A. (U) THE FBI OFFICE IN PHILADELPHIA, PA WAS CONTACTED ON 25 JUN BY AN ANONYMOUS MALE CALLER WHO STATED THAT AN UNSPECIFIED GOVT FACILUTY IN NEBRASKA WOULD BE BOMBED IN LATE JULY OF EARLY AUGUST. THE FACILITY WAS DESCRIBED AS BEING 40 BY 60 FT, SURROUNDED BY A CHAIN LINK FENCE NITH BARBED WIRE AND 150 METERS OF OPEN GROUND BETWEEN THE FENCE AND A WOODED AREA.
