3. WE ARE ALSO INFORMED THAT THE GOS IS CONSIDERING MAKING SOME STATEMENT EXPRESSING ITS SATISFACTION AT RECENT U.S. NAVAL MANEUVERS IN THE GULF OF SIRTE, PERHAPS LINKING THE EXERCISE TO THE LIBYAN THREATS AGAINST SUDAN.

4. SHOULD WE BE QUESTIONED ABOUT THE GOS ANNOUNCEMENT AND THE TERRORIST THREAT, WE WILL REFER MEDIA REPRESENTATIVES TO THE SUDANESE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION.

5. EMBASSY COMMENT: GOS SEES OUR NAVAL EXERCISE AS HELPING TO DETER LIBYAN AGGRESSION AGAINST IT OF VARIOUS SORTS. WE HAVE PREVIOUS KNOWLEDGE OF THIS ARREST: INFORMATION WAS COMMUNICATED TO THE DEPARTMENT IN THE PAST YEAR THERE HAVE BEEN
