ALL INFORMATION CONTAINED HEREIN IS CLASSIFIED SECRET.  
ON OCT. 7, 1981, A CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE WAS INTERVIEWED TO  
OBTAIN THE REACTION AND ASSESSMENT OF THE AMERICAN COPTIC ASSOCI-  
ATION TO THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT OF EGYPT, ANWAR SADAT,  
ON OCT. 6, 1981.  
WITH REGARD TO THE INDEPENDENT ORGANIZATION FOR THE LIBERATION  
OF EGYPT, THE ASSET ADVISED THAT MOSLEM EXTREMIST GROUPS REGULARLY  
SPLINTER, MERGE AND REALIGN AND NAME CHANGES ARE THE NATURAL ORDER  
OF BUSINESS. ASSET ADVISED THAT THE INDEPENDENT ORGANIZATION FOR  
THE LIBERATION OF EGYPT (IOLE) IS NOT KNOWN TO HIM SPECIFICALLY. HE  
IS IN AGREEMENT WITH THE ASSESSMENTS IN THE PRESS THAT THE FORMER  
EGYPTIAN CHIEF OF STAFF SAADIN EL-SHAZLI IS THE MOST LIKELY INDIVIDUAL  
TO HAVE MASTERMINDED THIS, THE 7TH ATTEMPT, ON SADAT'S LIFE.  
ASSET BASED HIS OPINION ON THE FACTS THAT MOSLEM "HARDLINERS"  
SUCH AS THE MOSLEM BROTHERHOOD AND THE ISLAMIC ASSOCIATION HAVE BEEN  
INFILTRATING THE EGYPTIAN ARMY FOR SOME TIME. MEMBERS OF THESE GROUPS  
SHARE EL-SHAZLI'S OPINION OF SADAT AS A TRAITOR TO ISLAM BASED ON  
SADAT'S SIGNING OF THE CAMP DAVID ACCORDS. EL-SHAZLI CONTINUES TO  
HAVE SUPPORT WITHIN THE EGYPTIAN ARMY AND THE ARMY WAS UTILIZED AS  
THE ASSASSINATION VEHICLE.  
WITH REGARD TO THE CURRENT WHEREABOUTS OF EL-SHAZLI, SOURCE  
ADVISED THAT HE TRAVELS REGULARLY BETWEEN LEBANON, SYRIA AND  
LIBYA.  
CONCERNING OTHER GROUPS CURRENTLY ACTIVE IN EGYPT, THE  
ASSET NAMED THE NATIONAL UNIONIST PROGRESSIVE PARTY (NUPP) SIMILAR  
TO HIS EGYPTIAN COPTIC ASSOCIATION, AS A TARGET OF THE RECENT

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SADAT "CRACKDOWN" ON DISSENT. HE CHARACTERIZED THE MURP AS INTELLECTUAL IN NATURE AND NOT PHILOSOPHICALLY DISPOSED TOWARD TERRORIST TACTICS SUCH AS ASSASSINATION.

ASSET ADVISED THAT (IN HIS OPINION) THE BROAD PRINCIPLES UNDERLYING THE ASSASSINATION ARE MORE IMPORTANT TO FORMULATING ANY U.S. RESPONSE THAN THE SPECIFIC IDENTITIES OF THOSE INVOLVED. HE LISTED THE FOLLOWING POINTS AS OF GREATEST IMPORTANCE:

THE ISLAMIC PERCEPTION OF ALL NON-BELIEVERS OR INFIDELS AS HAVING LESS THAN HUMAN STATUS WHO SHOULD BE PUT TO DEATH.

THE FACT THAT WHEN FUNDAMENTALIST MOSLEMS (SUCH AS THE AYATALLAH KHOMEINI) REFER TO THE U.S. AND THE WEST AS "DEVILS" THEY ARE NOT SPEAKING RHETORICALLY BUT LITERALLY. (AS A COPILLARY ANYONE WHO DEALS WITH THE WEST IS TRAFFICKING WITH THE DEVIL AND THEREFORE TAINTED.)

THIS BELIEF IS FIRMLY GROUNDED IN THE TEACHING OF THE KORAN AND BEING BASED ON RELIGIOUS DOGMA IS NOT SUBJECT TO CHANGE OR MODIFICATION THROUGH THE PROCESS OF REASON OR THE PRESENTATION OF A FACTUAL ARGUMENT.

THE NATION OF ISLAM IS JUST THAT - A NATION. AS SUCH IT SUPERCEDES BOUNDARIES BETWEEN COUNTRIES SUCH AS THAT BETWEEN LIBYA AND EGYPT. THE PRIMARY ALLEGIANCE OF THE MOSLEM IS TO HIS RELIGIOUS LEADERS AND NOT TO ANY SOVEREIGN STATE AS DEFINED OR PERCEIVED BY THE WEST. (THE RELIGION IS THE STATE IS THE NATION.)

WHILE SADAT WAS REGARDED IN THE WEST AS A "MAN OF PEACE" AND "A MODERATING INFLUENCE IN THE MIDDLE EAST", HIS SIGNATURE ON THE CAMP DAVID ACCORDS ACTUALLY PROVIDED A FOCAL AND A PALLIATING POINT FOR FUNDAMENTALIST OPPOSITION TO ANY RECOGNITION OF THE JEWISH STATE IN ISRAEL. IN THE MOSLEM WORLD, SADAT WAS ALMOST UNIVERSALLY REGARDED AS A TRAITOR TO THE CAUSE OF ALLAH WHO HAD BEEN CORRUPTED BY THE WEST.

THE STRATEGIC GOAL OF THE ISLAMIC FUNDAMENTALIST IS A "PURE" MOSLEM EMPIRE STRETCHING FROM IRAN IN THE EAST THROUGH NORTH AFRICA TO MOROCCO IN THE WEST. THIS EMPIRE WILL THEN BE USED AS A STAGING AREA FOR CARRYING THE "WORD OF ALLAH" TO THE REST OF THE WORLD WHICH WILL BE GIVEN A SIMPLE CHOICE OF ALLEGIANCE OR DEATH.

ASSET WAS ASKED IF HE COULD DOCUMENT ANY FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR SADAT'S OPPOSITION FROM EITHER LIBYA OR SAUDI ARABIA. THE ASSET ADVISED THAT HE BELIEVES THE SAUDIS HAVE PROVIDED ROUGHLY \$100,000 TO THE MOSLEM BROTHERHOOD IN JERSEY CITY, N.J. HOWEVER, COULD DOCUMENT NO FINANCIAL CONNECTION BETWEEN ANY ARAB NATION AND THE ASSASSINATION ITSELF.

IN THIS CONTEXT THE ASSET WAS ASKED IF THE ACA HAD EVER RECEIVED ANY FUNDS FROM LIBYA OR ANY OTHER ARAB NATION. HE ADVISED THAT EARLIER IN 1991 THE LIBYAN EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON, D.C., HAD WRITTEN TO ACA HEADQUARTERS IN JERSEY CITY AND OFFERED TO PAY DUES IN EXCHANGE FOR A SUBSCRIPTION TO THE ACA MONTHLY PUBLICATION. AN ACA OFFICIAL TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED THE LIBYAN EMBASSY AND ADVISED AN OFFICIAL THERE THAT THE MAGAZINE WAS FREE TO INTERESTED MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AND THAT THE COPTICS WANTED NONE OF THE

LIBYAN "BLOOD MONEY". THE ASSET WAS QUITE EMPHATIC ON THIS POINT.

[REDACTED] (LIEUTENANT), WITHOUT SPECIFYING IN WHAT COUNTRY'S ARMED  
FORCES.

[REDACTED] CALLER STATED THAT HE HAS INFO  
THAT LIBYAN AIRFORCE WILL ATTACK CAIRO DURING FUNERAL SERVICES FOR  
ANWAR SAGAD, AND ASKED THAT THIS INFORMATION BE FORWARDED TO  
APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES. THE CONSULATE EMPLOYEE WHO TOOK THE CALL  
HAS THE IMPRESSION THAT THE LANGUAGE USED BY THE CALLER NOT HIS  
NATIVE TONGUE AND THAT THE VOICE APPEARED TO BE THAT OF MIDDLE-AGED  
MAN.

1. (S) [REDACTED] REPORTS RECEIVED  
INDICATE THAT AN ATTACK BY LIBYA ON SADAT FUNERAL IS POSSIBLE.

LATTER PROVIDED NECESSARY PROTECTION IN PERSON OF TWO OFFICERS AND SOME TWENTY MEN. CROWD NEVER GOT OUT OF HAND AND NO DAMAGE DONE TO BUILDINGS OR PROPERTY.

2. CROWD, LED BY INSTIGATOR WITH TRUCK AND LOUDSPEAKER, DENOUNCED US ASSISTANCE TO REPRESSIVE FORCES IN EL SALVADOR AND NICARAGUA, AND PROTESTED MALCON VISTA MILITARY EXERCISE CURRENTLY UNDERWAY ON NORTH COAST. PAPER AMERICAN FLAG AND UNCLE SAM EFFIGY WERE BURNED.

3. THIS IS FIRST PROTEST DEMONSTRATION DIRECTED SPECIFICALLY AT THE US MISSION IN OVER ONE YEAR. EMBASSY WAS IMPRESSED WITH GENERAL CIVILITY OF EVENT, WITH NO EVIDENCE OF THREAT ON PART OF EITHER POLICE OR DEMONSTRATORS.

COMMUNIQUE MADE NO MENTION THAT THE BUILDING WAS TEMPORARILY OCCUPIED (WE BELIEVE IT WAS), BUT CONCEDED THE ATTACKERS MADE OFF WITH WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION AND MANAGED TO ESCAPE IN THE CAR WHICH THEY HAD BEEN DRIVING AT THE BEGINNING OF THE RAID.

4. IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THE SITUATION IN ASYUT WAS SOMEWHAT GRAVER THAN THAT DESCRIBED IN GDE COMMUNIQUE. ALMOST IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE ABOVE ATTACK, ONE OF THE TWO MAIN POLICE STATIONS IN ASYUT WAS OVERRUN IN THE SAME MANNER. ONCE AGAIN, THE ATTACKERS MANAGED TO WITHDRAW AFTER SEIZING UNKNOWN QUANTITY OF WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION. THEY THEREUPON ATTACKED THE SECOND MAIN POLICE STATION, BUT THIS ATTACK WAS REPULSED. ATTACKERS THEN WITHDREW TO ROOFTOPS OF NEARBY BUILDINGS AND FIGHTING CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE DAY. GDE AUTHORITIES HAVE REPORTEDLY CORDONED OFF THIS AREA. DROPPED PARATROOP REINFORCEMENTS AND FEEL CONFIDENT THEY HAVE THE SITUATION UNDER CONTROL. HOWEVER, AS OF 1100 LOCAL, WE HAVE NO CONFIRMATION GDE HAS OVERRUN THE LAST POSITION WHICH THE ATTACKERS REPORTEDLY HELD.

(COMMENT: ASYUT IS BOTH A MAJOR COPTIC CENTER AND A HOTBED OF ISLAMIC FUNDAMENTALIST ACTIVITY. THE CITY WAS THE SCENE OF SERIOUS SECTARIAN STRIFE IN LATE 1976, AND THE "AL-TAKFIR WIAL-HIJRA" (ATONEMENT AND HOLY FLIGHT), MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD, THE ISLAMIC GROUP, AND OTHER ISLAMIC FUNDAMENTALIST SOCIETIES HAVE LONG BEEN ACTIVE AT ASYUT UNIVERSITY. 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SERIOUS INTERCOMMUNAL FIGHTING IN JUNE PRECIPITATED SADAT'S HARSH CRACKDOWN ON RELIGIOUS EXTREMISTS LAST MONTH. AT LEAST ONE OF THE ATTACKS INVOLVED GUNSHOTS BEING FIRED AT A POLICE STATION FROM A PASSING AUTOMOBILE. IN WASHINGTON, SECRET SERVICE SPOKESMAN DICK HARTWIG DENIED THE REPORT.

"WE HAVE NO INDICATION THERE'S ANY SUCH PLOT OR CONSPIRACY AND WE DON'T HAVE ANY INVESTIGATION IN THAT AREA," HARTWIG SAID.

FBI SPOKESMAN BERNIE MANG SAID HE HAD NO KNOWLEDGE OF THE REPORT.

THE WHITE HOUSE ANNOUNCED WEDNESDAY THAT REAGAN AND BUSH WOULD NOT ATTEND THE FUNERAL FOR SECURITY REASONS. THE U.S. GOVERNMENT WAS REPRESENTED BY A CONTINGENT OF PAST AND PRESENT OFFICIALS INCLUDING SECRETARY OF STATE ALEXANDER HAIG AND FORMER PRESIDENTS JIMMY CARTER, GERALD FORD AND RICHARD NIXON.

NBC SAID FEDERAL AGENTS ARE INVESTIGATING REPORTS THAT FORMER MEMBERS OF THE GREEN BERETS, THE ARMY'S ELITE SPECIAL FORCES, WERE HIRED BY KHADAFY TO TRAIN ASSASSINATION TEAMS AND PARTICIPATE IN "A PLOT TO KILL THE PRESIDENT."

CIA AGENTS WERE QUOTED AS SAYING THAT KHADAFY BECAME "SO INCENSED" AFTER TWO LIBYAN JETS WERE SHOT DOWN BY U.S. NAVY PLANES LAST SUMMER THAT "...HE ORDERED MR. REAGAN'S ASSASSINATION."

STATES SECRETARY OF STATE ALEXANDER H A I G WHEN HE VISITS

THE ST LUCIAN GOVERNMENT POINTED OUT THAT ITS FOREIGN MINISTRY OFFICIALS WOULD BE EXTREMELY BUSY JUST PRIOR TO THE CONFERENCE.
