2. BEGIN SUMMARY. A SIGNIFICANT EXPANSION IN THE SIZE OF THE REPUBLIC CENTRAL COMMITTEES ELECTED AT THE RECENTLY COMPLETED REPUBLIC PARTY CONGRESSES SUGGESTS THAT THE CPSU CENTRAL COMMITTEE MAY BE CONSIDERABLY EXPANDED IN SIZE AT THE XXVI CPSU CONGRESS. THIS APPROACH, WHICH WOULD FULFILL THE PRINCIPLE OF "SYSTEMATIC RENEWAL" OF PARTY BODIES STIPULATED IN THE PARTY STATUTE, WOULD ALLOW THE LEADERSHIP TO BRING A FAR LARGER NUMBER OF NEW MEMBERS INTO THE COMMITTEE THAN WOULD BE POSSIBLE IF THEY RELIED ON PERSONNEL TURNOVER ALONE. END SUMMARY.

3. THE POLITBURO IS ALMOST CERTAIN TO EXPAND THE SIZE OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE AT THE XXVI PARTY CONGRESS. IT HAS DONE SO AT EVERY CONGRESS SINCE THE XIX (1952), IN KEEPING WITH THE PRINCIPLE OF "SYSTEMATIC RENEWAL" OF PARTY BODIES WHICH IS INCORPORATED IN THE CURRENT PARTY STATUTE. THIS PROCEDURE IS ATTRACTIVE TO KREMLIN LEADERS BECAUSE IT ALLOWS THEM TO BRING NEW BLOOD INTO THE NATIONAL LEADERSHIP WITHOUT RESORTING EXCESSIVELY TO THE MORE POLITICALLY PAINFUL PROCESS OF REMOVING INCUMBENTS - - A METHOD THAT HAS NOT BEEN USED FREQUENTLY IN THE BREZHNEV ERA. AT THE LAST FIVE PARTY CON-GRESSES THE INCREASE IN SIZE OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAS RANGED FROM A HIGH OF 25 PERCENT AT THE XXII (1961) TO A LOW OF ABOUT 8 PERCENT AT THE LAST CONGRESS (1976). BASED ON OUR ANALYSIS OF THE DATA FOR THE 13 RECENTLY COMPLETED REPUBLIC CONGRESSES, HOWEVER, WE THINK THAT THE INCREASE WILL BE SOMEWHAT GREATER AT THIS CONGRESS THAN AT THE XXV. 4. IN 1976, THE LOW POINT FOR GROWTH AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL, THE CENTRAL COMMITTEES ELECTED BY THE REPUBLIC CONGRESSES WERE ON THE AVERAGE SLIGHTLY SMALLER THAN THE SAME COMMITTEES ELECTED IN 1971. BY CONTRAST, IN 1981 THESE CONGRESSES ELECTED CENTRAL COMMITTEES THAT ARE ABOUT NINE PERCENT LARGER ON THE AVERAGE THAN THE ONES ELECTED IN 1976. FOUR RE-PUBLICS (AZERBAYDZHAN, KIRGIZIA, MOLDAVIA, AND TURKMENIA) HAVE ENLARGED THEIR COMMITTEES BY MORE THAN 15 PERCENT.

S. WE HAVE ALSO NOTICED THAT BEHIND THE GENERAL FACADE OF CADRE STABILITY AT THE REPUBLIC

CONGRESSES. CONSIDERABLE TURNOVER AMONG LEADING OFFICIALS IN THE REPUBLICS HAS OCCURRED SINCE THEIR PREVIOUS CONGRESSES IN 1976. MORE THAN 44 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL MEMBERSHIP IN THE REPUBLICAN BUREAUS HAS BEEN ELECTED IN THE LAST FIVE YEARS AND ALMOST 25 PERCENT WITHIN THE LAST YEAR. ABOUT 53 PERCENT OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PARTY SECRETARIATS IN THE REPUBLICS HAVE BEEN SELECTED SINCE 1976 AND REPLACEMENT OF THE TOP FOUR LEADERS IN EACH REPUBLIC HAS INCREASED BY MORE THAN 20 PERCENT OVER THE RATE FOR THE 1971 - 1976 PERIOD.

6. THESE FACTS DO NOT MEAN THAT MAJOR TURNOVER IS IN THE OFFING AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL. THEY DO INDICATE, HOWEVER, THAT THE PROCESS OF LEADERSHIP RENEWAL HAS AT LEAST REACHED THE REPUBLIC LEVEL. THE EXPANSION IN CENTRAL COMMITTEE SIZE, MOREOVER, ALMOST CERTAINLY REFLECTS NATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE REPUBLICS. THIS LEADS US TO BELIEVE THAT AN INCREASE ON THE ORDER OF TEN PER CENT IS LIKELY IN THE NEW CENTRAL COMMITTEE. QUITE POSSIBLY, THESE ADDITIONAL MEMBERS AND CANDIDATES WILL BE DRAWN PRIMARILY FROM THE RANKS OF OBKOM FIRST SECRETARIES IN THE UKRAINE, KAZAKHSTAN, UZBEKISTAN, AND BELORUSSIA AS WELL FROM GOVERNMENTAL OFFICIALS BELOW THE MINISTERIAL LEVEL. WITHOUT THIS EXPANSION THE NUMBER OF NEW PEOPLE IN THE LEADERSHIP (SOMETHING THAT IS BRAGGED ABOUT REGARDING PARTY CONGRESS DELEGATES) WOULD PROBABLY BE CONSIDERED TOO LOW BY THE SOVIET LEADERSHIP. Role of the Congress

The Congress is the supreme governing organ of the Communist Party. When it is not in session the Central Committee of the Communist Party, whose members are elected by the Congress, function as the nominally supreme governing body. Congresses are convened by the Central Committee at least once every five years, but they usually meet more often.

Functions and Format

The Congress elects the Central Committee, both the full and the candidate members and the Central Auditing Commission. It does not elect members of the Politburo. The Politburo is elected by the Central Committee.

The Congress listens to and approves reports made by the Party Secretary which deal with domestic, economic and foreign policies. While there is no debate during the Congress, all the reports should be taken seriously as they represent the most authoritative statements on Party intentions and strategy, ideology, foreign, military and economic policy. The Congress is the only body which can change the Party rules.

Domestic Significance

The primary importance of the CPSU congresses is to set Soviet policy on both domestic and foreign matters: they determine the agenda for the immediate future which is meant to be government policy until the next Party Congress. In a sense, they seek to accomplish in two weeks what the U.S. Congress does in its routine business over two years. Secondarily, they inform the 15 million members of the Party what the Party's intentions and objectives are. Implications for the United States

Since the Party Congress seeks to "define" the position of the Soviet Union vis-a-vis its main adversaries, we can expect that an appropriate amount of attention will be devoted to "imperialism," of which the United States and its "henchmen" are the main representatives.

Given the increasingly delicate situation in Poland, the Congress may be expected to enunciate an updated version of the Brezhnev doctrine, perhaps combined with a "warning" to the United States to desist from interference in Poland's internal affairs.

Similarly, one can expect that there will be a concerted effort to drive a wedge between the United States and its West European Allies by exploiting the fear of confrontation between the U.S. and the USSR.

Attached at TAB A are three sensitive intelligence items giving varying interpretations of what will emerge from the 26th Party Congress.

recently told

who is recognized by many as almost an apologist for Soviet policy, that speeches at the 26th CPSU Congress will stress continuity of Soviet policy, the Soviet economy, and the Soviet desire for peace, arms control and detente. Portugalov admitted the economy is in "terrible" shape and needs reform. (S)

He indicated that Moscow understands the U.S. administration's provocations, both verbal and other, are typical of the need of a U.S. President's to assert himself upon taking office. Soviets intend to restrain their responses and hope eventually the administration "will come to grips with reality." The Soviets are ready to cooperate and hope the FRG will play a role in seeing everything remains in balance. (S)

On Poland, Portugalov reiterated the Soviet line that Warsaw must solve its own problems. He believes Soviet credibility will be enhanced if they do not invade Poland. However, he did not rule out the possibility that a state of emergency would be declared but if it is, the Poles will handle it themselves.

SAGGING PRODUCTION, RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT PROBLEMS, INVESTMENT PRIORITIES AND AGRICULTURE INCLUDING THE WORST FOOD SITUATION THE BREZHNEV REGIME HAS EVER FACED UNDOUBTEDLY WILL BE KEY ISSUES OF CONCERN AND DISCUSSION. IN ADDITION, ANY LEADERSHIP CHANGES WILL BE FOLLOWED WITH GREAT INTEREST. DURING THE PAST FEW WEEKS, RUMORS HAVE SURFACED CONCERNING THE POSSIBLE REPLACEMENT OF SOME KEY POLITBURO MEMBERS. Despite such attacks, major editorials in *Pravda* this week pointedly ignored polemics. Instead, they urged Washington to start businesslike discussions of ways "to reduce the level of East-West military confrontation."

The combination of these commentaries suggests that Moscow is uncertain what US statements portend for bilateral relations. Although the door is being kept open for discussions and agreements, contingency preparations are being made for an extended period of increased rivalry. In his address to the party congress on Monday, President Brezhnev is thus likely to note the recent US statements and resultant heightened tension, but to stress Moscow's readiness to improve its ties with Washington.

THE FAILED ATTEMPTS ON BIEHL AND PORTUGUESE CONSUL JOAD SANTOS CHAVES TOOK PLACE FRIDAY MORNING.

THE GUERRILLAS DEMANDED THE RESIGNATION OF INTERIOR MINISTER JUAN JOSE ROSON, FULL AMNESTY FOR PRISONERS AND POLITICAL REFUGEES AND A PURGE OF POLICE CHIEFS THEY CHARGED RAW RIGHT-WING TERRORIST SQUADS.

THE ABBUCTIONS DREW NO ATTENTION IN THE MADRID PARLIAMENT, WHERE DEBATE CENTERED ON CALVO SOTELO'S DECLARED INTENTION TO TAKE SPAIN INTO THE ATLANTIC ALLIANCE.

LEONID BREZHNEV HAS SAID:

"A WAR DANGER DOES EXIST FOR THE UNITED STATES, AS IT DOES FOR ALL THE OTHER COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD. BUT IT ORIGINATES NOT FROM THE SOVIET UNION, NOT FROM ANY MYTHICAL SOUIET SUPERIORITY, BUT FROM THE ARMS RACE AND FROM THE TENSION THAT STILL OBTAINS IN THE WORLD. WE ARE PREPARED TO COMBAT THIS TRUE AND NOT IMAGINARY DANGER HAND IN HAND WITH THE UNITED STATES, WITH THE COUNTRIES OF EUROPE, WITH ALL COUNTRIES IN THE WORLD. (TEXT) MOSCOW, 23 FEB (TASS)--LEONID BREZHNEV SAID FROM THE ROSTRUM OF THE 26TH CPSU CONGRESS:

"SPEAKING OF EUROPEAN AFFAIRS, WE MUST NOT IGNORE THE NEW AND SERIOUS DANGERSTHAT HAVE ARISEN TO EUROPEAN PEACE. THIS REFERS FIRST OF ALL TO THE NATO DECISION OF DEPLOYING NEW U.S. NUCLEAR MISSILES IN WESTERN EUROPE. THIS DECISION IS NO 'RESPONSE' TO ANY IMAGINED SOVIET CHALLENGE. NEITHER IS IT AN ORDINARY 'MODERNISATION' OF THE ARSENAL, AS THE WEST WOULD HAVE US BELIEVE. IT SPEAKS OF AN OBVIOUS INTENTION TO TILT THE EXISTING MILITARY BALANCE IN EUROPE IN NATO'S FAVOUR.

"IT MUST BE CLEAR: THE DEPLOYMENT OF NEW U.S.
MISSILES, TARGETTED AGAINST THE USSR AND ITS ALLIES,
IN THE FRG, ITALY, BRITAIN, THE NETHERLANDS OR BELGIUM IS
BOUND TO AFFECT OUR RELATIONS WITH THESE COUNTRIES,

(EXCERPT) THROUGHOUT ALL THESE YEARS WE HAVE BEEN FOLLOWING A PRINCIPLED AND CONSTRUCTIVE LINE IN RELATIONS WITH THE UNITED STATES. UNFORTUNATELY, THE PREVIOUS WASHINGTON ADMINISTRATION BY NO MEANS CONSIDERED THE DEVELOPMENT OF RELATIONS, MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING. ATTEMPTING TO EXERT PRESSURE ON US, IT BEGAN TO DESTROY ALL THE POSITIVE RESULTS WHICH HAD BEEN SCORED WITH NO LITTLE DIFFICULTY IN SOVIET-AMERICAN RELATIONS OVER THE PRECEDING YEARS. AS A RESULT, OUR BILATERAL RELATIONS IN A NUMBER OF AREAS WERE SET BACK. THE SALT II TREATY HAS BEEN FROZEN. THE UNITED STATES HAS UNILATERALLY BROKEN OFF TALKS WITH US ON CERTAIN ARMS LIMITATION ISSUES, SUCH AS CUTTING ARMS SUPPLIES TO THIRD COUNTRIES.

UNFORTUNATELY, EVEN AFTER THE CHANGE OF LEADERSHIP IN THE WHITE HOUSE, CANDIDLY BELLICOSE CALLS AND STATEMENTS ARE BEING HEARD FROM WASHINGTON, CALLS AND STATEMENTS WHICH SEEM TO BE SPECIALLY INTENDED TO POISON THE ATMOSPHERE OF RELATIONS BETWEEN OUR COUNTRIES. IN ANY CASE, WE WOULD LIKE TO HOPE THAT THOSE WHO NOW DETERMINE U.S. POLICY WILL ULTIMATELY BE ABLE TO LOOK AT THINGS MORE REALISTICALLY.

THE MILITARY-STRATEGIC EQUILIBRIUM PREVAILING BETWEEN THE SOVIET UNION AND THE UNITED STATES, BETWEEN THE WARSAW TREATY ORGANIZATION AND NATO, IS OBJECTIVELY SERVING THE MAINTENANCE OF WORLD PEACE. WE HAVE NOT BEEN STRIVING FOR AND ARE NOT NOW STRIVING FOR MILITARY SUPERIORITY OVER THE OTHER SIDE.

THAT IS NOT OUR POLICY. BUT NEITHER WILL WE PERMIT SUCH A SUPERIORITY TO BE ESTABLISHED OVER US. SUCH ATTEMPTS, AS WELL AS TRYING TO TALK TO US FROM A POSITION OF STRENGTH, ARE ABSOLUTELY FUTILE. NOT TRYING TO DISRUPT THE EQUILIBRIUM WHICH EXISTS AND NOT IMPOSING A NEW AND EVEN MORE EXPENSIVE TWIST IN THE ARMS RACE—THESE WOULD BE EVIDENCE OF GENUINE WISDOM. TRULY, THE TIME HAS LONG SINCE COME TO ELIMINATE FROM SERIOUS POLICY THE RAGGED SCARECROW OF THE SOVIET THREAT.

CONTINUED. WHETHER THE QUESTION IS ONE OF STRATEGIC NUCLEAR ARMS OR OF MEDIUM-RANGE NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN EUROPE, THERE IS AN APPROXIMATE EQUALITY BETWEEN THE SIDES. THE WEST HAS A CERTAIN ADVANTAGE IN SOME KINDS OF WEAPONS, WE HAVE THE ADVANTAGE IN OTHERS. THE EQUALITY COULD BE EVEN MORE ENDURING IF WE WERE TO CONCLUDE PERTINENT TREATIES AND AGREEMENTS. THEY ALSO TALK ABOUT TANKS. THE SOVIET UNION REALLY DOES HAVE MORE OF THEM. HOWEVER, THE NATO COUNTRIES HAVE A LARGE NUMBER. IN ANY EVENT THEY HAVE CONSIDERABLY MORE ANTI-TANK WEAPONS.

IN ADDITION, THE STORY OF SOVIET SUPERIORITY IN OVERALL TROOP STRENGTH DOES NOT CORRESPOND TO REALITY. IF ONE LOOKS AT THE UNITED STATES TOGETHER WITH THE OTHER NATO COUNTRIES, THEIR OVERALL TROOP STRENGTH IS SLIGHTLY HIGHER THAN THAT OF THE SOVIET UNION AND THE OTHER COUNTRIES OF THE WARSAW TREATY ORGANIZATION. WHAT QUESTION CAN THERE BE OF ANY SOVIET MILITARY SUPERIORITY? A MILITARY THREAT HAS INDEED LOOMED OVER THE UNITED STATES AS WELL AS OVER ALL THE OTHER COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD. BUT ITS SOURCE IS NOT THE SOVIET UNION, NOT ITS MYTHICAL SUPERIORITY, BUT RATHER THE ARMS RACE ITSELF, THE TENSION WHICH PERSISTS IN THE WORLD. JOINING HANDS WITH AMERICA, THE AMERICAN STATES AND ALL THE COUNTRIES OF OUR PLANET, WE ARE PREPARED TO STRUGGLE AGAINST THIS GENUINE, NOT IMAGINARY, THREAT. TO ATTEMPT TO DEFEAT EACH OTHER IN THE ARMS RACE AND TO COUNT ON VICTORY IN A NUCLEAR WAR ARE DANGEROUS MADNESS.

IT IS GENERALLY RECOGNIZED THAT THE INTERNATIONAL SITUATION DEPENDS TO A LARGE DEGREE ON THE POLICIES OF THE SOVIET UNION AND THE UNITED STATES. IN OUR OPINION, THE PRESENT STATE OF RELATIONS BETWEEN US AND THE SHARPNESS OF INTERNATIONAL PROBLEMS DEMANDING SOLUTION DICTATE THE NEED FOR DIALOGUE AT ALL LEVELS AND, WHAT IS MORE, AN ACTIVE DIALOGUE. WE ARE READY FOR DIALOGUE. EXPERIENCE SHOWS THAT THE DECISIVE LINK HERE IS MEETINGS AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL. THIS WAS TRUE YESTERDAY AND REMAINS TRUE TODAY. THE SOVIET UNION WANTS NORMAL RELATIONS WITH THE UNITED STATES. FROM THE POINT OF VIEW OF THE INTERESTS OF THE PEOPLES OF BOTH OUR COUNTRIES, AND OF MANKIND AS A WHOLE, WE JUST DO NOT HAVE ANY OTHER REASONABLE PATH.

(EXCERPT) WE ALSO HELP; TOGETHER WITH THE OTHER FRATERNAL COUNTRIES; IN STRENGTHENING THE DEFENSE CAPABILITY OF THE LIBERATED STATES; WHEN THEY TURN TO US WITH SUCH REQUESTS. THIS TOOK PLACE; FOR EXAMPLE; IN ANGOLA AND ETHIOPIA. ATTEMPTS WERE BEING MADE TO DEAL WITH THE PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONS IN THESE COUNTRIES BY MEANS OF ENCOURAGING INTERNAL COUNTERREVOLUTION OR AGGRESSION FROM OUTSIDE. WE ARE AGAINST EXPORTING REVOLUTION, BUT WE CANNOT AGREE EITHER WITH THE EXPORT OF COUNTERREVOLUTION. IMPERIALISM UNLEASHED A REAL UNDECLARED WAR AGAINST THE AFGHAN REVOLUTION. THIS ALSO CREATED A DIRECT THREAT TO THE SECURITY OF OUR SOUTHERN BORDER. THIS SITUATION FORCED US TO RENDER THE MILITARY ASSISTANCE WHICH THE FRIENDLY COUNTRY ASKED FOR.

THE PLANS OF AFGHANISTAN'S ENEMIES FAILED. THE WELL THOUGHTOUT POLICIES OF THE PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONARY PARTY AND THE GOVERNMENT
OF AFGHANISTAN, HEADED BY COMRADE BABRAK KARMAL, WHICH CORRESPOND
WITH THE NATIONAL INTERESTS, STRENGTHENED PEOPLE'S RULE.
AS FAR AS THE SOVIET MILITARY CONTINGENT IS CONCERNED, WE SHALL
BE READY TO WITHDRAW IT ON AGREEMENT WITH THE AFGHAN GOVERNMENT.

(EXCERPT) WE ONCE MORE ISSUE AN URGENT APPEAL FOR RESTRAINT IN THE SPHERE OF STRATEGIC ARMAMENTS. THE PEOPLES OF THE WORLD MUST NOT BE ALLOWED TO LIVE UNDER THE THREAT OF A NUCLEAR WAR BEING UNLEASHED. THE LIMITATION OF STRATEGIC ARMS AND THEIR REDUCTION IS AN EXTRAORDINARY PROBLEM. FOR OUR PART, WE ARE READY TO CONTINUE WITHOUT DELAY APPROPRIATE TALKS WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA WHILE PRESERVING EVERYTHING POSITIVE THAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED UP TO NOW IN THIS SPHERE.

NEGOTIATIONS CAN, OF COURSE, ONLY BE CONDUCTED ON A BASIS OF EQUALITY AND IDENTICAL SECURITY. WE WILL NOT ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT GIVING ONE-SIDED ADVANTAGE TO THE UNITED STATES. THERE SHOULD NOT BE ANY ILLUSIONS ON THIS SCORE. IN OUR OPINION ALL THE OTHER NUCLEAR POWERS SHOULD ALSO JOIN IN SUCH NEGOTIATIONS IN DUE TIME. THE SOVIET UNION IS READY TO HOLD TALKS ON THE LIMITATION OF ANY KIND OF ARMAMENTS. AT ONE TIME WE PROPOSED A BAN ON THE CREATION OF THE U.S. TRIDENT UNDERWATER MISSILE SYSTEM AND OUR OWN CORRESPONDING SYSTEM. THIS PROPOSAL WAS NOT ACCEPTED. AS A RESULT THE AMERICANS HAVE CREATED THE NEW OHIO SUBMARINE WITH TRIDENT-1 MISSILES. WE HAVE CREATED THE ANLOGOUS TYPHOON SYSTEM. BUT WHO HAS GAINED FROM THIS?

WE ARE READY TO REACH AGREEMENT ON LIMITING THE DEPLOYMENT OF NEW U.S. SUBMARINES OF THE OHIO TYPE AND SIMILAR ONES IN THE USSR. WE COULD ALSO ENTER INTO AN ACCORD ON BANNING THE MODERNIZATION OF EXISTING BALLISTIC MISSILES AND THE CREATION OF NEW ONES FOR DEPLOYMENT ABOARD THESE SUBMARINES.

NOW TO THE SUBJECT OF NUCLEAR MISSILE ARMAMENTS IN EUROPE.

AN EVER MORE DANGEROUS ACCUMULATION OF THESE IS TAKING PLACE.

A KIND OF VICIOUS CIRCLE HAS FORMED. THE ACTION OF ONE SIDE EVOKES COUNTERMEASURES BY THE OTHER. HOW CAN THIS CHAIN BE BROKEN? WE PROPOSE THAT AGREEMENT BE REACHED ON ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM NOW ON THE DEPLOYMENT IN EUROPE OF NEW MEDIUM-RANGE NUCLEAR MISSILE FACILITIES OF THE NATO COUNTRIES AND THE USSR—IN OTHER WORDS, TO FREEZE BOTH QUANTITATIVELY AND QUALITATIVELY THE EXISTING LEVEL OF SUCH FACILITIES INCLUDING, OF COURSE, THE FORWARD-BASED NUCLEAR FACILITIES OF THE UNITED STATES IN THIS REGION. THIS MORATORIUM COULD COME INTO FORCE IMMEDIATELY AS SOON AS NEGOTIATIONS ON THIS QUESTION COMMENCE, AND NOULD BE EFFECTIVE UNTIL A PERMAMENT TREATY ON LIMITATION OR, EVEN BETTER, ON REDUCTION OF SUCH NUCLEAR FACILITIES IN EUROPE IS CONCLUDED.

IN THIS WE PROCEED FROM THE POSITION THAT BOTH SIDES SHOULD CURTAIL ANY KIND OF PREPARATIONS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF CORRESPONDING ADDITIONAL MEANS, INCLUDING THE U.S. PERSHING 2 MISSILES AND GROUND-BASED STRATEGIC CRUISE MISSILES. THE PEOPLES SHOULD KNOW THE TRUTH ABOUT THE CONSEQUENCES, RUINOUS FOR MANKIND, WHICH NUCLEAR WAR WOULD BRING. WE PROPOSE THE CREATION OF AN AUTHORITATIVE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE WHICH WOULD DEMONSTRATE THE VITAL NECESSITY OF AVERTING NUCLEAR CATASTROPHE: THE COMMITTEE MIGHT INCLUDE THE MOST PROMINENT SCIENTISTS FROM VARIOUS COUNTRIES; AND THE WHOLE WORLD COULD BE INFORMED OF THEIR CONCLUSIONS.

(TEXT) MOSCOW, 23 FEB (TASS)--LEONID BREZHNEV SAID:

"THE GROWTH OF SOVIET ECONOMIC MIGHT MADE IT POSSIBLE TO ACCOMPLISH A SWEEPING PROGRAMME OF IMPROVING THE PEOPLE'S WELL-BEING IN THE SEVENTIES. THE SUM OF 32,000 MILLION ROUBLES WAS ALLOCATED FOR STATE MEASURES TO INCREASE WAGES AND SALARIES, PENSIONS, ALLOWANCES, AND SO FORTH. EACH SUCH MEASURE IS A REAL AND TANGIBLE STEP FORWARD ON THE ROAD MOST IMPORTANT TO US-THAT OF IMPROVING THE SOVIET PEOPLE'S LIFE.

"THE HOUSING BUILT IN THE SEVENTIES HAS A BIGGER FLOOR SPACE THAN THAT OF ALL THE URBAN HOUSING THAT EXISTED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SIXTIES. THE SCALE OF HOUSING CONSTRUCTION IS, COMRADES, A GREAT SOCIAL ACHIEVEMENT OF OURS.

"IN SUM, THE MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE PARTY'S ECONOMIC STRATEGY IS REING CONSISTENTLY IMPLEMENTED."

LEONID BREZHNEV HAS SAID:

"THE CONSTITUTION OF THE USSR HAS GREATLY ENHANCED THE ROLE OF PUBLIC ORGANISATIONS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF OUR DEMOCRACY. THE LARGEST OF THESE ARE THE TRADE UNIONS. (TEXT) MOSCOW, 23 FEB (TASS)—THE GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE CPSU CENTRAL COMMITTEE LEONID BREZHNEV SAID FROM THE ROSTRUM OF THE PARTY CONGRESS:

"TO SAFEGUARD PEACE -- NO TASK IS MORE IMPORTANT NOW ON THE INTERNATIONAL PLANE FOR OUR PARTY, FOR OUR PEOPLE AND, FOR THAT MATTER, FOR ALL THE PEOPLES OF THE WORLD.

"BY SAFEGUARDING PEACE WE ARE WORKING NOT ONLY FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE LIVING TODAY AND NOT ONLY FOR OUR CHILDREN AND GRANDCHILDREN: WE ARE WORKING FOR THE HAPPINESS OF DOZENS OF FUTURE GENERATIONS.

"IF THERE IS PEACE, THE CREATIVE ENERGY OF THE PEOPLES BACKED BY THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY IS CERTAIN TO SOLVE THE PROBLEMS THAT ARE NOW TROUBLING PEOPLE. TO BE SURE, NEW, STILL LOFTIER TASKS WILL THEN ARISE BEFORE OUR DESCENDANTS. BUT THAT IS THE DIALECTIC OF PROGRESS, THE DIALECTIC OF LIFE.

"NOT WAR PREPARATIONS THAT DOOM THE PEOPLES TO A SENSELESS SQUANDERING OF THEIR MATERIAL AND SPIRITUAL WEALTH, BUT CONSOLIDATION OF PEACE -- THAT IS THE CLUE TO THE FUTURE."

DESCRIBING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE USSR IN THE PERIOD UNDER REVIEW, LEONID BREZHNEV SAID:

"THE NATIONAL ECONOMY BALANCE SHEET FURNISHES CONVINCING PROOF THAT THE PARTY'S ECONOMIC STRATEGY IS CORRECT. THE COUNTRY HAS MADE SUBSTANTIAL PROGRESS IN ALL THE AREAS OF BUILDING THE MATERIAL AND TECHNICAL BASIS OF COMMUNISM. THE PRODUCTIVE FORCES OF SOVIET SOCIETY HAVE ATTAINED A QUALITATIVELY NEW LEVEL.

"SOVIET MEN AND WOMEN HAVE PUT IN GOOD WORK. WHAT WE CALL SHOCK WORK. RALLIED CLOSELY AROUND LENIN'S PARTY AND TREATY ITS MASTER PLANS AS A MATTER OF VITAL CONCERN TO THEM PERSONALLY, THE WORKING PEOPLE IN TOWN AND COUNTRY HAVE SPARED NO EFFORTS IN BUILDING UP THE COUNTRY'S ECONOMIC POTENTIAL. (TEXT) MOSCOW, 23 FEB (TASS)—LEONID BREZHNEV NOTED THAT ON THE WHOLE, THE PRESENT PROGRAMME OF THE CPSU CORRECTLY MIRRORS THE LAWS OF SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT. BUT 20 YEARS HAVE PASSED SINCE IT WAS ADOPTED.

"WE APPARENTLY SHOULD INTRODUCE THE NECESSARY AMENDMENTS
AND ADDITIONS INTO THE PRESENT PROGRAMME. IF THIS PROPOSAL
IS APPROVED BY THE DELEGATES TO THE CONGRESS THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE
SHOULD BE INSTRUCTED TO REDRAFT THE PROGRAMME OF THE CPSU."

CONCLUDING HIS REPORT AT THE 26TH CONGRESS OF THE PARTY;
THE GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE COMMUNIST
PARTY OF THE SOVIET UNION LEONID BREZHNEV SAID:

"OUR AIM IS COMMUNISM AND IT IS A MAJESTIC AIM. EVERY LABOUR ACHIEVMENT, EVERY YEAR OF HEROIC ACCOMPLISHMENT, AND EVERY FIVE-YEAR PLAN BRINGS US NEARER TO THAT AIM. THIS IS THE STANDPOINT FROM WHICH THE PARTY ASSESSES THE COMING FIVE-YEAR PERIOD. MUCH WILL HAVE TO BE DONE. THE TASKS THAT WILL HAVE TO BE FULFILLED ARE BIG AND MORE COMPLEX, BUT WE WILL MOST DEFINITELY CARRY THEM OUT."
