Information has just been received confirming that Roh Tae Woo, the ruling Democratic Justice Party nominee for President of the Republic of Korea, will visit Washington September 14, 15 and 16. A busy schedule of speeches and appearances is being organized, but a brief call on the President is the most critical item. It can be short (ten minutes maximum) and at anytime on those dates. A Schedule Proposal is at Tab A.

State will send a memorandum in support of Roh's courtesy call, and I strongly support it, recognizing the visit scheduling constraints that exist.

For your information as a possible future matter, in the event that the Korean opposition candidate (not yet selected, but presumably Kim Young Sam or Kim Dae Jung) comes to Washington, we would have to make every reasonable effort to afford similar treatment.

SUBJECT: Request for Call on You by Foreign Minister Choi Kwang Soo of the Republic of Korea

The Korean Ambassador called today to inform me of a "private visit" by Foreign Minister Choi to Washington on Thursday/Friday, October 1 and 2. He asks, if possible, that you see Minister Choi.

I strongly support the recommendation. Although Choi is seen as "Chun's Foreign Minister" he is an experienced and very bright technocrat/diplomat. Choi is about 52 and was, for example, Vice Minister of Defense at 34. In New York he will be managing, in particular, the Republic's approaches to North Korea on Olympics and other issues. Initially, it was expected that Choi would ask to call on the President, but the Roh Tae Woo visit used up their credit in the Oval Office.

RECOMMENDATION:

That you approve a 30-minute call by Minister Choi Kwang Soo.

As you see at Tab A, we do have Kim Young Sam's letter. State is taking it for action with reply to be sent from there. I had informally gone along with this approach.

Concerning Mr. Narsavage's letter to Tom Griscom, the problem is that "his" Mr. Kim is not yet a presidential candidate. Current reporting notes a breakdown in talks on September 29 over whether Kim Young Sam or Kim Dae Jung will be their party's presidential candidate. They have not even agreed on procedures for settling the nomination question.

Accordingly, I do not recommend a Presidential response to Mr. Kim or any invitation beyond the statements that have already been made.

RECOMMENDATION:

That you explain the above to Tom Griscom.

1. WE HAVE RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING LETTER TO PRESIDENT REAGAN FROM KIM YOUNG SAM, PRESIDENT OF THE REUNIFICATION DEMOCRATIC PARTY. REQUEST THE LETTER BE FORWARDED TO THE WHITE HOUSE AND THAT PRESIDENT REAGAN SEND A RESPONSE.

DEAR MR. PRESIDENT:

I AM HONORED TODAY TO TAKE THIS OCCASION, ON THE DATE OF THE 200TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SIGNING OF THE U.S. CONSTITUTION, TO CONGRATULATE THE AMERICAN PEOPLE ON THEIR BICENTENNIAL CELEBRATION OF THE OLDEST WRITTEN INSTRUMENT OF ENDURING NATIONAL GOVERNMENT.

I KNOW THE KOREAN PEOPLE JOIN ME IN HONORING THE SIGNING OF THE U.S. CONSTITUTION AND THE CREATION OF A FREE AND DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY WHICH THE AMERICAN PEOPLE HAVE SUSTAINED.

WE, THE PEOPLE OF KOREA, ARE ON THE THRESHOLD OF A SIMILAR MIRACLE LIKE THAT WHICH EMERGED FROM INDEPENDENCE HALL IN PHILADELPHIA. IN SIGNING THE U.S. CONSTITUTION, YOUR FOUNDING FATHERS CREATED A CONTRACT WITH THE PEOPLE OF YOUR COUNTRY GUARANTEEING THEM FUNDAMENTAL DEMOCRATIC PRINCIPLES OF GOVERNMENT. HERE IN KOREA, WE ARE EMBARKING ON A SIMILAR QUEST FOR DEMOCRACY.

DR. BENJAMIN FRANKLIN, WHILE WATCHING HIS FELLOW DELEGATES SIGN THE CONSTITUTION ON SEPTEMBER 17, 1787, POINTED TO THE CARVING OF A HALF SUN ON THE CHAIR OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE CONVENTION AND SAID, "NOW I HAVE THE HAPPINESS TO KNOW THAT IT IS A RISING AND NOT A SETTING SUN."

MR. PRESIDENT, WE ALSO HOPE THAT THE KOREAN PEOPLE WILL SOON ENJOY THE SAME LIGHT OF DEMOCRACY WHICH ROSE THIS DAY, 200 YEARS AGO, IN PHILADELPHIA.

Dear Tom:

I can appreciate that you're too busy to return my phone call, so allow me to lay this out in writing.

Lee Verstandig and I have both been volunteering some of our time with an ad hoc committee of Washington lobbyists and businessmen who are interested in promoting the candidacy of Kim Young Sam, a respected advocate of democracy and currently president of South Korea's opposition party, as that country's next president. A member of that group is Mr. Kim's brother-in-law, Dr. Charles Kim.

For background, within the next week to 10 days, Kim Young Sam and his opposition party colleague, Kim Dae Jung, will decide which of them will be the candidate in the December elections, the country's first direct election of a president since 1971. Conventional political wisdom in Korea makes Kim Young Sam the best candidate, with private numbers showing him to be an almost guaranteed winner in December. I think you would find that the State Department has already made its unofficial "choice."

The candidate from the ruling party, hand-picked by President Chun Doo Hwan, is Roh Tae Woo. Mr. Roh visited here last week and met with the President. At the time, Marlin Fitzwater went out of his way to emphasize that the White House had no preference, and that it would be just as accommodating to the opposition candidate.

In at least one small way, you have an opportunity to be just that with Kim Young Sam. Last week--Sept. 17--he sent a telegram to the President, via the NSC wire in our Seoul embassy. It congratulated the U.S. on its celebration of the signing of the Constitution, and expressed the hope that Korea was on the verge of founding a similar history of democracy.

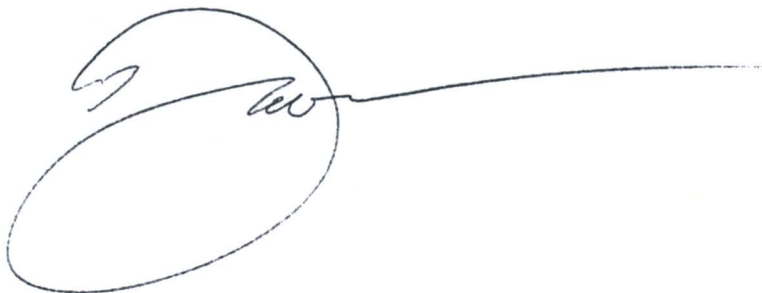

Our request is for a response to Mr. Kim, along with some notification to us of the message's contents. Because we are talking with Mr. Kim now about the advisability of visiting Washington soon after he becomes the candidate, I'd also ask if a general invitation from the President would be appropriate--something along the lines of welcoming whoever is chosen as the party's candidate.

I'm sorry we couldn't talk about this, and I'm sorry if this letter has burdened you with more than you want to know. But I do hope you can be of some assistance to us.

Thanks, Tom. I hope you're well and happy.
