HOWEVER IT NOTED THAT "...PERHAPS AS AMERICANS WATCHED NEWSCASTS AND READ NEWSPAPER REPORTS OF THE SAN SALVADOR BLOODBATH AND THE HOSTAGE DRAMA UNFOLDING IN BEIRUT, THEY RECALLED WHAT WHITE HOUSE SPOKESMAN LARRY SPEAKES SAID WHEN ASKED WHAT THE U.S. RESPONSE TO THE MARINE COMPOUND BOMBING WOULD BE: "ALL I CAN SAY TO THEM IS WAIT AND SEE," AMERICA IS STILL WAITING."

IN A RELATED ARTICLE, "AMERICANS POLLED BY LONG-DISTANCE TELEPHONE YESTERDAY CALLED FOR VIOLENT REVENGE AGAINST SHITE TERRORISTS HOLDING U.S. HOSTAGES IN BEIRUT." THOSE REPONSES INCLUDED:

"PRESIDENT REAGAN HAS NO CHOICE...THE U.S. MUST STRIKE AGAINST TERRORISM EVEN IF IT MEANS THE LOSS OF INNOCENT LIVES..."

THAT IT IS A "...COUP FOR A HANDFUL OF UNKNOWN INDIVIDUALS IN A POOR AND DISLOCATED PART OF THE WORLD WHEN THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES...SPENDS MOST OF A RARE PRESS CONFERENCE TALKING ABOUT THEIR DEED...CONFESSING "I"M AS FRUSTRATED AS ANYONE..."
"HOW EMPTY ARE THE WORDS OF THE PRESIDENT WHEN HE SAYS:"LET ME MAKE IT PLAIN TO THE ASSASSINS IN BEIRUT AND THEIR ACCOMPLICES...THAT AMERICA WILL NEVER MAKE CONCESSIONS TO TERRORISTS," WHEN ON TELEVISION HE LOOKED LIKE A PAPER TIGER, ROARING AT THE GOVERNMENT OF GREECE, BUT NOT DARING TO THREATEN THE MEN WHO BEAT UP AND MURDERED AN INNOCENT U.S. CITIZEN...THEY HAVE HUMILIATED THE PRESIDENT (AND MAY HAVE CONVINCED) THE U.S. AND OTHER COUNTRIES TO DECLARE WAR WITHOUT QUARTER ON TERRORISM."
