I am fully aware that President Reagan's schedule will be extremely tight since heads of states and government leaders from all over the world will be visiting the United States during that time. If my call on President Reagan could be realized, brief as it may be, it will be the most rewarding part of my visit which I trust will contribute greatly to the further strengthening of friendly ties between our two allies.
