1. A FEW MINUTES AFTER MIDNIGHT THURSDAY MORNING, MARCH 14, AN EXPLOSION SHATTERED WINDOWS AND DAMAGED THE ENTRANCE TO THE ESSO OIL COMPANY'S MAIN OFFICES IN NICOSIA. THE EXPLOSIVE DEVICE HAD BEEN PLACED IN THE DOORWAY LEADING INTO THE BUILDING. THERE WERE NO INJURIES FROM THE BLAST'S POLICE FOUND ADDITIONAL UNDETONATED EXPLOSIVES UNDERNEATH AN ESSO COMPANY VEHICLE THAT WAS PARKED NEARBY IN FRONT OF THE BUILDING. AS OF MID-DAY ON MARCH 15, THE POLICE HAD NOT YET UNCOVERED A MOTIVE FOR THE BOMBING. NOR HAS ANY GROUP CLAIMED RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE INCIDENT.

2. ACCORDING TO LOCAL POLICE SOURCES, THE EXPLOSIVES WERE PREPARED BY AMATEURS. THE CHARGE THAT EXPLODED CONSISTED OF A SMALL AMOUNT OF DYNAMITE WRAPPED IN A CLOTH THAT WAS SET ON FIRE' A FUSE THAT RAN TO THE SIMILAR DYNAMITE CHARGE PLACED UNDERNEATH THE VEHICLE WAS NOT PROPERLY PREPARED, AND THE DYNAMITE THEREFORE DID NOT EXPLODE.

3. THE POLICE HAVE NOT RULED OUT THE POSSIBILITY THAT THE ATTACK WAS POLITICALLY MOTIVATED, ALTHOUGH THERE IS NOTHING TO CONFIRM THIS SO FAR. ONE LOCAL NEWS REPORT ON THE MORNING

WE WILL REPORT FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE MARCH 14 ESSO EXPLOSION AS IT BECOMES AVAILABLE. BOEHM BT

ALL WERE IN REASONABLY GOOD SPIRITS CONSIDERING WHAT THEY HAD GONE THROUGH, AND WERE ANXIOUS TO RETURN HOME. CONTRARY TO EARLIER ASSUMPTIONS THE TWO COUPLES WERE NOT IN THE RESTAURANT BUT SIMPLY WALKING BY WHEN THE BOMB EXPLODED. MEDICAL AUTHORITIES HAVE PRONOUNCED THE FOUR READY TO TRAVEL AND THEY ARE EXPECTED TO RETURN ON AIR FRANCE TO MIAMI, SATURDAY, MARCH 16 AT THE EXPENSE OF THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT WHICH IS ARRANGING THE NECESSARY SPACE ON AIRCRAFT AND WILL SEND A DOCTOR ALONG.
