2. REFTEL MENTIONED MCFARLANE'S PRESENT PLAN TO HAVE LEBANESE NATIONAL SECURITY ADVISER WADIA HADDAD ACCOMPANY MCFARLANE PARTY ON VISIT TO SAUDI ARABIA LATER THIS WEEK.

3. BASED ON MY READING OF CURRENT SAUDI POSTURE, THIS COULD POSSIBLY BE A PROBLEM HERE, PARTICULARLY IN VIEW OF THE RECENT BEIRUT DAILY "AN NAHAR" STORY CLAIMING THAT A TRIPARTITE MCFARLANE-BANDAR-WADIA HADDAD "COMMITTEE" HAD BEEN CONSTITUTED TO RESOLVE THE LEBANESE-SYRIAN PROBLEM. SAUDI GOVERNMENT HAS PUBLICLY DENIED THAT SUCH A GROUP EXISTS. BANDAR YESTERDAY MENTIONED NAHAR STORY AS ANOTHER REASON FOR NOT TRAVELING TO BEIRUT. THE PRESENCE OF WADIA HADDAD ON MCFARLANE MISSION WILL LEND CREDENCE TO THE "TRIPARTITE COMMITTEE" STORY AND WILL RISK THE KIND OF PUBLIC VISIBILITY THAT THE SAUDIS CURRENTLY FIND SO UNCOMFORTABLE IN THE NAHAR STORY. ALSO, I NOTE THAT ASSAD IN HIS MESSAGE YESTERDAY TO THE SYRIAN ARMED FORCES CRITICIZED THE FACT THAT THE U.S. IS NOW MEDIATING BETWEEN ARAB COUNTRIES" AS WELL AS BETWEEN ISRAEL AND THE ARAB COUNTRIES. THIS WILL PUT FURTHER NEGATIVE PRESSURE ON THE SAUDIS REGARDING HADDAD-MCFARLANE VISIT.

4. SAUDIS RADICALLY TRANSFORMED SECRETARY'S PROPOSAL TO KING FAHD DURING SECRETARY'S RECENT VISIT HERE FOR BANDAR-HADDAD-HABIB MEETINGS INTO A "FOUR STAGE" PROCESS (REFTEL B): (1) BANDAR-HADDAD MEETING; (2) BANDAR-SYRIA MEETING; (3) LEBANESE-SYRIAN-SAUDI MEETING; AND (4) U.S.-SAUDI-SYRIAN-LEBANESE MEETING. ONLY FIRST TWO STEPS HAVE NOW OCCURRED. BASED ON THIS SCENARIO SAUDIS THEREFORE MAY WELL ARGUE THAT MCFARLANE-BANDAR-HADDAD MEETINGS, WHICH HADDAD PRESENCE ON AIRCRAFT WOULD IMPLY, WOULD BE PREMATURE, EVEN IN TERMS OF THE PREVIOUSLY ANNOUNCED

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SAUDI SCENARIO.

5. I RECOGNIZE THAT, FROM OUR VIEWPOINT, HADDAD PRESENCE ON MCFARLANE VISIT HERE MAY BE INTENDED TO BRING PRECISELY SAME KIND OF PUBLIC SAUDI IDENTIFICATION WITH LEBANESE PROBLEM AS EANDAR VISIT TO BEIRUT WAS INTENDED TO DO (AND WHICH SAUDIS SIDESTEPPED). I AM AFRAID, HOWEVER, THAT IF WE PRESENT HADDAD'S INCLUSION ON VISIT HERE AS A FAIT ACCOMPLI WITHOUT A CAREFULLY REASONED PRESENTATION TO SAUDIS THIS COULD UPSET THE SAUDIS AND ADVERSELY AFFECT ATMOSPHERE FOR MCFARLANE VISIT.

6. I THEREFORE SUGGEST, IF MCFARLANE WISHES TO PROCEED WITH HADDAD VISIT IDEA, THAT: (1) MCFARLANE AUTHORIZE AMBASSADOR MURPHY (WHO RETURNS TO JIDDA THIS EVENING) TO MAKE THE PROPOSAL TO BANDAR AND PROVIDE HIM WITH OUR RATIONALE FOR HAVING HADDAD ALONG, THE SAUDI "FOUR STAGE" SCENARIO NOTWITHSTANDING. (2) IF KING FAHD SHOULD AGREE TO HADDAD'S INCLUSION (WHICH IS BY NO MEANS CERTAIN), SAUDIS WOULD PROBABLY NOT WISH HADDAD TRAVELING ON SAME AIRCRAFT AS MCFARLANE AND SOME FLEXIBILITY IN THAT REGARD ON OUR PART WOULD ALSO BE DESIRABLE. PLEASE ADVISE.

7. BANDAR HAS NOT YET GIVEN ME THE READ-OUT ON HIS VISIT TO DAMASCUS. I WILL NOT RPT NOT BRING UP THE HADDAD ISSUE WITH HIM WHEN I SEE HIM (HOPEFULLY TODAY), AND WE WILL AWAIT FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS FOR AMBASSADOR MURPHY TO PRESENT AFTER HIS RETURN HERE TONIGHT.

WHILE ACKNOWLEDGING THAT ANNAHAR STORY ALTERS THE CLIMATE FOR REALIZING THIS GOAL. THERE IS AN ELEMENT OF PRETEXT IN THE SAUDI POSITION GIVEN THEIR EXCELLENCE AT PRIVATE DIPLOMACY. THIS IS PARTICULARLY SO AS THE VENUE IS SHIFTED TO SAUDI ARABIA.
- 3. UNDERSTANDING THE POTENTIAL FOR EMBARRASSMENT IF HADDAD ARRIVED VISIBLY WITH ME (EVEN THOUGH OUR 2 AIRCRAFT MAKE PRIVATE ARRIVAL EASILY MANAGEABLE), I DO NOT WANT TO INSIST ON THIS APPROACH, BUT WOULD STILL PREFER IT.
- 4. NEVERTHELESS, I WANT TO STRESS THROUGHOUT MY MISSION THE PRIME IMPORTANCE OF REINFORCING LEBANON. CONSEQUENTLY WOULD APPRECIATE AMBASSADOR MAKING THIS POINT IN MY BEHALF AND URGING PROMPT SAUDI DEBRIEF FOR LEBANESE. WHETHER THIS IS ARRANGED PRIVATELY AS PART OF MY PARTY OR SEPARATELY IS LESS IMPORTANT THAN ITS TIMELINESS.
- 5. WOULD ALSO APPRECIATE AMBASSADOR MAKING POINT THAT WE LOOK FORWARD TO CLOSE TRIPARTITE CONSULTATIONS (AS OPPOSED TO SAUDI "FOUR STAGE" SCENARIO). AN-NAHAR SPECULATION WAS VERY EMBARRASING AND ANGERING TO GOL AND YOU MAY TELL SAUDIS WE HAVE BEEN PRIVATELY AND FORCEFULLY ASSURED THAT THERE WILL BE NO REPETITION OF SUCH INDISCRETION AND THAT "THOSE RESPONSIBLE HAVE BEEN DEALT WITH" (FYI ONLY, THIS APPEARS TO MEAN, INTER ALIA, THAT GHASSAN TUENI, PUBLISHER OF AN-NAHAR, WILL BE REMOVED FROM PRIVATE DECISION-MAKING CHANNEL.)
- 6. MY CURRENT EXPECTATION IS TO SPEND WEDNESDAY AND AT LEAST HALF DAY THURSDAY IN ISRAEL. IF RESULTS WARRANT, WOULD THEN MAKE BRIEF RETURN VISIT TO BEIRUT AND PROCEED JIDDA THURSDAY NIGHT OR FRIDAY MORNING. DILLON##

3. MORNING MEETING AT PRESIDENTIAL PALACE BEGAN WITH MCFARLANE RESTATING USG COMMITMENT TO LEBANESE SOVEREIGNTY, TOTAL WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES, AND SECURITY OF LEBANESE BORDERS. HE NOTED U.S. BELIEF THAT PHASED ISRAELI REDEPLOYMENTS ALONG LINES DESCRIBED BY SHAMIR AND ARENS ARE CONSISTENT WITH STATED GOALS. MCFARLANE CONVEYED ISRAELI DESIRE TO COORDINATE POLITICAL AND MILITARY ASPECTS OF REDEPLOYMENT AND US READINESS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COORDINATION EFFORT AS NECESSARY. DURING MCFARLANE'S PRESENTATION SALEM NOTED THAT ISRAELI

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REDEPLOYMENT AND PLO WITHDRAWAL WERE MERELY QUOTE FOOTNOTES UNQUOTE ON THE LEBANESE AGENDA. FOR THE LEBANESE OBTAINING SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL IS THE TOP PRIORITY.

4. IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION FROM HADDAD, MCFARLANE EXPLAINED USG EFFORTS TO OBTAIN TIMETABLE FOR SUBSEQUENT --- PHASES OF REDEPLOYMENT AND THE ISRAELI UNWILLING-NESS TO AGREE OR DISAGREE PENDING CABINET CONSIDERATION. HADDAD MADE CLEAR THAT THE CENTRAL CONDITION FOR POLITICA COORDINATION WITH ISRAEL ON THE FIRST PHASE OF REDEPLOY-MENT WAS AGREEMENT ON A QUOTE CONTEXT FOR ISRAELI ACTIONS UNQUOTE (I.E. AGREEMENT ON A TIMETABLE FOR A COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL), IN WHICH CASE LEBANESE COULD CONSIDER PHASED REDEPLOYMENT AS QUOTE AD HOC IMPLEMENTA-TION OF THE AGREEMENT UNQUOTE. WITHOUT SUCH A CONTEXT, LEBANESE WOULD REGARD ISRAELI REDEPLOYMENT TO THE AWWALI AS A UNILATERAL ACTION. IN ANY EVENT LEBANESE WOULD COORDINATE MILITARY ASPECTS OF THE REDEPLOYMENT. SALEM ADDED THAT IT WAS FRUITLESS FOR LEBANON TO DISCUSS PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL UNLESS THERE WAS SOMETHING TO DISCUSS WITH SYRIA. HE STRESSED REPEATEDLY THE NEED FOR PARALLEL DISCUSSIONS WITH SARG EVEN AS THE LEBANESE DISCUSS SUBSTANTIVE PROBLEMS OF REDEPLOYMENT WITH ISRAEL. SYRIA COULD EXPLOIT REDEPLOYMENTS, AND THE USG, SAUDIS AND OTHERS MUST PERSUADE SYRIA NOT TO INTERFERE IN AREAS VACATED BY THE ISRAELIS. MCFARLANE ACKNOWLEDGED THE IMPORTANCE OF PARALLEL APPROACH TO SYRIA. FAIRBAMKS NOTED THAT ISRAELIS VIEW PHASED REDEPLOYMENT AS A MEANS OF PRESSURING SYRIA AND HE PROVIDED WRITTEN US SUMMATION OF THE ISRAELI POSITION. SALEM COMMENTED THAT THE REFERENCE TO PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL IS INCONSISTENT WITH WHAT IS ENVISAGED IN THE LEBANON-ISRAEL AGREEMENT AND THAT ISRAEL SHOULD RESTATE ITS READINESS TO WITHDRAW COMPLETELY AS SYRIA WITHDRAWS. HE ADDED THAT A LETTER TO ASSAD FORMALLY REQUESTING SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL IS READY TO BE SENT, BUT AS WITH THE EXCHANGE OF INSTRUMENTS OF RATIFICATION, THE QUESTION OF TIMING IS STILL OPEN.

5. MCFARLANE THEN ATTEMPTED TO DETERMINE CONCRETE LEBANESE POSITIONS WITH RESPECT TO ISRAELI PLANS AND ISRAELI REQUIREMENTS AS CONVEYED BY ARENS AND SHAMIR. HE SAID WE NEED TO TURN ISRAELI DETERMINATION TO REDEPLOY INTO A PROCESS WHICH WOULD REINFORCE THE AUTHORITY OF THE GOL. HE REQUESTED THAT THE LEBANESE

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- REINVIGORATE THE MILITARY-TO-MILITARY CHANNEL AT THE TANNOUS-LEVY LEVEL, IN ADDITION TO THE POLITICAL CHANNEL. HADDAD RESPONDED THAT THE MILITARY CHANNEL IS NOT A PROBLEM BUT THAT OPEN POLITICAL COORDINATION WOULD NOT BE POSSIBLE ABSENT AN AGREED TIMETABLE. HADDAD STRESSED THAT A GOL MOVE INTO THE ALEY AND SHOUF WOULD BE EXTREMELY HELPFUL TO GEMAYEL'S POSITION. HADDAD AND SALEM REPEATEDLY STRESSED THAT UNLESS THIS REDEPLOYMENT WAS CAREFULLY MANAGED, GOL COOPERATION COULD BE EXPLOITED BY THE SYRIANS TO THE DETRIMENT OF ALL.
- 6. SALEM SUMMARIZED LEBANON'S PROBLEMS WITH PROPOSED REDEPLOYMENT. FIRST THE NEED FOR ISRAELI COMMITMENT NOT TO INCITE FACTIONS AFTER THEY LEAVE THE SHOUF. SECOND. THE NEED FOR THE US, GOL AND SAUDI ARABIA TO PRESSURE THE SYRIANS TO INSURE THAT THEY DON'T TAKE ADVANTAGE OF AN ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL BY INCITING THEIR OWN SURROGATES OR INTERVENING WITH THE SYRIAN ARMY. THIRD, THE GOL MUST WORK OUT A POLITICAL SETTLEMENT TO ALLOW FOR THE PEACEFUL ENTRY OF THE LAF INTO THOSE AREAS VACATED BY ISRAEL. GOL IS COMMITTED TO AN EARLY SOLUTION TO THIS PROBLEM.
 - 7. SALEM OUTLINED THE CONDITIONS FOR LEBANESE COOPERA-TION WITH AN ISRAELI PLAN FOR SUCCESSIVE REDEPLOYMENTS CULIMATING IN WITHDRAWAL FROM LINES OPPOSITE SYRIAN FORCES IN THE EAST. THESE CONDITIONS WERE REDUCED TO WRITING BY THE US SIDE AND REVIEWED DURING EVENING DISCUSSION WITH THE LEBANESE:
- -- LEBANESE NEED TO LINK ISRAELI REDEPLOYMENT TO PROGRESS ON SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL.
 - -- GOL WILL COORDINATE FULLY AND PROCEED TO AN AD HOC IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT IF GOI PUBLICLY STATES TARGET DATES FOR ALL REDEPLOYMENT PHASES.
 - -- TO FORESTALL ADVERSE SYRIAN RESPONSE TO REDEPLOYMENT SYRIAN CONCESSIONS MUST BE EXACTED IN EXCHANGE FOR AN ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL UNDERTAKEN OUTSIDE THE CONTEXT OF LEBANESE-ISRAELI AGREEMENT.
 - -- AN ANNOUNCED TIMETABLE FOR COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL IS ESSENTIAL WHICH SHOULD NOT EXCEED 4-5 MONTHS. TARGET DATES FOR EACH PHASE ARE NEEDED.

GEMAYEL MADE CLEAR THAT HE DOES NOT SUPPORT THE BREAK-UP OF LEBANON INTO ENCLAVES. THE VARIOUS COMMUNITIES MUCH REACH A POLITICAL AGREEMENT TO WORK TOGETHER TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF MUTUAL STRENGTHS. GEMAYEL IS CONFIDENT OF THE ABILITY OF GOL TO ACHIEVE FACTIONAL RECONCILIATION.
- 4. WITH RESPECT TO REDEPLOYMENT, GEMAYEL SAID THAT HE RECOGNIZED THAT FURTHER ACCOMMODATION BY GOL MIGHT BE NECESSARY AND HE COULD ENVISAGE THE EVENTUAL UTILITY OF PRIVATE POLITICAL EXCHANGES WITH THE ISRAELIS, HOWEVER HE URGED AMBASSADOR MCFARLANE TO USE THESE CARDS JUDICIOUSLY. MCFARLANE MADE CLEAR THAT HE UNDERSTANDS THAT POLITICAL EXCHANGES ARE AN IMPORTANT CARD THAT CANNOT BE USED LIGHTLY. GEMAYEL EMPHASIZED HIS CONCERN THAT WE MAKE MAXIMUM EFFORT TO KEEP SUCH MEETINGS PRIVATE. AT THE SAME TIME HE ACKNOWLEDGED PROBABILITY OF THEIR BECOMING PUBLIC. FOR THIS REASON HE STRESSED ONCE MORE THAT ISRAELI QUID --AGREEMENT TO FULL WITHDRAWAL PLAN -- HAD TO BE WORTH IT.

IN CLOSING, PRESIDENT GEMAYEL REQUESTED THAT U.S.
OFFICIALS WORK WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF LEBANON AND NOT WITH
THE LEADERS OF VARIOUS COMMUNAL GROUPS WITHOUT COORDINATING WITH THE GOVERNMENT.

5. IN LARGER MEETING GEMAYEL REITERATED THAT HE VIEWS OUR PROPOSAL VERY SERIOUSLY AND IS READY TO WORK WITH IT. HE WANTS TO MEET AGAIN AFTER WE STOP IN ISRAEL AND SAUDI ARABIA. HE FELT THAT THE MEETINGS YESTERDAY WENT VERY WELL BETWEEN AMBASSADORS MCFARLANE AND FAIRBANKS AND THE LEBANESE DELEGATION. AMB. MCFARLANE EXPRESSED PRESIDENT REAGAN'S DEEP PERSONAL COMMITMENT THROUGH ALL NECESSARY MEASURES TO FACILITATE PROCESS OF ESTABLISHING AN INDEPENDENT LEBANON, THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES, AND THE SECURITY OF ALL LEBANON'S BORDERS. HE NOTED HOW PRESIDENT REAGAN WAS INSPIRED BY PRESIDENT GEMAYEL'S LEADERSHIP AND HIS ROLE IN PROMOTING ECONOMIC GROWTH AND

STABILITY IN LEBANON. MCFARLANE REAFFIRMED HIS OWN COMMITMENT TO THE EFFORT TO ACHIEVE THESE GOALS. HE EXPLAINED THAT WE WOULD PRESENT THE LEBANESE POSITION IN ISRAEL BUT EXPECT SOME RESISTANCE ON THE POSSIBLE NEED FOR ACCOMMODATION IN THE DAYS AHEAD. MCFARLANE CONTINUED THAT HE WOULD POSSIBLY HAVE TO COME BACK TO LEBANON BEFORE WE WENT ON TO SAUDI ARABIA AND SYRIA WHERE WE WILL BE IN A POSITION TO PURSUE A STRATEGY THAT CONTAINS POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE INCENTIVES. WHILE WE WILL ACKNOWLEDGE AND RESPECT SYRIAN INTERESTS, WE WILL ALSO TRY TO BRING ARAB PRESSURE TO BEAR ON SYRIA. U.S. WILL CONTINUE TO COORDINATE WITH LEBANESE UNTIL SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL IS MCFARLANE THEN PROPOSED THAT HIS TEAM BE ACHIEVED. HEADQUARTERED IN BEIRUT DURING LATER ROUNDS. GEMAYEL EMPHASIZED THAT AGREEMENT IS NEEDED QUICKLY AND THAT TIME IS AS IMPORTANT AS SUBSTANCE; OTHERWISE THERE WILL BE A CONTINUING EROSION OF THE CONSENSUS. GEMAYEL NONETHELESS BELIEVES THAT NINETY-NINE PERCENT OF THE LEBANESE WANT TO REBUILD THEIR NATION BUT THAT SOME LEADERS ARE FORCED TO WORK FOR THE ISRAELIS AND SYRIANS AGAINST THEIR WILL. ONCE WITHDRAWAL IS COMPLETED, LEBANON CAN BE REBUILT AND "BECOME A MASTERPIECE OF U.S. STRATEGY IN THE MIDDLE EAST." GEMAYEL CLOSED HIS REMARKS BY REITERATING THAT THE LEBANESE WILL TAKE NO INDEPENDENT ACTIONS THAT MIGHT EMBARRASS THE MCFARLANE REITERATED THAT IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE THE U.S. NATIONAL UNITY THAT PRESIDENT GEMAYEL SPEAKS OF WE MUST FIRST GET ALL FOREIGN FORCES OUT. THIS PROCESS CAN LEAD TO RESTORATION OF A STABLE, PROSPEROUS LEBANON. HE ASSURED PRESIDENT GEMAYEL OF OUR COMMITMENT TO FULL COORDINATION. DILLON##

4. BANDAR SAID ASSAD TOLD HIM THAT THE LINKAGE

1. FOLLOWING ARE REMARKS BY AMBASSADOR MCFARLANE TO THE PRESS AFTER MEETING WITH PRIME MINISTER MENACHEM BEGIN, JERUSALEM, AUGUST 4, 1983:

BEGIN REMARKS: MCFARLANE: AS ALWAYS, IT IS A PLEASURE TO RETURN TO ISRAEL. ON THIS OCCASION IT IS AN EXPRESSION OF PRESIDENT REAGAN'S COMMITMENT TO LENDING UNITED STATES EFFORTS TO THE ADVANCEMENT OF PEACE, MOST URGENTLY IN LEBANON, THROUGH THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES, THE ORDERLY RESTORATION OF LEBANESE SOVEREIGNTY THROUGHOUT ITS COUNTRY, AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SECURITY, FULLY EFFECTIVE SECURITY, ON LEBANON'S BORDERS PARTICULARLY ON ISRAEL'S NORTHERN BORDER. AND IN THE BROADER CONTEXT OF ADVANCING THE PROSPECTS FOR PEACE, OUR DELEGATION HAS VISITED BEIRUT AND NOW. OUR EXCHANGES HERE IN JERUSALEM AND TEL AVIV. WE MET THIS MORNING WITH THESE EXCHANGES WERE PRIME MINISTER BEGIN. EXTREMELY WORTHWEILE, THEY FACILITATED A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE DIFFERENCES WHICH EXIST, AND THEY HOLD A PROMISE OF PROGRESS. I'LL CARRY THESE IDEAS BACK TO BEIRUT. WE'LL LOOK FORWARD TO VISITING ARAB CAPITALS IN THE DAYS AHEAD. A MATTER OF URGENT PRIORITY IS THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES FROM LEBANON. WE APPRECIATE THE TRADITIONAL WARM HOSPITALITY WE HAVE RECEIVED HERE, THE VERY CONSTRUCTIVE VIEWS AND PROPOSALS, IDEAS, CRITICISMS THAT WE HAVE GOTTEN.

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LEBANESE POSITION ON ISRAELT WITHDRAWALS

The Lebanese Understanding of Israeli Intentions

Israel has announced its intention to withdraw (redeploy) its forces from the general grea of the Alayh and Shul districts as a first step in its complete withdrawal from Lebanon. As its plans are now understood, the TDF will leave the area bounded (a) on the north by the Beirut-Damascus highway, including advanced Israeli positions in the Bayt Mari/Monteverde localities north of that highway, (b) on the west by the sea, (c) on the south by the Awwali River and its extension, the Baruq Siver, and (d) on the east by the western slopes of Jabal Baruq and the road between Batlun and Ayn Dara, of which it will retain control. In addition, Israel is prepared to discuss a minor extension of the zone from which it departs to include the village of Mukhtara.

This redeployment will take six to eight weeks, take the form of one continuous operation, and is to be completed before the advent of the winter snows, roughly October 15.

Following this redeployment, Israel wishes to retain an MFA liaison presence in the Beirut area, preferably near the coast north of the city, and to station security personnel similar in function to Marine Security Guards on its premises. It is prepared to discuss the nature and size of this security force with the Lebanese. It recognizes that primary responsibility for the security of this office rests wiDECLASSIFIED ese.

Israel would further like this redeployment to occur in the context of the Lebancse-Israeli Agreement, which it hopes will be brought into force as soon as possible. Mean-while, it wishes the Lebanese to coordinate this redeployment fully with it at both the political and military levels.

As a tangible way of demonstrating that it has absolutely no territorial ambitions in southern Lebanon and that the area south of the Awwali River will not become an Israeli protectorate, Israel is anxious to promote as great a return of Lebanese governmental authority to that area as is consistent with its security concerns.

Subsequently, as the Lebanese army demonstrates its capacity to take larger missions, Israel would be prepared to withdraw in stages from the rest of southern Lebanon west of the Biqa Valley down to the international border.

A last stage -- withdrawal from the Biqa -- would occur only in conjunction with Syrian withdrawal.

The Lebanese Position

The Lebanese position on this first withdrawal, which is shared by a desire to make it a part of an overall strategy to obtain Syrian withdrawal, is as follows:

- define a public presentation of the first withdrawal that includes a notational or target date for full withdrawal, Lebanon is prepared to undertake full tripartite coordination of the successive operations and proceed to ad hoc implementation of the security arrangements foreseen in the Lebanese-Israeli Agreement as Israel departs from areas south of the Awwali. The purpose of this coordination and of the implementation of ad hoc security arrangements would be to facilitate withdrawal and ensure that it took place in a stable political environment. Otherwise, Lebanon intends to deal with the planned withdrawal as a unilateral action.
- -- In order to forestall Syrian exploitation of the planned Israeli withdrawal as constituting evidence of an intention to partition Lebanon, the U.S., Lebanon, and other Arab states must engage Syria in substantive discussions concurrently with Lebanese-Israeli-U.S. discussions on the planned Israeli withdrawal. In part, these discussions should seek to prevent the Syrians from activating surrogates in the areas from which the Israelis withdraw or infiltrating Syrian or Palestinian personnel from areas under their own control. Syria should be prepared

to pay a price for the political gains it will receive from an Israeli withdrawal that occurs outside the scope of the Lebanese-Israeli Agreement and without a parallel Syrian withdrawal.

- To minimize further the danger of Syrian exploitation of the planned Israeli withdrawal, an announced target date for completion of a full Israeli withdrawal is essential. This should not exceed four to five months. Israel can also state that it remains willing to effect a full withdrawal in eight to twelve weeks in accordance with the Lebanese-Israeli Agreement if Syria will agree to withdraw.
- -- Furthermore, the successive phases of withdrawal from Lebanon west of the Biga Valley must be implemented according to a definite timetable with specific target dates for each phase conditioned only by the commitment of the Lebanese to maintain security in the areas from which the Israelis depart.
- -- Lebanon for its part has been working and will continue to work intensively to achieve the kind of political/security agreement that will provide the best possible conditions for the entry of the Lebanese army into the areas from which the Israelis depart.

- -- To facilitate the emergence of stability in any area from which they depart, the Israelis must depart cleanly, without residual presence or movement. No "time bombs" must be left behind. Following withdrawal, the various Israeli agencies must adopt a hands-off policy in these areas.
- -- While the Lebanese army will shoulder full responsibility for the maintenance of law and order throughout the areas evacuated, the MNF will have an important supporting role to play in the area north of the Awwali River. MNF association with the Lebanese army and its precise form are still under discussion.
- -- The Lebanese government will undertake all necessary measures to restore all appropriate functions of the civil administration in southern Lebanon south of the Awwali River. Coordination of these measures will take place in the tripartite political forum.
- ** -- The Lebanese remain committed to the entry into force of the Lebanese-Israeli Agreement as soon as the full withdrawal of all foreign forces can be arranged.
 **NOTE: This point was added after the August 1 evening session.

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ORAL EXPANSION OF THIRD POINT IN LEBANESE POSITION

If necessary, the target date for final withdrawal can be conditioned upon Syrian withdrawal.

LEBANESE CONCESSIONS REGARDING REDEPLOYMENT

- "Unconditional" Concessions
 - -- Political Coordination: GOL is prepared to use the existing Kimche-Qassis-(Ross) channel to coordinate political aspects of Israeli redeployment from the Shouf. This "committee" could meet frequently.

 Although frequency was not defined with precision, it was reaffirmed that meetings could be on a daily basis if that was required. The GOL could ensure that Qassis has full and timely access to highest policy officials.

 -- Military Coordination: Lebanese have agreed to continue meetings at Tannous-Levy level to establish terms of reference for coordination of military aspects of IDF withdrawal. General Tannous has specifically tabled concept of Redeployment Supervisory Committee (1-2 Star General Officer Level) which would work out specific details. This committee could include MNF participation.
- Conditional Concessions: Conditions bearing on these concessions are that Israel agrees to a complete with-drawal with a target date certain for the completion of each phase including the final phase, even if the last phase is contingent on Syrian withdrawal.
 - E-- Maintenance of Israeli Liafson Office in Greater

 Beirut. Provided certain conditions were met, GOL will

 permit continuation of a civilian Israeli office in

 greater Beirut area as envisaged in the May 17 Agreement.]

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- Ad Hoc Implementation of Security Arrangements.

 GOL would consider ad hoc implementation of security arrangements for each phase of Israeli withdrawal.

 This might permit, for example, the establishment of prototype joint teams to satisfy the GOI that LAF security in the successively vacated zones is adequate to verify the commitments of the GOL.
- -- The GOL is prepared to accept an extended timetable for Israeli withdrawal not to exceed five months and thereby implicitly recognizes the Israeli position stipulated in the side letter and its requirement for simultaneous withdrawal.

DRAFT STATEMENT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF ISRAEL

- -- The Government of Israel has no territorial ambitions in Lebanon and does not covet a single square inch of Lebanese soil. This concept was one of the key elements of the Agreement of May 17.
- -- The Government of Israel respect. Lebanon's independence and hopes that the Government of Lebanon will be able to assert its sovereign authority throughout all its territories as soon as possible through the withdrawal of all foreign forces.
- -- The Government of Israel regards the forthcoming redeployment of its military forces to the Awali River Line as the first stage in a process of withdrawal. This redeployment is fully consistent with all elements in the Israeli-Lebanese Agreement of May 17 and will be carried out in the context of that Agreement.
- -- The Government of Israel of course expects that the Agreement will come into force as soon as possible.
- -- Further withdrawals are contemplated as the security situation permits.

THE ACHIEVE-MENT OF THIS GOAL REQUIRES WITH THE UTMOST URGENCY THAT THE LAND OF LEBANON BE FREED OF OCCUPATION OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES.

AS PART OF THIS COMMITMENT TO ACHIEVE THE RENEWAL OF LEBANESE SOVEREIGNTY, THE GOVERNMENT HAS RECEIVED NEW ASSURANCES AND UNDERTAKINGS FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF ISRAEL.

- AGREEMENT TO FENOVE ALL OF ITS FORCES FROM LEBANON WITHIN EIGHT TO TWELVE WEEKS AS SOON AS SATISFACTORY ARRANGEMENTS ARE MADE FOR THE REPOVAL FROM LEBANON OF ALL OTHER FOREIGN FORCES.
- -- IN THE MEANTIME, ISRAEL WILL BEGIN SHORTLY THE

 COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL OF ITS MILITARY FORCES IN THE

 COASTAL AREA OF LEBANON TO POSITIONS SOUTH OF THE AWWALI

 RIVER. THIS WITHDRAWAL WILL BE TIMELY AND CONTINUOUS,

 AND THE SECURITY AND JURISDICTION OF THIS AREA WILL

 CONCARRENTLY

 INMEDIATELY BECOME THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE GOVERN
 MENT OF LEBANON. PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE ASSUMP
 TION OF CONTROL WILL BE CONCLUDED IN TALKS BETWEEN ISRAELI

 AND LEBANESE AUTHORITIES.
 - -- FURTHER ISRAELI WITHDRAWALS SOUTH OF THE AWWALI

RIVER ARE CONTEMPLATED SUBJECT TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF EFFECTIVE SECURITY IN THE EVACUATED AREAS AND THE WITH-DRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES. A COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES COULD BE ACCOMPLISHED WITHIN FOUR TO FIVE MONTHS WILL BE ARRANGED AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE.

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- Israelis remain committed to total withdrawal; no partition.
- Described in detail the redeployment plan to be completed by October 15.
- Are considering USG request for a presentation of how this initial redeployment to Awali line would be associated with further redeployments and complete withdrawal. Review public presentation document agreed with Israelis.
- Expressed their views that this redeployment would afford opportunity to demonstrate capacity of GOL to expand authority beyond current area.
- We made clear our view that Israelis must help facilitate and cooperate with Lebanese efforts to resolve political disputes between factions and to to terminate armed hostilities between militias.
 - We stressed and the Israelis acknowledged that the USG would not pressure the GOL to exchange instruments of ratification at this time. The Israelis remain nonetheless convinced that prompt implementation of the agreement would put added pressure on Syria (Query GOL desire on this point about logic for their refusal).
- Israelis believe GOL needs to demand Syrian withdrawal in a formal way. We need to discuss the timing and context of such a demarche and how USG and others might help.

- USG understanding of Israeli rationale, refer to State summary). In this context, How do you view the closing of the LF's barracks in the South?
- The Israelis are also interested in a 2-10 km disengagement with the Syrians in the Bega. We would like your thinking on this.
- -- Explain how we might take advantage of Israeli redeployment.
 - Machinery to coordinate redeployment, maintain security and facilitate extension of GOL authority.

 Hope you can agree to establishment of a military channel for this coordination -- we may be able to help here as well. We thank that Tannous and Levy should meet to agree to a TOR for staff level coordination right away.

 Likewise, can the Kimche-Qassis work to coordinate political issues relating to redeployment?
 - GOL thinking and action to date to reach interim accord with both Druze and Christian communities and to stop the fighting between the PSP militias and the LF. What assistance from third parties mught be useful (such as witnesses to status quo and agreed territorial adjustments in Shuf/Alex)?
 - Depending on your deliberations, we may be able to table in Jerusalem subject of plans for subsequent phases in IDF redeployment.
 - Finally, how do you see the MNF assisting in this redeployment process?

- -- Encourage GOL to negotiate withdrawal of PLO fighters (Arafat feelers).
 - Our view of Arafat/Syrian split and implications for withdrawal of loyalist elements.
 - Ascertain Lebanese thinking on prospects for the concurrent resettlement of exposed Palestinians in camps.
 - I hope to find out more about the PLO intentions in the course of my trip. Welcome your thoughts.
 - In this regard, you should know that Shamir again intimated that PLO withdrawal was the priority.

 Following the PLO withdrawal, the Israelis hinted they might be more flexible about terms of Syrian withdrawal.
 - -- Emphasize tough posture towards Syria.
 - As you know, we are continuing to articulate and elaborate our plans for Syria.
 - We are convinced that the USG must provide a credible backdrop. This could include enhanced military presence in and around Lebanon. Would appreciate your thoughts.

(Brief Bud on backsliding)

- We also believe that a credible Israeli military threat adjacent to Syrian lines is a valuable form of pressure.
 - Israeli planning for subsequent phases in the redeployment of the IDF includes continuous pressure on Syria in the mountains and the Bekaa even as the coastal plain is evacuated.

Under any of the taregoing options:

- -- Israel will insist in particular that arrangements for maintaining an Israeli liaison office in the Beirut area as well as privileges and immunities for Israeli personnel will be honored during this interim period.
- -- Returning to the particular problems associated with the initial Israeli redeployment to the Awali River Line, Israel is prepared in principle to cooperate with and assist in a political agreement involving the Druze, the Lebanese forces, and other factions and elements in the Alayh Shuf regions, a political agreement which will have to be negotiated and completed primarily by the Lebanese Government.
- -- Similarly, Israel undertakes not to provide military equipment or support to any factions or groups in these regions after the Lebanese Army and Government have asserted authority there.
- -- Israel will not establish any military or occupation government in the territory it holds pending final withdrawal.
- -- Israel will be prepared in principle to keep its presence in this area as low as feasible consistent with security needs and will cooperate and foster any efforts by the central Lebanese Government to assert its civil authority, to make appointments of local officials, to carry out economic and development projects, to provide humanitarian services, etc.
- -- Israeli authorities will conduct themselves so as to keep one communal group from asserting authority or domination over another in the areas where it maintains control.
- -- The overall objective of the Israeli authorities will be to allow the central government to exercise as much civil authority as it wishes, consistent with preserving security and on condition that there be full cooperation between civilian officials of the Lebanese Government in the areas under Israeli control and the Israeli authorities.

Description of Israeli position on the forthcoming redeployment which can be used publicly:

- -- The Government of Israel has no territorial ambitions in Lebanon and does not covet a single square inch of Lebanese soil. This concept was one of the key elements of the Agreement of May 17.
- -- The Government of Israel respects Lebanon's independence and hopes that the Government of Lebanon will be able to assert its sovereign authority throughout all its territories as soon as possible through the withdrawal of all foreign forces.
- The Government of Israel regards the forthcoming redeployment of its military forces to the Awali River Line as the first stage in the withdrawal envisaged in the Israeli Lebanese Agreement of May 17, 1983. This redeployment is fully consistent with all elements in the Israeli-Lebanese Agreement of May 17 and will be carried out in the context of all parts of that Agreement, thus allowing the Covernment of Lebanen to restore its sovereign authority over a significant portion of its territory.
 - -- The Government of Israel has reiterated its position previously expressed authoritatively and at the highest levels. This is that the projected redeployment of Israeli forces is in no way intended to bring about a division of Lebanon. Division of Lebanon would clearly be against the national interest of Israel, which forsees as in its best interests a free and independent Lebanon, with a strong central government capable of maintaining security throughout its sovereign territory, thereby assuring the security of Israel's northern border and fulfilling the objectives of the Agreement.
 - -- The Government of Israel of course hopes that the Agreement will come into force as soon as possible.

SUMMARY: FOLLOWING MCFARLANE'S CLARIFICATION OF CONTINUING U.S. INTEREST IN DEVELOPMENT OF FORMULA FOR COMMITMENT TO CONDITIONAL TARGET DATE FOR IDF WITHDRAWAL, FOREIGN MINISTER SHAMIR AGREED TO CONSIDER ANY FORMULAE WHICH LEBANESE MIGHT PROPOSE. SUBJECT WILL BE DISCUSSED AT TRIPARTITE MEETING IN BEIRUT TONIGHT. END SUMMARY.

3. AMBASSADORS MC FARLANE, FAIRBANKS AND LEWIS AND TEICHER MET WITH FOREIGN MINISTER SHAMIR, KIMCHE AND BAR-ON FOR ONE HOUR AUGUST 4. MC FARLANE EXPLAINED THAT EFFORT TO FIND FORMULA FOR COMMITMENT TO WITH-DRAWAL PROCESS WITH ARBITRARY TARGET DATE WAS NOT AIMED AT IMPOSING NEW OBLIGATIONS ON ISRAEL. RATHER. WORKING TO DEVISE PUBLIC FORMULA WHICH WOULD HELP GEMAYEL WITH THE LEBANESE FACTIONS. U.S. SIDE HAD NOT, HOWEVER, DEVELOPED SATISFACTORY PROPOSALS FOR PRESENTA-TION TO THE FOREIGN MINISTER. SHAMIR, AWARE THAT SUBJECT HAD BEEN RAISED EARLIER WITH PM BEGIN, EXPRESSED SURPRISE THAT MC FARLANE HAD NOT BROUGHT A NEW FORMULA.

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AT THIS POINT, AMBASSADOR LEWIS REVIEWED HISTORY OF RECENT WASHINGTON TALKS TO REMIND SHAMIR THAT EFFORT TO DEVISE THIS FORMULA HAD BEGUN IN WASHINGTON. I.E. SECRETARY SHULTZ'S INITIATIVE REGARDING THE SO-CALLED ARENS PLAN. SHAMIR HAD SAID IT WOULD BE DISCUSSED UPON HIS RETURN TO JERUSALEM, EVEN THOUGH IT WOULD PROBABLY NOT BE USEFUL.

4. SHAMIR SAID THAT HE "WOULD BE OPEN TO ANY IDEAS OR PROPOSALS WHICH COULD BE USEFUL," BUT HE DID NOT SEE HOW THIS COULD CONTRIBUTE TO CHANGING THE SYRIAN MIND. OR WHY THE GOL REMAINS UNCONVINCED OF GOI INTENTIONS. LEWIS EXPLAINED SYRIAN DIMENSION BY REFERRING TO THE DISTINCTION BETWEEN WITHDRAWAL IN THE WEST VICE WITH-DRAWAL IN THE BIOA. MOREOVER, COMMITMENT TO WITHDRAWAL TARGET DATE WOULD HAVE MAJOR POSITIVE EFFECT ON SHIA IN THE SOUTH. MC FARLANE ADDED THAT GOL DOESN'T DOUBT GOI INTENTION; IT IS A POPULAR PROBLEM WITH THE PUBLIC. FURTHERMORE, WHAT IS SOUGHT IS NOT A TIMETABLE IN THE TRADITIONAL SENSE. INSTEAD, TRYING TO DEVISE "A PROCESS OF WITHDRAWAL WHICH COULD BE CONTEMPLATED IN 4-5 MONTHS THAT EXPRESSES A VISION OF THE FUTURE. THIS WOULD PERMIT GOL TO SAY HOW ISRAEL WILL WITHDRAW IN A NEW MANNER. SHAMIR RESPONDED, "LET THEM PROPOSE A FORMULA." KIMCHE SAID THERE ARE TWO CONDITIONS AND ISRAEL WILL LEAVE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE: ALL FOREIGN FORCES MUST LEAVE AND THERE MUST BE ADEQUATE SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS. IT COULD BE DONE IN THREE MONTHS IF SYRIANS LEAVE. FAIRBANKS EXPLAINED WE ARE NOT SEEKING CHANGE IN POLICY, RATHER A CHANGE IN THE PRESENTATION OF POLICY FOR TACTICAL REASONS.

5. SHAMIR SAID ANY DECLARATION MUST MENTION THE LEBANON-ISRAEL AGREEMENT. BUT REGARDING SEPARATE WITHDRAWAL IN THE WEST AND EAST, SHAMIR FOUND IT "HARD TO CONCEIVE ISRAEL COULD AGREE DUE TO SECURITY REASONS. PLO WOULD TRY TO GET AT THE IDF FROM THE WEST. THIS WOULD NOT BE A GOOD PROPOSAL. FAIRBANKS SAID THAT U.S. WOULD NOT CONTEMPLATE A PROPOSAL TEAT DID NOT PROVIDE FOR SECURITY. GOL MUST MEET CONDITIONS OR NOTHING WOULD HAPPEN. SHAMIR AGAIN COMPLAINED THAT GOL IS NOT READY TO IMPLEMENT ITS SHARE OF AGREEMENT, BUT WANTS ISRAEL TO WITHDRAW ANYWAY. MC FARLANE RE-

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PEATED HOW THE FORMULA WOULD BE CONSISTENT WITH AGREE-MENT AND WOULD HELP GEMAYEL. IT WOULD HELP BREAK THE MIND SET OF PARTITION."

SUMMARY: AMBASSADORS MCFARLANE, LEWIS AND FAIRBANKS MET FOR ONE HOUR AUGUST 4 WITH PRIME MINISTER BEGIN TO REVIEW MCFARLANE'S DISCUSSIONS IN LEBANON AND TO OUTLINE OUR THINKING ON HOW TO PROCEED WITH THE LEBANESE ON REDEPLOYMENT. MCFARLANE RE-EMPHASIZED LEBANON'S FIRM COMMITMENT TO THE AGREEMENT AND ITS IMPLEMENTATION, AS WELL AS LEBANON'S RECOGNITION THAT THE MAJOR PROBLEM FACING US NOW IS HOW TO ACHIEVE SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL. HE NOTED LEBANON'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ISRAEL'S DECISION TO REDEPLOY, BUT EMPHASIZED THAT THE FRAGILE POLITICAL SITUATION IN LEBANON MAKES IT IMPERATIVE THAT REDEPLOYMENT TAKE PLACE IN A FASHION TO SERVE OUR MUTUAL GOALS. MCFARLANE OUTLINED THE LEBANESE DESIRE TO FIND A FORMULA WHEREIN REDEPLOYMENT WILL BECOME PART OF A CONTINUOUS PROCESS OF WITHDRAWAL AND ONE WHICH CAN BE CAST WITHIN THE CONTEXT OF FULL WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AGREEMENT AND IN RECOGNITION OF ISRAEL'S SECURITY REQUIREMENTS. BEGIN RESPONDED WITH THREE QUESTIONS: WHY DOES THE GOVERNMENT OF LEBANON REFUSE TO EXCHANGE INSTRUMENTS OF RATIFICATION; WHY HAVE

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THE LEBANESE REFUSED TO CALL PUBLICLY FOR SYRIA'S WITHDRAWAL; AND HOW CAN ISRAEL BE EXPECTED TO ACCEPT THE LEBANESE SUGGESTION FOR A PROCESS OF WITHDRAWAL ON THE COAST TO THE INTERNATIONAL BORDER WHEN THIS CAN ENDANGER ISRAEL'S NORTHERN POPULATION WHILE ENHANCING SYRIA'S POSITION. FOLLOWING PROTRACTED DISCUSSIONS OF THESE ISSUES, BEGIN ASKED THAT MCFARLANE RE-EMPHASIZE ISRAEL'S CONCERNS TO THE LEBANESE. END SUMMARY.

3. AMBASSADORS MCFARLANE, LEWIS AND FAIRBANKS AND EMBASSY NOTETAKER MET FOR ONE HOUR AUGUST 4
AATH PRIME MINISTER BEGIN IN HIS JERUSALEM OFFICE.
BEGIN WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MATITYAHU SHMUELEVITZ,
DIRECTOR GENERAL OF HIS OFFICE; DAN MERIDOR, CABINET SPOKESMAN; AND URI PORAT, BEGIN'S PRESS ADVISOR.
AT THE OUTSET MCFARLANE CONVEYED THE PRESIDENT'S WARMEST PERSONAL GREETINGS TO BEGIN. BEGIN TOOK NOTE OF WHAT HE TERMED FRUITFUL DISCUSSIONS IN WASHINGTON DURING THE SHAMIR/ARENS VISIT.

4. REVIEWING HIS MEETINGS IN BEIRUT. MCFARLANE SAID THAT HE HAD DRAWN TWO IMPORTANT CONCLUSIONS: FIRST. THE LEBANESE REMAIN FIRMLY COMMITTED TO THE AGREEMENT AND ITS IMPLEMENTATION. AND THEY RECOGNIZE THAT THE MOST PRESSING CURRENT PROBLEM IS HOW TO ACHIEVE SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL. SECOND. HE SAID. THE LEBANESE ACKNOWLEDGE ISRAEL'S DECISION TO REDEPLOY BUT WANT TO ASSURE THAT IT TAKES PLACE IN A FASHION WHICH WILL SERVE THE DUAL GOALS OF ACHIEVING THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES WHILE REINFORCING THE POSITION OF THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT. MCFARLANE SAID THAT THE U.S. IS CONVINCED OF LEBANON'S GOOD FAITH COMMITMENT TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENT. THE DISAGREEMENT BETWEEN ISRAEL AND LEBANON ON THE TIMING OF IMPLEMENTATION IS MOTIVATED BY LEBANON'S SENSE OF HOW THIS WILL AFFECT OUR ABILITY TO MOVE THE SYRIANS OUT. THE LEBANESE BELIEVE THAT THE EXCHANGE OF THE INSTRUMENTS OF RATIFICATION. THE IMMEDIATE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT AND A FORMAL, PUBLIC CALL ON SYRIA TO WITHDRAW WOULD INCREASE THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT'S INTERNAL VULNERABILITY. MCFARLANE NOTED SINCERE LEBANESE EFFORTS TO ACHIEVE RECONCILIATION WITH THE VARIOUS

CONFESSIONAL FACTIONS; WHILE WE MAY DESIRE MORE VIGOROUS ACTIVITY. THE LEBANESE ARE MOVING IN THIS DIRECTION. IN THIS CONTEXT, MCFARLANE NOTED, ISRAEL'S DECISION TO REDEPLOY HAS HELPED ACCELERATE LEBANESE RECONCILIATION EFFORTS IN THE SHUF. HE NOTED THAT PRESIDENT GEMAYEL HAD TASKED WADI HADDAD TO HOLD INTENSIVE TALKS WITH THE DRUZE LEADERSHIP. AND THAT HADDAD IS CONFIDENT HE CAN SUCCEED IN MEETING DRUZE INTERESTS AND REACHING AN ACCOMMODATION TO PREVENT CONFLICT IN THE SHUF. THE LEBANESE ALSO REAFFIRMED CONFIDENCE IN THEIR ABILITY TO ACHIEVE THE COMPLIANCE OF THE LEBANESE FORCES IN THE SHUF AND TO INTRODUCE THE LEBANESE ARMY INTO THE AREA PEACEFULLY.

- MCFARLANE SAID THAT LEBANON'S MILITARY TRAINING PROGRAM HAS REGISTERED MODERATE PROGRESS IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THREE BRIGADES WHICH WILL BE ADEQUATE FOR DEFENSIVE PURPOSES. HE SAID THAT WITHIN SIX TO EIGHT WEEKS WE ARE CONFIDENT THAT THE LEBANESE CAN INSERT THE ARMY INTO THE SHUF TO PERFORM A DEFENSIVE MISSION IN A SUITABLE POLITICAL CLIMATE.
- DESPITE GEMAYEL'S COMMITMENT TO THE AGREEMENT. HE IS ACUTELY CONSCIOUS OF RAPID POLITICAL DISINTEGRATION THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. OUTSIDE BEIRUT THERE HAS BEEN INTENSE PROPAGANDA BY THE SYRIANS AND OTHER ARAB ELEMENTS TO CREATE THE PERCEPTION THAT THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT IS NOT REPRESENTATIVE AND IS SUBSERVIENT TO THE WILL AND POWER OF ITS NEIGHBORS. THE PERCEPTION HAS ALSO BEEN FOSTERED THAT REDEPLOYMENT OF ISRAELI FORCES MEANS LEBANON'S PERMANENT PARTITION. THE U.S. AND LEBANON'S LEADERSHIP UNDERSTAND ISRAEL'S EMPHATIC COMMITMENT TO FULL WITHDRAWAL, FEARS AND DOUBTS PERSIST AMONG THE LEBANESE POPULATION.
 - MCFARLANE SAID THAT GEMAYEL NOW ACCEPTS REDEPLOYMENT AS AN OPPORTUNITY TO ACHIEVE OUR COMMON GOALS AND STRENGTHEN CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY. HOWEVER. IN VIEW OF PUBLIC PERCEPTIONS THAT REDEPLOYMENT HAS BEEN FOISTED BY ISRAEL ON LEBANON AND THAT IT IS A PRELUDE TO PARTITION, GEMAYEL BELIEVES IT NECESSARY TO PORTRAY REDEPLOYMENT WITHIN A CONTEXT OF A PROCESS LEADING TO TOTAL WITHDRAWAL. THE QUESTION APPEARS TO BE ONE OF PUBLIC PRESENTATION. GEMAYEL HOPES WE CAN FIND A FORMULA WHICH WILL PRESENT REDEPLOYMENT IN SUCH A WAY SO THAT IT CAN HELP LEGITIMIZE HIS PARTICIPATION IN THE PROCESS AND STRENGTHEN HIS AUTHORITY.
 - IN RESPONSE TO MCFARLANE'S PRESENTATION. BEGIN POSED THREE QUESTIONS:
 - IF THE LEBANESE HAVE EXHIBITED "SO MUCH GOOD WILL", (A) WHY HAVE THEY REFUSED TO EXCHANGE THE INSTRUMENTS OF RATIFICATION WHICH. ACCORDING TO THE RULES OF INTERNATIONAL LAW, IS NECESSARY TO BRING THE AGREEMENT

INTO EFFECT? BEGIN SAID THAT THE LEBANESE HAVE REFUSED TO DO THIS FOR FEAR OF PROVOKING THE SYRIANS. BUT HAVE NOT EXPLAINED HOW THE EXCHANGE OF INSTRUMENTS OF RATIFICATION WOULD NOT HELP ACHIEVE THE GOAL OF WITHDRAWING ALL FOREIGN FORCES.

- B) IF THE LEBANESE HAVE ACCEPTED THAT ISRAEL'S FINAL WITHDRAWAL WOULD BE CONDITIONED ON THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL OTHER FORCES, WHY HAVE THE LEBANESE REFUSED TO CALL ON THE SYRIANS AND PLO PUBLICLY AND DIRECTLY TO WITHDRAW?
- C) BEGIN SAID THAT SHAMIR HAD REPORTED TO HIM A LEBANESE PROPOSAL THAT ISRAEL BEGIN EVACUATING THE WESTERN SECTOR TO THE INTERNATIONAL BORDER. IF ISRAEL WERE TO ACCEPT THIS, THE GALILEE WOULD BE IN GREAT DANGER AND THE IDF WOULD BE THREATENED BY ATTACKS FROM THE SYRIANS AND PLO ON ALL SIDES. BEGIN SAID THAT SHAMIR HAD BEEN SURPRISED TO HEAR THIS PROPOSAL, SINCE IT HAD NOT BEEN RAISED DURING THE WASHINGTON TALKS.
- 9. LEWIS RESPONDED THAT THERE MUST BE SOME FAILURE

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OF COMMUNICATION. SINCE THE IDEA HAD BEEN RAISED SEVERAL TIMES DURING THE TALKS IN WASHINGTON, BOTH BY SECRETARY SHULTZ AND IN MORE GENERAL TERMS BY THE PRESIDENT. LEWIS SAID THAT THE GOL HAS AN INTERNAL POLITICAL REQUIREMENT TO DEMONSTRATE TO ITS CLTIZENS THAT REDEPLOYMENT IS THE FIRST OF SEVERAL PHASES OF WITHDRAWAL TO THE BORDER WITHIN SOME KIND OF TIMETABLE. THE LEBANESE RECOGNIZE THAT SYRIA WOULD ALSO HAVE TO WITHDRAW BEFORE ISRAEL WITHDRAWS COMPLETELY. THE PROPOSAL, THEREFORE, IS TO ESTABLISH A GENERAL TIME-TABLE FOR PHASED ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL WEST OF THE MOUNTAINS, WITH FINAL ISRAELI WITEDRAWAL FROM THE BEKA'A CONDITIONED ON SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL. IF THIS COULD BE ACCOMPLISHED, IT WOULD HELP LEBANON OVERCOME REAL PSYCHOLOGICAL AND POLITICAL PROBLEMS. LEWIS EMPHASIZED THAT SECRETARY SHULTZ HAD RAISED THIS SEVERAL TIMES IN GENERAL TERMS. ALTHOUGH SHAMIR HAD EXPRESSED STRONG RESERVATIONS. WHEN THE FINAL MEETING WITH SHAMIR AND ARENS HAD ENDED BEFORE THE SECRETARY HAD BEEN ABLE TO COMPLETE THE DISCUSSION OF OUR SUGGESTED APPROACH. WE HAD CONTINUED TO EXPLAIN THE CONCEPT IN A FOLLOW-ON MEETING WITH ROSENNE, BAR-ON, NETANYAHU AND EINAN. MCFARLANE ADDED THAT THIS PROPOSAL WOULD LEND CONCRETENESS TO THE PROCESS OF WITHDRAWAL AND YET WOULD CONDITION FINAL WITHDRAWAL ON PLO AND SYRIAN RESPONSES AND ON THE ADEQUACY OF LEBANESE ARMY PERFORMANCE IN THE EVACUATED AREAS.

10. REFERRING TO BEGIN'S QUESTIONS, MCFARLANE NOTED THE FRAGILITY OF THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT'S POSITION AND ITS SENSITIVITY TO ACTIONS WHICH. IF PROVEN INEFFECTIVE, WOULD DEMONSTRATE ITS IMPOTENCE. THE LEBANESE DO NOT WANT THE EXCHANGE OF INSTRUMENTS OF RATIFICATION AND A PUBLIC CALL ON THE SYRIANS TO WITHDRAW TO BE A RHETORICAL EXERCISE. BELIEVE THAT, AT THIS TIME, BECAUSE OF SYRIAN INTRANSIGENCE, THESE ACTIONS WILL NOT CHANGE THE STATUS QUO. MCFARLANE SAID THAT GEMAYEL HAD TOLD HIM THAT THE LETTER TO THE SYRIANS HAS BEEN WRITTEN. AND THAT HE IS COMMITTED TO SENDING IT AT A TIME WHEN IT WILL BE REINFORCED BY SUPPORT FROM ARABS AND OTHERS TO MOVE THE SYRIANS TO WITHDRAW. MCFARLANE SAID WE RECOGNIZE THAT THE ISSUE OF TIMING CANNOT BE OPEN-ENDED. AND THAT HE SEES HIS MISSION TO WORK WITH THE LEBANESE AND ISRAELIS TO ACHIEVE RESULTS IN AS SHORT A TIME AS POSSIBLE.

^{11.} BEGIN REITERATED THE NEED TO EXCHANGE INSTRUMENTS OF RATIFICATION IMMEDIATELY SO AS NOT TO BACK AWAY FROM THE MUTUAL COMMITMENT OF BRINGING THE AGREEMENT INTO EFFECT. HE STRESSED THAT THIS IS AN IMPORTANT ISSUE FOR ISRAEL, AND THAT ISRAEL SEES CONTRADICTION IN THE LEBANESE PROCLAIMING COMPLETE FAITHFULNESS TO THE AGREEMENT WHILE REFUSING TO PUT IT INTO EFFECT. HE ASKED MCFARLANE TO RAISE THIS ISSUE AGAIN DURING HIS NEXT VISIT TO BEIRUT.

^{12.} TURNING TO BEGIN'S SECOND QUESTION, MCFARLANE

REPEATED THAT THE LEBANESE BELIEVE THAT THE TIMING OF THEIR FORMAL CALL ON THE SYRIANS TO WITHDRAW SHOULD BE KEYED TACTICALLY TO THE POINT AT WHICH THEY CAN RALLY SUPPORT FROM OTHERS TO HELP INFLUENCE SYRIA'S DECISION. MCFARLANE SAID HE DOES NOT BELIEVE THAT GEMAYEL IS USING THIS AS A PRETEXT FOR INDEFINITE DELAY. THERE HAS BEEN SOME MOVEMENT IN ARAB CIRCLES IN AGREEING THAT SYRIA MUST WITHDRAW. TODAY A PUBLIC LEBANESE STATEMENT MIGHT HAVE NO POLITICAL EFFECT EXCEPT TO DEMONSTRATE ITS OWN WEAKNESS; AT THE PROPER MOMENT, IT COULD BE AN OPPORTUNITY TO ELICIT BROADER SUPPORT.

13. BEGIN CONTRASTED ISRAEL'S OPENLY DECLARED INTENTION TO WITHDRAW WITH SYRIA'S CATEGORICAL REFUSAL TO WITHDRAW. HE SAID THAT, IF THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT DOES NOT MAKE PUBLIC ITS DEMAND OF THE SYRIANS TO WITHDRAW, IT COULD CREATE THE IMPRESSION THAT THE ISRAELIS ARE THE MAIN IMPEDIMENT AND THAT THE LEBANESE ACQUIESCE TO SYRIA'S POSITION. HE PREDICTED THAT A LEBANESE DEMAND FOR SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL WOULD REVERBERATE IN THE ARAB WORLD. MCFARLANE ACKNOWLEDGED THE SERIOUSNESS OF THIS

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QUESTION, AND SAID THAT HIS TASK IS TO CREATE THE CONDITIONS FOR THIS TO HAPPEN SOON.

14. RETURNING TO THE PROPOSAL FOR AN AGREED FORMULATION ON A WITHDRAWAL PROCESS, MCFARLANE EMPHASIZED THAT THE GOAL IS TO GET THE SYRIANS OUT. ASSURE ISRAELI SECURITY AND DEMONSTRATE LEBANON'S ABILITY TO ACT EFFECTIVELY. POLITICALLY AND MILITARILY. IN EVACUATED AREAS. THE INTENTION IS NOT TO DEFINE PRECISE, SPECIFIC DATES, BUT RATHER TO PORTRAY A PROGRESSIVE PROCESS OF MOVEMENT WHICH WILL NEGATE THE APPEARANCE OF PARTITION. MCFARLANE SAID HE IS AWARE OF ISRAEL'S CONCERNS BOTH WITH REGARD TO THE QUESTIONS OF PRECISION ON TIMETABLES AND THE CONDITIONALITY OF ISRAEL'S WITHDRAWAL ON SYRIAN AND PLO WITHDRAWAL. HE SAID THAT PRESIDENT REAGAN REMAINS COMMITTED TO THE GOALS WHICH ISRAEL AND LEBANON ALSO SHARE.

IN RESPONSE TO BEGIN'S REPEATED EMPHASIS ON THE NEED FOR LEBANON TO CALL PUBLICLY ON SYRIA TO WITHDRAW. LEWIS DIFFERENTIATED BETWEEN A FORMAL CALL FOR WITHDRAWAL AND THE COMMUNICATION THROUGH A VARIETY OF DIPLOMATIC CHANNELS OF LEBANON'S DESIRE THAT THIS OCCUR. THE SYRIAN AND OTHER ARAB LEADERS NOW WILL KNOW THAT LEBANON WANTS SYRIAN FORCES TO LEAVE.

THE QUESTION IS ONLY ONE OF DIPLOMATIC TACTICS, I.E. THE TIMING OF WHEN LEBANON SHOULD MAKE A FORMAL APPEAL TO THE SYPIAAS. LEWIS SAID THAT WE ARE TRYING TO MOBILIZE ARAB PRESSURES ON SYRIA AND TO COORDINATE THE RIGHT MOMENT FOR GEMAYEL'S PUBLIC APPEAL TO THE SYRIANS. ONE WAY OF ENHANCING THE INCENTIVES FOR SYRIA TO WITHDRAW IS TO DEVELOP A PACKAGE OF LEBANESE, ISRAELI, ARAB AND U.S.-IMPLIED PRESSURES WHICH ARE DESIGNED TO CHANGE ASSAD'S MIND. LEWIS SAID THAT IT IS A MISPERCEPTION TO ARGUE, AS BEGIN DID. THAT THE ONLY ITEM ON LEBANON'S AGENDA IS ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL. HE RECALLED THAT FOREIGN MINISTER SALEM HAD GONE TO DAMASCUS ONLY TO BE REBUFFED, AND THAT, WHILE THE PUBLIC DIALOGUE HAS NOT APPARENTLY FOCUSED ON SYRIA. THE MAJOR ITEM IN PRIVATE DIPLOMACY HAS BEEN THE ISSUE OF SYRIAN WITHDRAWAL. FAIRBANKS ADDED THAT THE LEBANESE HAVE, IN FACT, ASKED SYRIA TO WITHDRAW PUBLICLY IN SEVERAL FORA. INCLUDING THE FEZ SUMMIT. LEWIS SAID THAT THE LEBANESE TACTICAL JUDGMENT IS THAT THE MORE ASSAD IS CONFRONTED PUBLICLY. THE LESS LIKELY HE IS TO CHANGE HIS MIND.

AS THE MEETING CONCLUDED BEGIN ASKED FOR MCFARLANE'S ASSESSMENT OF DRUZE-CHRISTIAN RELATIONS AND WHETHER THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT IS PREPARED TO MOVE INTO THE SHUF FOLLOWING ISRAEL'S REDEPLOYMENT. MCFARLANE RESPONDED THAT GEMAYEL IS WELL AWARE OF THE POTENTIAL FOR VIOLENCE IN THE SHUF. HADDAD HAS BEEN WORKING ON REACHING A FORMULA WHICH WILL DEAL WITH DRUZE POLITICAL INTERESTS WHILE

ASSURING THEIR SAFETY, AND HE IS OPTIMISTIC ABOUT HIS CHANCES OF SUCCESS. THE GOL HAS THE COMMITMENT OF THE LEBANESE FORCES TO LAY DOWN THEIR ARMS WHEN THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT ASKS; ITS GOAL IS TO GAIN A SIMILAR COMMITMENT FROM THE DRUZE. BEGIN WISHED MCFARLANE SUCCESS FOR HIS DIFFICULT MISSION.

17. AMBASSADOR MCFARLANE HAS NOT SEEN THIS MESSAGE.
