- 3. BESSMERTNYKH INITIALLY SOUGHT CLARIFICATION ON TWO POINTS: HE ASKED WHAT THE USG MEANT BY "RESTORATION OF SECURITY" AND WHETHER PROMISE OF "SAFE PASSAGE" IMPLIED AN "OCCUPATION" OF GRENADA. ADCM RESPONDED THAT THE NON-PAPER SPOKE FOR ITSELF AND THAT HE HAD NOTHING TO ADD WITH REGARD TO THE QUESTION OF "RESTORING SECURITY." 



2. THE CHARGE BRIEFED ACTING PERMANENT SECRETARY MFA MALUKI ON BASIS OF TALKING POINTS REFTEL. MALUKI WAS MOST GRATEFUL FOR INFORMATION AS HE HAD JUST HEARD OF LANDING IN GRENADA AND WAS URGENTLY SEEKING INFORMATION SO THAT HE COULD BRIEF HIS MINISTER AND PRESIDENT MOI IN TURN. HE MADE NO COMMENT, BUT ASKED TWO QUESTIONS: (1) WHO WAS GOING TO MAINTAIN ORDER ONCE IT HAD BEEN RESTORED, AND (2) WOULD THE STATES TAKING PART IN THE LANDING BE REPORTING ON THEIR COLLECTIVE SECURITY ACTION TO THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL?

3. THE CHARGE REPLIED THAT HE WAS UNINSTRUCTED ON THOSE POINTS BUT ASSUMED THAT SECURITY FORCES FROM THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES (DESC) WOULD BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF ORDER. REGARDING THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL, IT WAS OUR UNDERSTANDING THAT THE OECS WOULD BE CALLING FOR AN EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE OAS IN THE FIRST INSTANCE. THE CHARGE EMPHASIZED THAT U.S. SUPPORT OF THE OECS MILITARY ACTION WAS SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESTORING ORDER AND FACILITATING THE EVACUATION OF U.S. AND FOREIGN NATIONALS. HOUDEK

- 2. BEGIN SUMMARY: ON OCT 24 ASSISTANT SECRETARY MOTLEY MET WITH FRENCH CHARGE BOYER TO DISCUSS THE SITUATION IN GRENADA. BOYER WAS INFORMED THAT THE USG HAD BEEN ASKED BY THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES (OECS) TO JOIN IN AN EFFORT TO RESTORE PEACE TO GRENADA. HE WAS ALSO INFORMED THAT PRESIDENT REAGAN WAS CONSIDERING THE OECS REQUEST, BUT NO DECISION HAD YET BEEN MADE. BOYER ADMITTED THAT THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT HAD TRIED AND FAILED TO EVACUATE THE FOUR FRENCH CITIZENS WHO ARE IN GRENADA. BOYER ASKED THAT THE U.S. EVACUATE THE FRENCH CITIZENS IF WE DO DECIDE TO EVACUATE OUR CITIZENS. END SUMMARY.
- 3. ON OCT. 24 ASSISTANT SECRETARY MOTLEY (ARA) AND AN OFFICER FROM ARA/CAR MET WITH FRENCH EMBASSY CHARGE BERNARD BOYER AND POLITICAL OFFICER JANE DEBENEST TO DISCUSS THE SITUATION IN GRENADA. AMB. MOTLEY INFORMED THEM THAT THE USG HAD BEEN REQUESTED BY THE OECS TO JOIN

IT ALONG WITH JAMAICA AND BARBADOS IN ACTING TO RESTORE PEACE AND ORDER TO GRENADA. MOTLEY SAID THAT THE PRESIDENT WAS CONSIDERING THE OECS REQUEST, AND THAT NO FINAL DECISION HAD YET BEEN MADE. AMB. MOTLEY EXPRESSED THE USG'S CONCERN FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR CITIZENS, AND OUR REVULSION AT THE SERIES OF BRUTAL KILLINGS THAT BEGAN ON OCT 12. AMB. MOTLEY EXPRESSED OUR FRUSTRATION THAT THE CURFEW AND THE CLOSURE OF THE AIRPORT HAD MADE IT VIRTUALLY IMPOSSIBLE TO CHECK ON THE WELFARE OF OUR CITIZENS. IF THE U.S. DOES DECIDE TO EVACUATE THE U.S.

- 4. BOTH PARTIES AGREED THAT THE INFORMATION COMING OUT OF GRENADA WAS BOTH SCARCE AND DISTURBING. WHILE THERE HAD BEEN NO DIRECT THREATS AGAINST THE FOREIGN COMMUNITY, THE SITUATION REMAINED BOTH TENSE AND CONFUSED. BOYER STATED THAT THE U.S. HAD VASTLY GREATER INTERESTS AT STAKE IN GRENADA THAN FRANCE DID.
- 5. BOYER ASKED IF THE U.S. WAS CONSIDERING A JOINT EVACUATION PROCESS WITH THE U.K. MOTLEY REPLIED THAT IF THE U.S. DECIDED TO EVACUATE OUR CITIZENS, THAT WE WOULD LIKELY DO IT ALONE.
- 6. BOYER SUGGESTED THAT THE SITUATION IN GRENADA WAS SIMILAR TO THE SITUATION LAST YEAR IN SURINAME. AMB. MOTLEY AGREED THAT IN BOTH CASES THE MURDERS HAD BEEN CARRIED OUT IN A RUTHLESS FASHION, AND THAT THE GROUP IN CHARGE APPEARED TO BE A MIX OF THUGS AND HARDLINE MARXISTS. AMB. MOTLEY EXPRESSED A CONCERN THAT THE CUBANS CONTINUE TO BE A FACTOR IN GRENADA. THE CUBAN WORKERS HAD MILITARY TRAINING AND POSSIBLY A SUPPLY OF WEAPONS. 2. BEGIN SUMMARY. ON OCT. 24, ASSISTANT SECRETARY MOTLEY (ARA) MET WITH CANADIAN CHARGE ROY TO DISCUSS THE SITUATION IN GRENADA. AMB. 3. ON OCT. 24, ASSISTANT SECRETARY MOTLEY AND AN OFFICER FROM ARA/CAR MET WITH CHARGE JACQUES ROY AND J.P. JUNEAU FROM THE CANADIAN EMBASSY TO DISCUSS THE SITUATION IN GRENADA. AMB. MOTLEY TOLD ROY THAT THE ORGANIZATION OF

EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES (OECS) HAD REQUESTED THE U.S.,
