TSOURAS SAID THAT AN "EXPERIMENT" SUBSEQUENT TO ATWA'S CLAIM HAD SHOWN THAT THE AIRPORT SECURITY MACHINES WOULD HAVE DETECTED WEAPONS THROUGH SUCH INSULATION. TSOURAS SAID ATWA HAD BACKED DOWN ON HIS STORY OF HOW THE ARMS WERE SMUGGLED ON THE PLANE WHEN PRESENTED WITH THE FINDINGS OF THE EXPERIMENT.
