FROM: JAMES R. STARK

SUBJECT: Freedom of Navigation Program

Attached is the paper I forwarded last week on the freedom of navigation program. You were not available at the time so I cleared it with Paula Dobriansky. It is consistent with our earlier discussion on the need to reduce the frequency of FON programs, particularly with the Soviet Union. Note that, in all probability, operational requirements will generate naval challenges of Soviet claims more often than the two-year guideline specified in the memo. For example, I expect that KENNEL FREELANCE intelligence operations off the Soviet Pacific coast will occur at least annually and will involve penetration of the Soviet baseline claim.
