I. PURPOSE

To fulfill a request from Congressman Fascell for an opportunity to report to the President on his recent trip to the Soviet Union on which he was accompanied by Congressman Broomfield.

II. BACKGROUND

During the Easter Congressional Recess, Congressman Dante Fascell (D-Florida), Chairman of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, and Congressman William Broomfield (R-Michigan), Ranking Republican on the House Foreign Affairs Committee, traveled to Moscow and Leningrad. During their visit, they met with Soviet Premier Gorbachev. Congressman Fascell felt it important to report directly to you upon their return.

-- Dante, Bill, thank you for coming down this morning to share with me your reactions from your visit to the Soviet Union. I'll bet you still have jet lag.

-- I am anxious to hear your report, please proceed.

[General Discussion]

-- This is an important time in our relations with the Soviet Union, so I am really grateful to have your observations.

-- Before you leave, let me thank both of you personally for your support last month in behalf of the freedom fighters in Nicaragua. We shall have another vote very soon. This time we must win and I hope you will both continue to be in the forefront of our efforts to secure a favorable vote in the House.

-- Thank you again. We shall keep in close touch.
