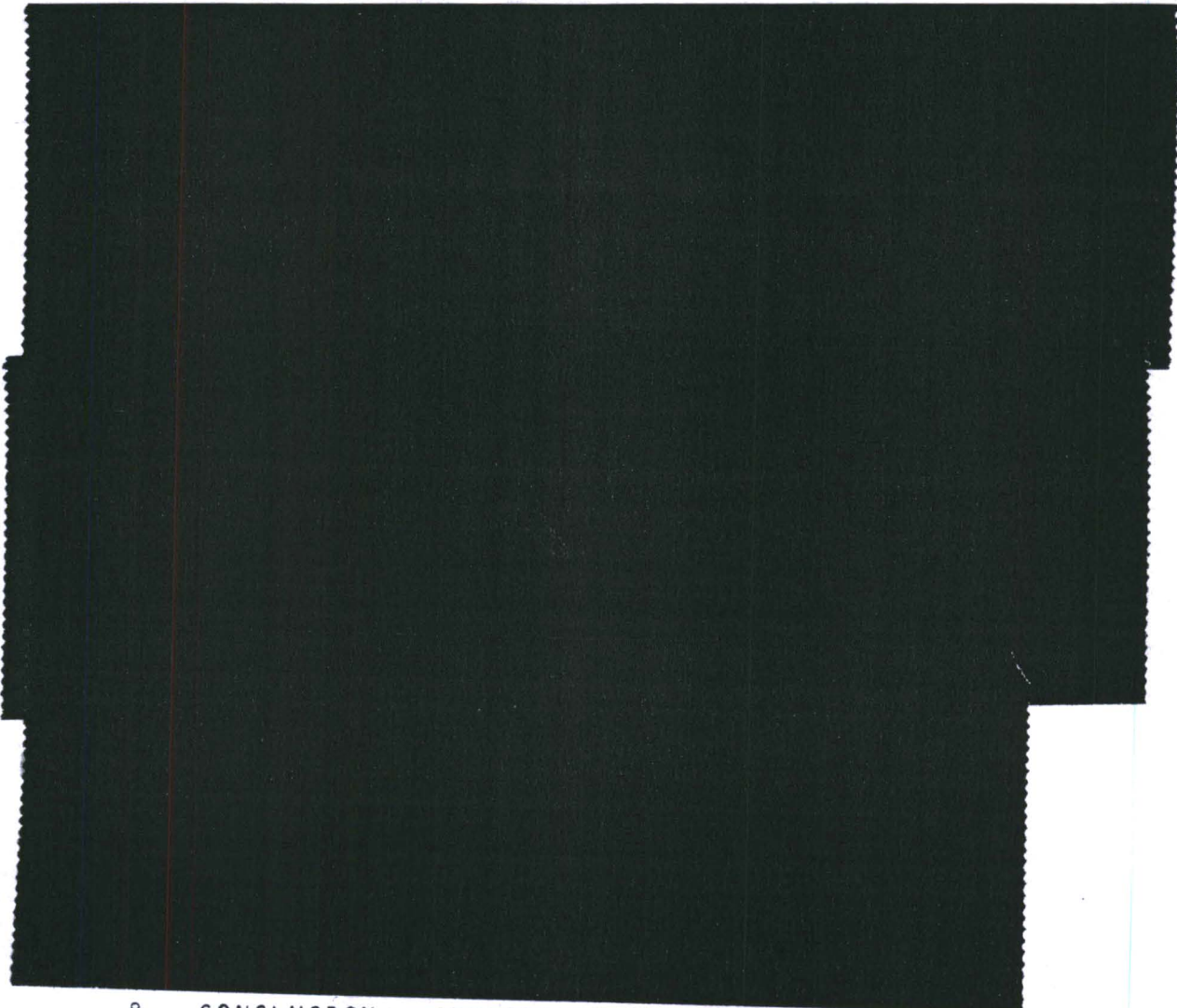

5. BOYER ASKED IF THE U.S. WAS CONSIDERING A JOINT EVACUATION PROCESS WITH THE U.K. MOTLEY REPLIED THAT IF THE U.S. DECIDED TO EVACUATE OUR CITIZENS, THAT WE WOULD LIKELY DO IT ALONE.

MOTLEY AGREED THAT IN BOTH CASES THE MURDERS HAD BEEN CARRIED OUT IN A RUTHLESS FASHION, AND THAT THE GROUP IN CHARGE APPEARED TO BE A MIX OF THUGS AND HARDLINE MARXISTS. AMB. MOTLEY EXPRESSED A CONCERN THAT THE CUBANS CONTINUE TO BE A FACTOR IN GRENADA. THE CUBAN WORKERS HAD MILITARY TRAINING AND POSSIBLY A SUPPLY OF WEAPONS. UPON RECEIPT OF REFTEL, I SPOKE TO FOREIGN MINISTER MIGUEL SCHWEITZER AND CONVEYED THE DEPARTMENT'S MESSAGE CONCERNING U.S. PARTICIPATION IN JOINT SECURITY FORCE, WITH JAMAICA AND BARBADOS, THAT HAS BEEN SENT TO GRENADA TO HELP RESTORE ORDER AND PROTECT/EVACUATE U.S. AND FOREIGN NATIONALS. I EMPHASIZED THAT WE WERE RESPONDING TO A REQUEST OF THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES, AND WE HOPED TO HAVE THE UNDERSTANDING AND SUPPORT OF CHILEAN GOVERNMENT.
