In a July 5 message to King Fahd (Tab B), the President indicated that he looked forward to talks with Saudi Foreign Minister Saud and Syrian Foreign Minister Khaddam later in the month.

Their main goal is to seek U.S. views on Lebanon and report back to the League's Council. However, Saud wishes to use the meeting to address longer-range problems in the region, including the peace process.



I'm sorry to have blindsided you this morning. I had sent the request to the West Coast last week but it obviously did not get to you.

The Saudis have been trying to prevent the radical Arab states from calling for sanctions against the US for our perceived "tilt" toward Israel. To do that, Fahd convened the moderates in Taif last week. The upshot was: 1. to preempt the Tunisian meeting of the Arab league, but also,2 To need something to vent the considerable criticism building up among eventhe moderates.

The vehicle chosen was a round of meeting by deputized foreign ministers to Europe, the Soviet Union and the US. The two guys chosen to come to the US were the Saudi and Syrian foreign ministers—Saud and Khaddam.

They propose to come either the 13th, 14th or 15th. It would require 30min to an hour.

Could we discuss whether and how this might be done?
