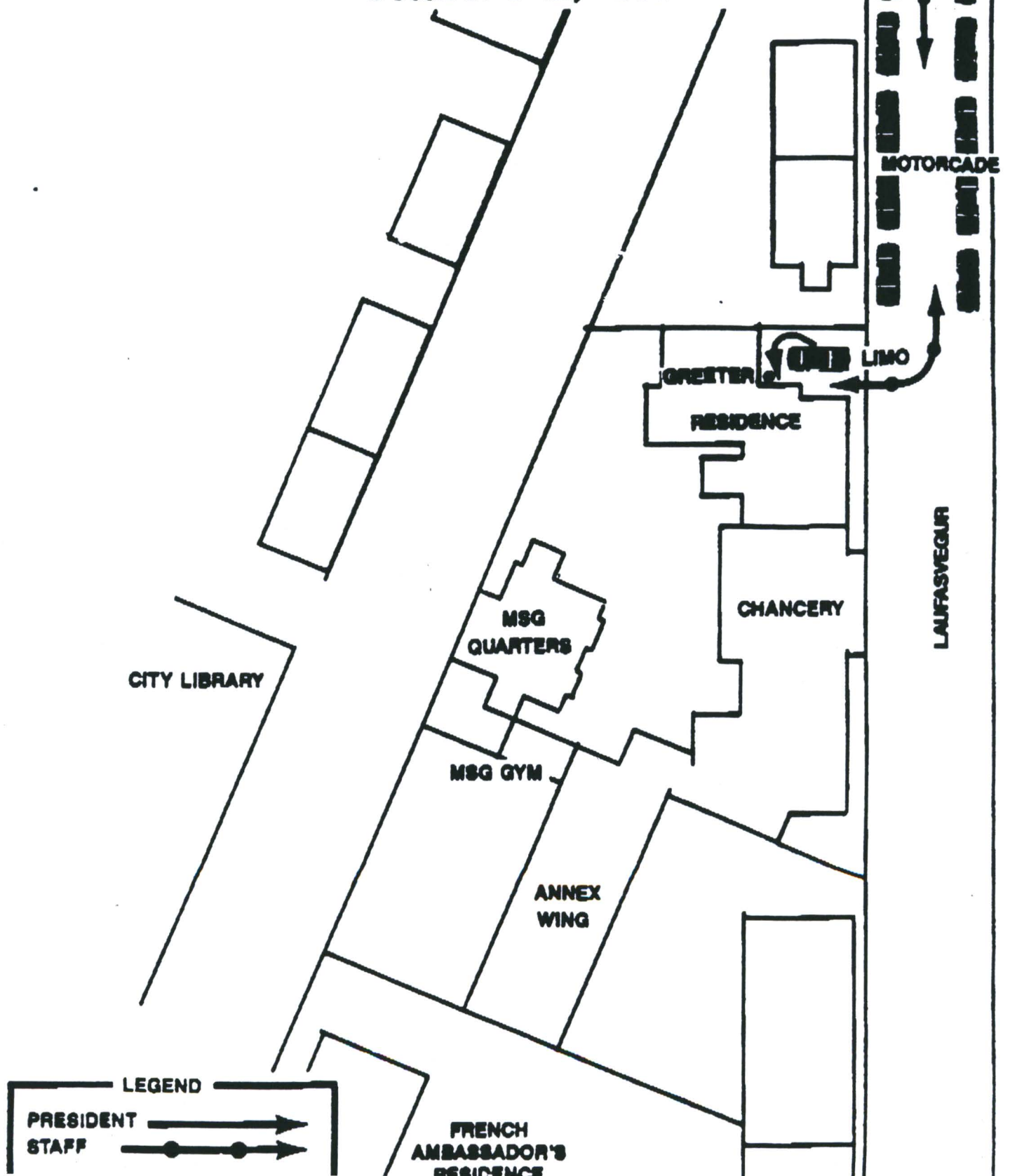
AMBASSADOR'S RESIDENCE GROUND FLOOR

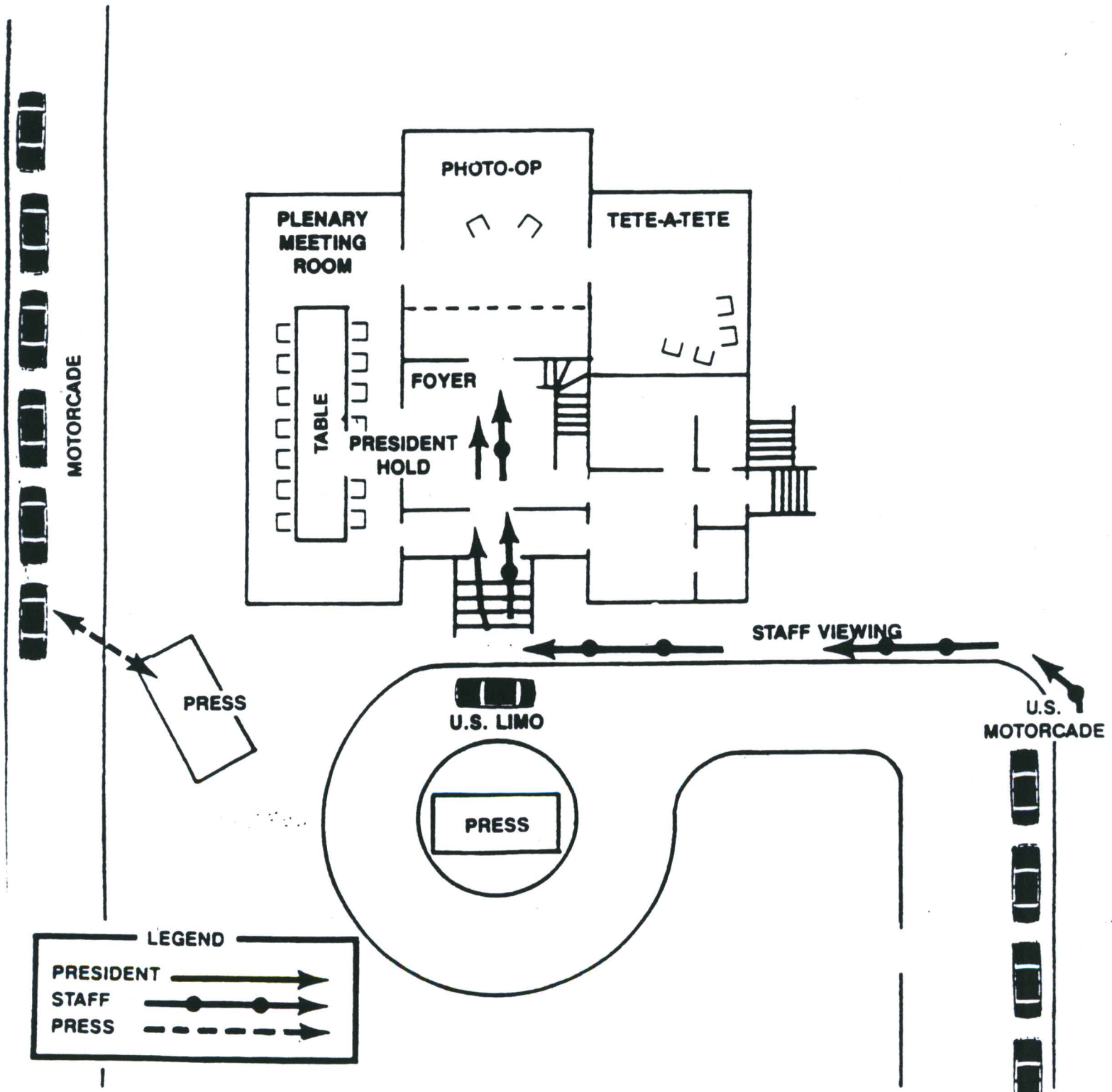
U.S. EMBASSY GROUNDS ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

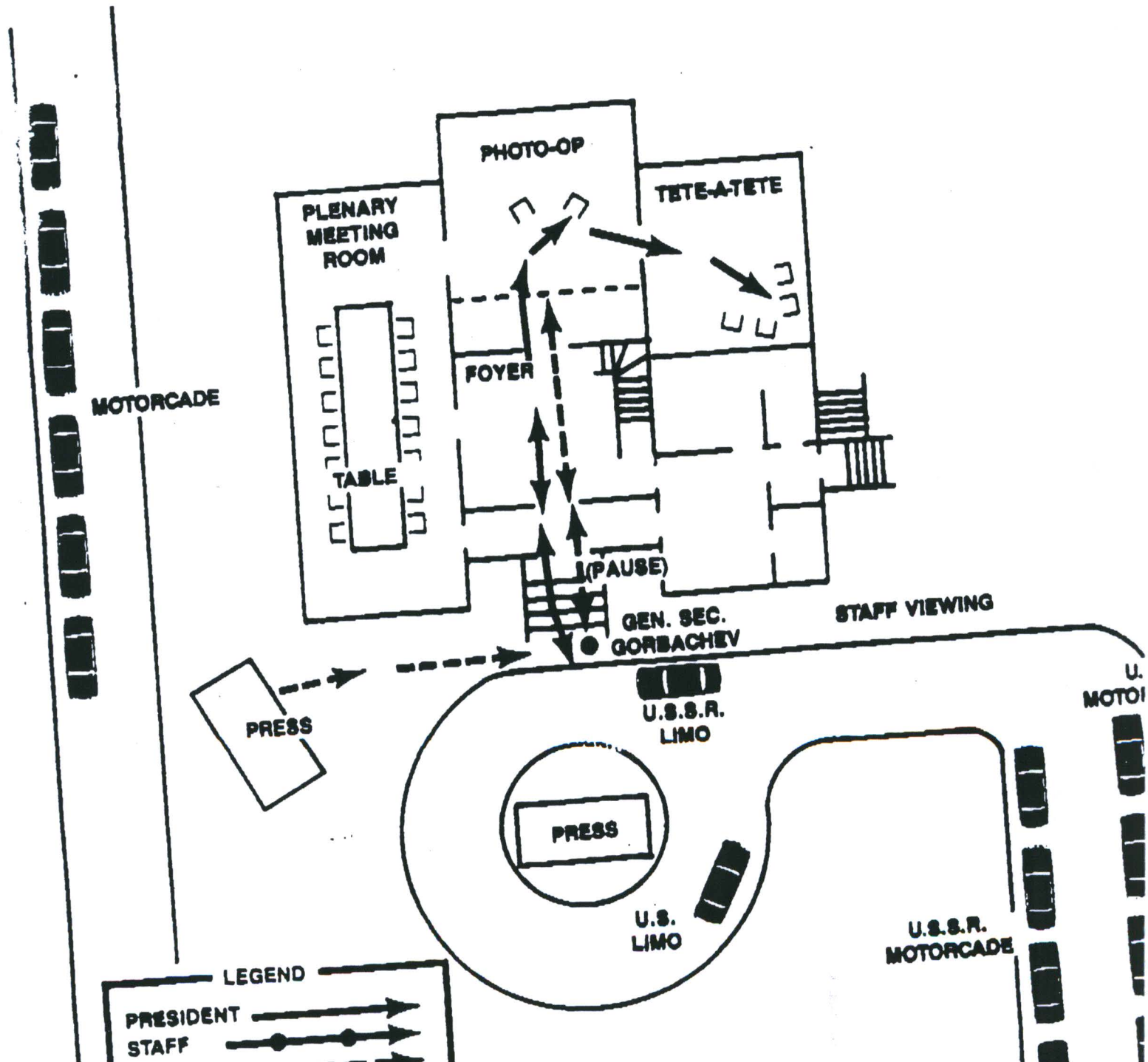
HOFDI HOUSE ARRIVAL AT FIRST MEETING

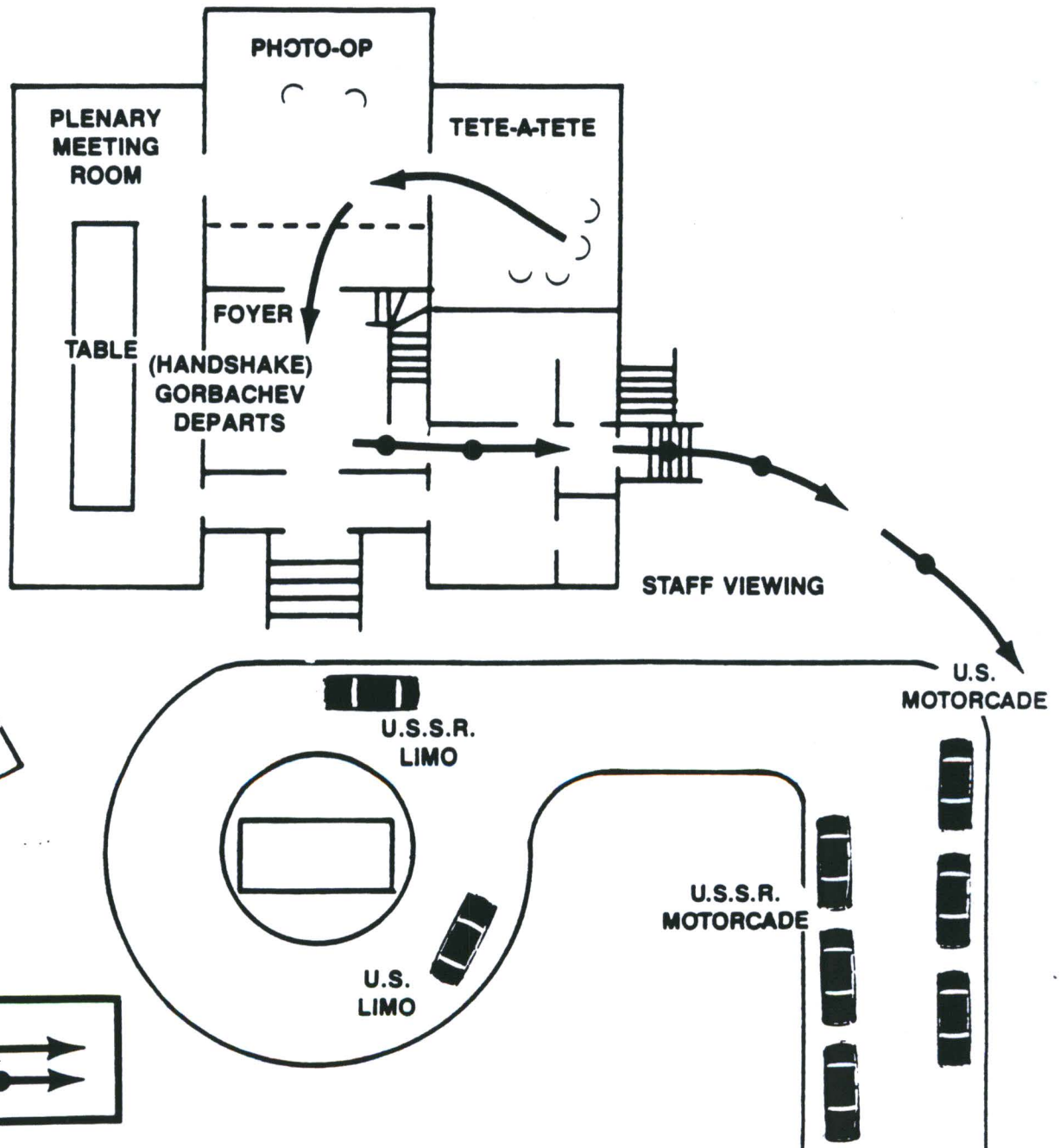

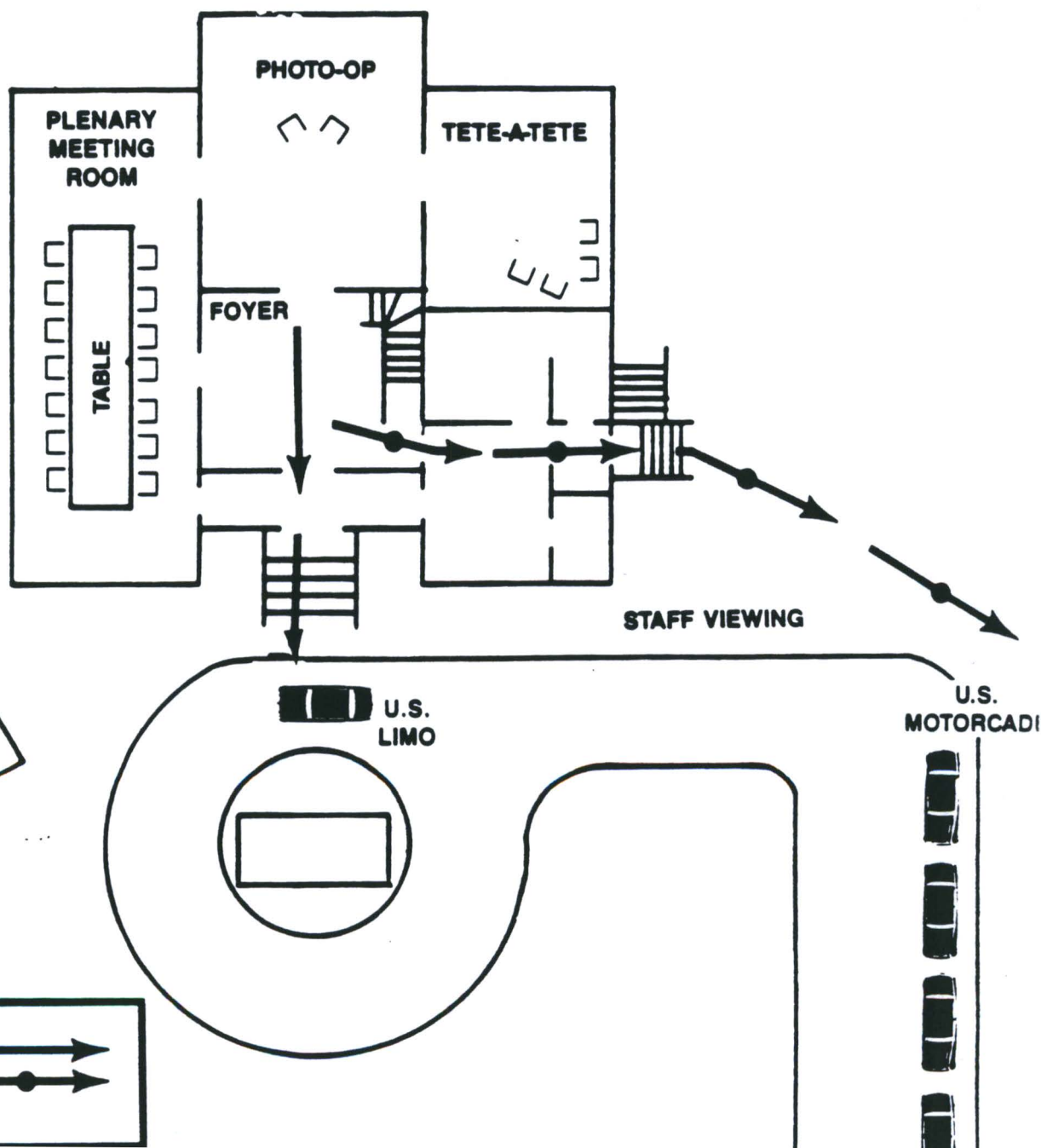

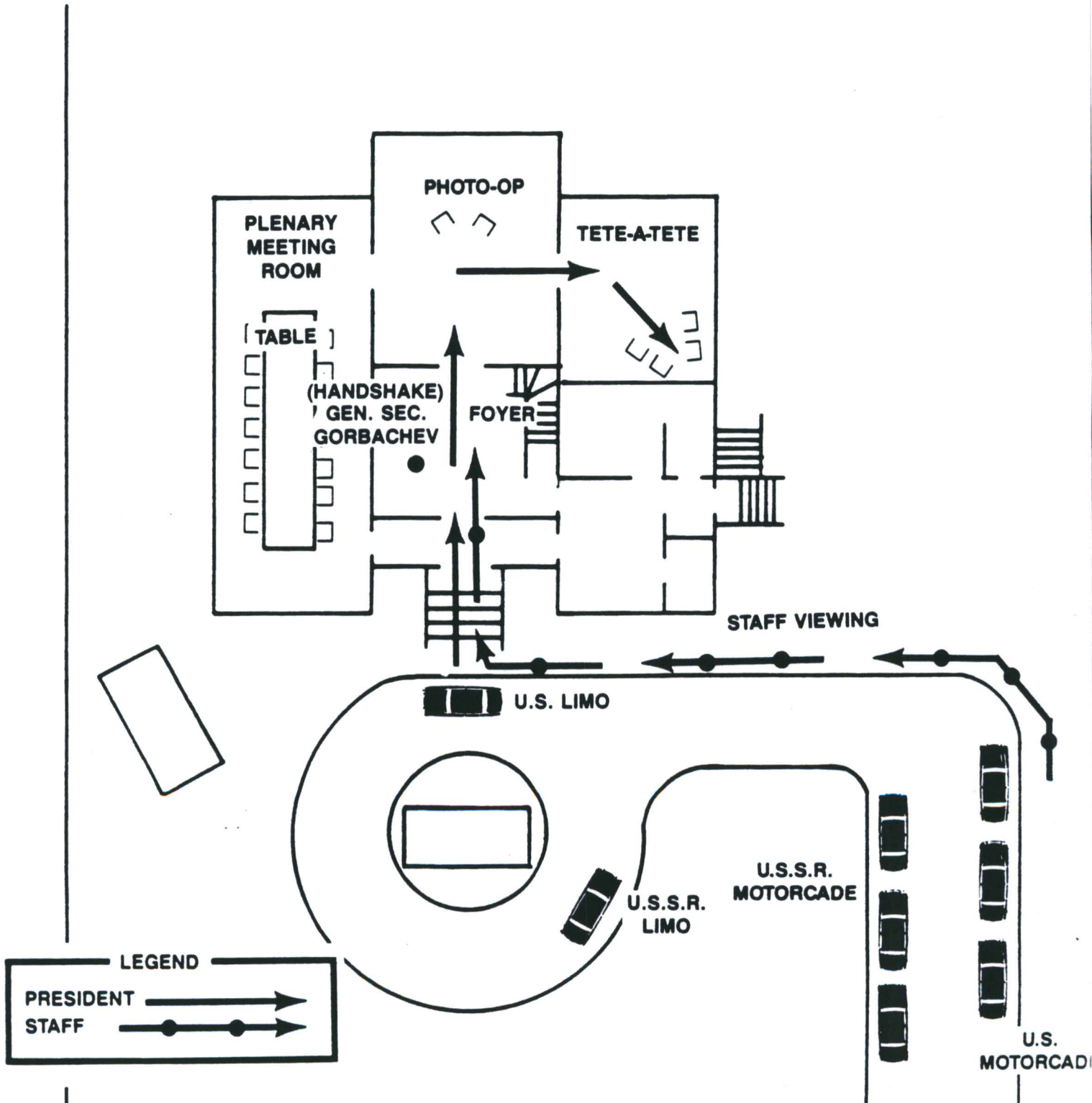
US DEPARTURE FROM FIRST MEETING

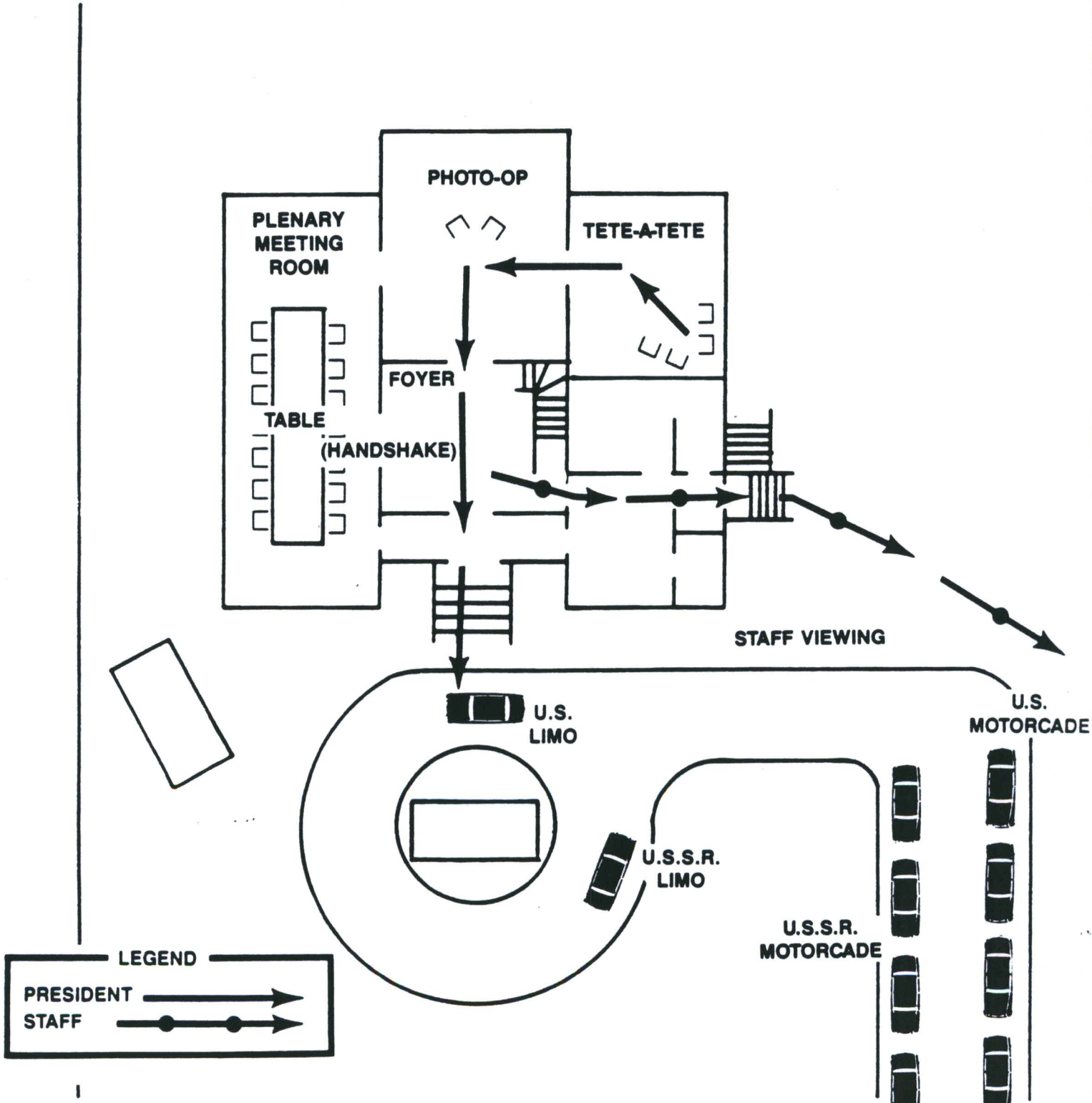
HOFDI HOUSE ARRIVAL, SECOND MEETING

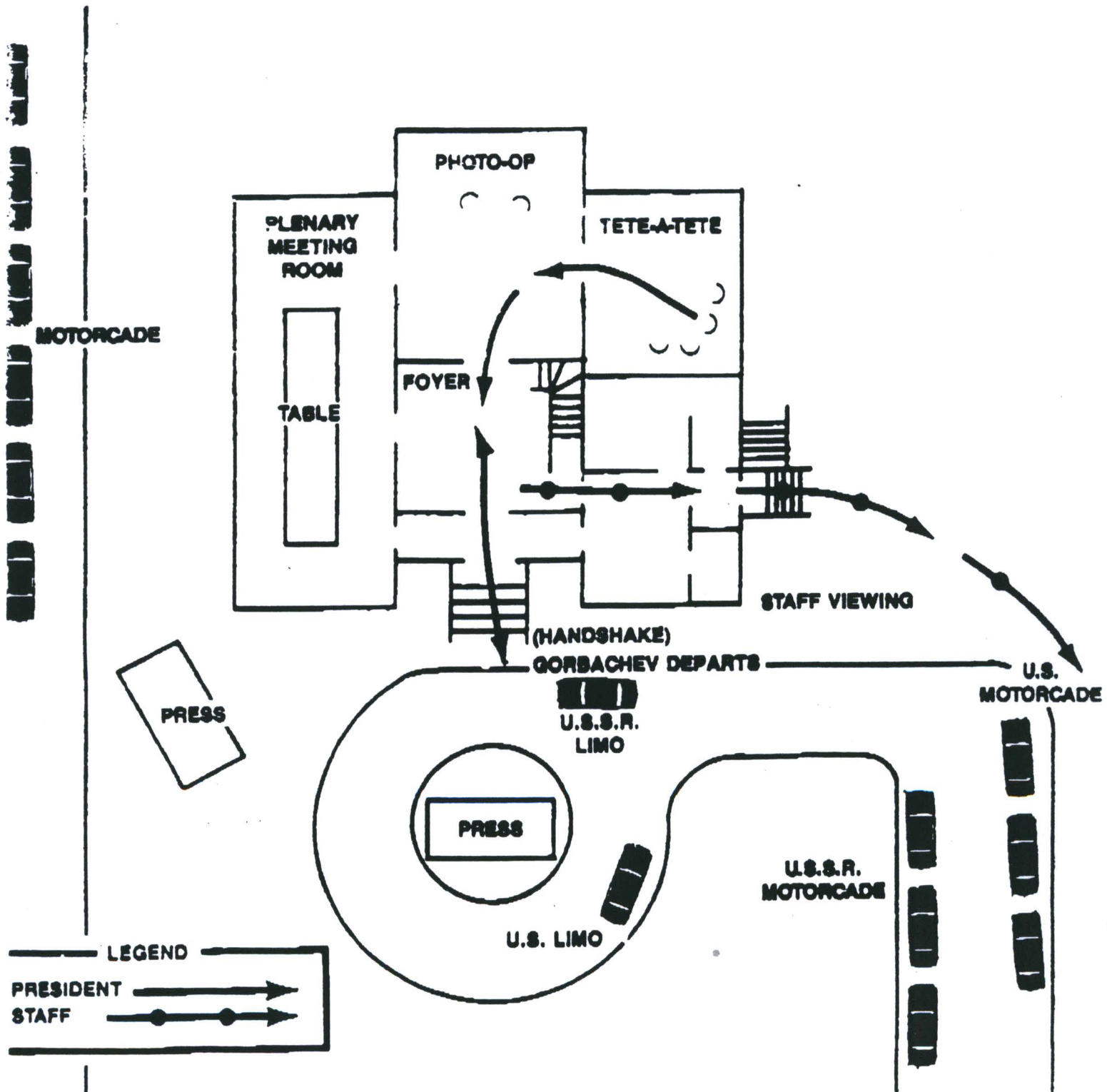
