1. C - ENTIRE TEXT.

2. SUMMARY: THE ECONOMIC SECTION OF BREZHNEV'S SPEECH WAS A REPLAY OF OLD THEMES RATHER THAN THE ARTICULATION OF MAJOR NEW DEPARTURES. HE STRESSED THE NEED FOR IMPROVED PERFORMANCES IN VARIOUS LAGGING SECTIONS OF HEAVY INDUSTRY (METALLURGY, CONSTRUCTION), AND GAVE TOP PRIORITY TO DEVELOPMENT OF NORTHERN NATURAL GAS FIELDS. THE SPEECH CONTAINED LITTLE NEW IN THE FIELD OF SCIENCE. THE KEY ELEMENT OF THE "SPECIAL FOOD PROGRAM" WILL BE INCREASED MEAT PRODUCTION; PRIVATE AGRICULTURAL PLOTS ARE PROMISED ADDITIONAL GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE TO HELP ACHIEVE THIS PRODUCTION. IN DISCUSSING THE NEED FOR INCREASED PRODUCTION OF CONSUMER GOODS. BREZHNEV OMITTED SPECIFIC REFERENCE TO A POTENTIAL ROLE FOR DEFENSE INDUSTRIES. HE CRITICIZED THE PRACTICE OF DOWNWARD "CORRECTIONS" OF THE FIVE-YEAR PLAN, CALLING FOR GREATER "PLAN DISCIPLINE" AND PARTY INVOLVEMENT IN MANAGEMENT DISCIPLINE. IN THE AREA OF FOREIGN TRADE, BREZHNEV STRESSED THE IMPORTANCE OF COOPERA-TION BETWEEN THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES. WHILE WARNING THAT THE POLICIES OF INDIVIDUAL CAPITALIST STATES WOULD BE "TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT" IN DETERMINING SOVIET TRADE POLICY. END SUMMARY.

3. HEAVY INDUSTRY, TRANSPORT AND ENERGY: HEAVY INDUSTRY RECEIVED PRIDE OF PLACE IN THE ECONOMIC PORTION OF BREZHNEV'S SPEECH. HE STRESSED PROBLEMS IN THE METALLURGICAL. TRANSPORT. ENERGY AND MACHINE BUILDING SECTORS AND NOTED THAT EVER MORE EXPENSIVE RESOURCES WOULD HAVE TO BE USED MORE EFFICIENTLY. TRANSPORT DEVELOPMENT IS TO BE APPROACHED FROM A "COMPREHENSIVE VIEWPOINT MEANING THAT NO SINGLE MODE SUCH AS RAILROADS IS TO BE STRESSED EXCLUSIVELY. WITH RESPECT TO ENERGY, BREZHNEV MADE THE STANDARD CALL FOR REDUCING THE USE OF OIL THROUGH GREATER RELIANCE ON NATURAL GAS, COAL, AND NUCLEAR POWER (INCLUDING BRIEDER REACTORS). HE ALSO CALLED FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A SYNTHETIC FUEL INDUSTRY BASED ON KANSK-ACHINSK COAL. WHILE BREZHNEY DID NOT ANNOUNCE ANY DECISION TO CONSTRUCT THE NORTHERN GAS PIPELINE, HE DID SAY THAT THE URENGOY GAS FIELD CONTAINS SUCH GIGANTIC RESOURCES THAT IT CAN FOR MANY YEARS MEET THE COUNTRY'S DOMESTIC AND EXPORT NEEDS, INCLUDING EXPORTS TO CAPITALIST COUNTRIES.

CONSUMER WELFARE:

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S IN OCTOBER 1980, BREZHNEV EMPHASIZED CONSUMER WELFARE WITHOUT SUPPLY-SIDE SPECIFICS. HE REPEATED THE STATEMENT IN THE "BASIC GUIDELINES" THAT "THE MAIN TASK OF THE ELEVENTH FIVE-YEAR PLAN CONSISTS OF THE GUARANTEEING OF THE FURTHEST GROWTH BT

"UPWARDS OF SIXTEEN BILLION RUBLES ARE TO BE SET ASIDE IN THE FIVE-YEAR PLAN FOR CENTRALIZED MEASURES TO INCREASE WAGES AND SALARIES. AND OTHER PAYMENTS AND BONUSES TO THE POPULATION. THERE ARE TO BE INCREASES IN THE MINIMUM OLD-AGE AND DISABILITY PENSIONS OF INDUSTRIAL AND OFFICE WORKERS. PROFESSIONALS AND COLLECTIVE FARMERS. AND OTHER MEASURES TO BRING ABOUT A FURTHER IMPROVEMENT IN THE SOCIAL SERVICES. STATE ASSISTANCE TO FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN IS TO BE EXTENDED. THE MINIMUM MONTHLY PAY WILL BE RAISED TO EIGHTY RUBLES PER MONTH, AND THE MONTHLY AVERAGE WAGE IS TO INCREASE IN 1981-1985 BY 13-16 PERCENT TO 19 -195 RUBLES. THE INCOMES OF COLLECTIVE FARMERS FROM THEIR JOINT HOLDINGS ARE TO RISE BY 20-22 PERCENT, AND "IT IS PROPOSED TO EXTEND SEVERAL WAGE BENEFITS -- LENGTH OF SERVICE INCREMENTS IN SOME EASTERN AREAS AND REGIONAL PREMIUM RATES. BREZHNEV NOTED SHORTAGES OF MANY CONSUMER GOODS, ESPECIALLY IN TEXTILES. KNITWEAR. LEATHER FOOT-WEAR, FURNITURE, AND TELEVISION SETS. "PROPER IMPROVEMENTS IN QUALITY, FINISH OR VARIETY"
REMAIN NEEDED. BREZHNEV ALSO OBSERVED THAT "THE PROGRAM FOR EXPANDING CONSUMER GOODS PRODUCTION AND SERVICES ... ASSIGNS A BIG ROLE TO HEAVY INDUSTRIES" WHICH PRODUCE "MORE THAN HALF OF THE CONSUMER GOODS OTHER THAN FOOD." HE TERMED THE HE TERMED THE HIGHER RATE OF GROWTH OF GROUP "B" PRODUCTION OVER GROUP "A" A "GOOD THING".

FOREIGN TRADE AND ECONOMIC INTEGRATION: IN THE AREA OF FOREIGN TRADE, INTRA-CEMA ECONOMIC COOPERA-TION REMAINS THE CORNERSTONE OF SOVIET TRADE POLICY.
BREZHNEV STRESSED THE NEED FOR "INTENSIVE COOPERATION" BETWEEN SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND SAID THAT ECONOMIC PROGRESS IS "INCONCEIVABLE" WITHOUT COOPERATION BETWEEN SOCIALIST COUNTRIES. DESPITE THIS EMPHASIS ON THE ECONOMIC SUCCESSES OF THE SOCIALIST STATES. BREZHNEY ADMITTED THAT "THE PAST FEW YEARS HAVE NOT BEEN AMONG THE MOST FAVORABLE FOR THE NATIONAL ECONOMIES OF SOME SOCIALIST STATES", ALLUDING TO POLAND AND PERHAPS CUBA. VIETNAM AND OTHER LAGGING SOCIALIST ECONOMIES AS WELL. ALTHOUGH MOSCOW IS IN FAVOR OF "EXPANDED" ECONOMIC CONTACTS WITH THE WEST, BREZHNEV WARNED THAT IT MUST "TAKE INTO ACCOUNT" THE POLICIES OF THE CAPITALIST STATES THAT USE "ECONOMIC TIES" AS A MEANS OF POLITICAL PRESSURE. THE REDUCTION OF TRADE WITH THE U.S. WAS

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ATTRIBUTED TO THE POLICIES OF THE CARTER ADMINISTRATION. FRANCE AND THE FRG, ON THE OTHER HAND, WERE SINGLED OUT FOR THEIR COOPERATIVE ATTITUDE IN THE ECONOMIC SPHERE.

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STAGE". A KEY GOAL OF THE SPECIAL FOOD PROGRAM WILL BE INCREASED MEAT PRODUCTION. DESCRIBING PRIVATE AGRICULTURAL PLOTS AS A PRIME SOURCE OF ADDITIONAL MEAT SUPPLIES, THE SPEECH PROMISED PRIVATE PLOT HOLDERS ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE (E.G.. FORAGE AND EQUIPMENT). THE SPEECH ALSO PROMISED TO DEVOTE "HUGE" FINANCIAL AND MATERIAL RESOURCES TO AGRICULTURE DURING THE ELEVENTH FIVE-YEAR PLAN. EREZHNEV CALLED FOR A NATION-WIDE EFFORT TO SPEED DEVELOPMENT OF THE RUSSIAN NON-BLACK EARTH REGION; THIS PROGRAM WAS SAID TO DESERVE THE SAME PRIORITY AS THAT ONCE GIVEN TO DEVELOPMENT OF VIRGIN LANDS AND RECONSTRUCTION OF TASHKENT. ALTHOUGH THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS SECTION OF THE SPEECH CONTAINED AN APPROVING REFERENCE TO THE "HUNGARIAN AGRICULTURAL MODEL", THE AGRICULTURE SECTION DID NOT FOLLOW UP ON THIS.

MANAGEMENT AND INVESTMENT: BREZHNEV NOTED TWO CHANGES IN MINISTRY ORGANIZATION -- THE CREATION OF A FRUIT AND VEGETABLE MINISTRY AND A SEPARATE MINISTRY OF FERTILIZER PRODUCTION; BOTH INTENDED TO IMPROVE AGRICULTURAL OUTPUT. GENERAL DEFECTS IN MANAGEMENT WERE ATTRIBUTED TO "HABITS WHICH AROSE" DURING THE PERIOD WHEN QUANTITY, NOT QUALITY, WAS THE MAJOR PROBLEM. GREATER "PLAN DISCIPLINE" IS (AGAIN) NOTED AS A REMEDY FOR UNBALANCED SUPPLY AND DEMAND, AND IT MUST BE "UNQUESTIONABLY FULFILLED". A TOTAL INVEST-MENT TARGET IS LISTED AS 711-730 BILLION RUBLES. REPRESENTING A GROWTH OF 14 PERCENT - 63 BILLION OVER THE PREVIOUS FYP (COMMENT: AN INCREASE OF LESS THAN 3 PERCENT ANNUALLY. END COMMENT). ON INVESTMENT, PARTICULARLY IN AGRICULTURE, MUST BE INCREASED. RURAL INFRASTRUCTURE IS CITED AS ESSEN-TIAL. WITHOUT (YET) SPECIFYING THE SIZE OF INCREASED ALLOTMENTS. UNSPECIFIED INCREASES ARE ALSO NOTED FOR FOOD PROCESSING. IN THE CONCLUSION OF THE ECONOMIC PORTION OF THE SPEECH BREZHNEV STATED THAT THE TENDENCY IN HIS VIEW IS TOWARD GREATER INDEPEN-DENCE FOR LOCAL AND REGIONAL MANAGERS, BUT FOLLOWS IMMEDIATELY WITH THE INJUNCTION THAT PROBLEMS OF ECONOMIC MANAGEMENT ARE NOT JUST ECONOMIC. BUT POLITICAL. PARTY PROBLEMS".

8. SCIENCE: IN A SECTION DEVOTED TO SCIENCE, BREZHNEV COVERED STANDARD THEMES SUCH AS THE NEED TO APPLY SCIENTIFIC DISCOVERIES TO PRODUCTION AND

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TO ENSURE THAT SOVIET PRODUCTION MEETS THE HIGHEST WORLD STANDARDS. BREZHNEV ALSO SUGGESTED THAT AN ASSESSMENT OF THE RESEARCH OR DESIGNING FACILITIES OF LIGHT INDUSTRIES (LIGHT, FOOD AND MEDICAL MINISTRIES ARE MENTIONED BY NAME) BE CARRIED OUT WITH THE HELP OF THE MINISTRIES WITH MORE POWERFUL RESEARCH FACILITIES, "INCLUDING THE DEFENSE INDUSTRIES." WE ALSO NOTE THAT BREZHNEV CALLED FOR THE EVENTUAL ESTABLISHMENT OF NUCLEAR POWER FACILITIES BASED ON THE FUSION BT

IT ACKNOWLEDGED CON-TINUING PROBLEMS IN NATIONALITY RELATIONS. CALLING FOR GREATER ATTENTION TO MINORITY SENSITIVITIES WHILE CONDEMING MANIFESTATIONS OF NATIONALISM SUCH AS ANTI-SEMITISM AND ZIONISM. THE REPORT ALSO ADVOCATED IMPROVED SOCIAL PROGRAMS TO ADDRESS THE LABOR SHORTAGE IN SIBERIA. END SUMMARY.

PARTY AFFAIRS.

- 3. THE REPORT ASKED THE DELEGATES TO APPROVE A REVISION OF THE 1961 PARTY PROGRAM BY THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE. HE LISTED A NUMBER OF FACTORS IN THE LAST 20 YEARS THAT SHOULD BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT INCLUDING:
- CHANGES IN THE STRUCTURE OF THE SOVIET ECONOMY;
- THE DRAWING TOGETHER OF FRATERNAL COUNTRIES AND
- THE DEVELOPMENT OF ECONOMIC INTEGRATION;
- LESSONS DRAWN FROM THE DIFFICULTIES ENCOUNTERED IN DEVELOPMENT OF SOCIALIST COUNTRIES (AN OBVIOUS
- REFERENCE TO DEVELOPMENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN
- 1968 AND POLAND THAT HAVE REFERENCE FOR THE USSR);
- THE GROWING ROLE OF THE MILITARY-INDUSTRIAL COM-
- PLEX AND TRANSNATIONAL CORPORATIONS IN THE
- CAPITALIST WORLD.
- 4. AS WE EARLIER REPORTED (REFS). EMBASSY WAS TOLD MONTHS AGO THAT THE ISSUE OF DRAFTING A NEW PARTY PROGRAM WAS UNDER DISCUSSION IN HIGH PARTY CIRCLES. THE DECISION TO GO AHEAD WITH A NEW PARTY PROGRAM REFLECTS THE REGIME'S DESIRE TO REPLACE THE OVERLY OPTIMISTIC KHRUSHCHEV PROGRAM WITH ONE THAT MORE REALISTICALLY AND CONCRETELY ADDRESSES THE ECONOMIC AND INTERNATIONAL PROBLEMS FACING THE REGIME. A NEW PARTY PROGRAM COULD ALSO CONSTITUTE BREZHNEV' LAST "TESTAMENT" TO THE PARTY APPARATUS. MUCH AS THE NEW 1977 CONSTITUTION HAS BEEN HERALDED AS BREZHNEV'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE STATE STRUCTURE.
- 5. THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE REPORT NOTED THAT THE POLITBURO AND SECRETARIAT HAD MET 237 AND 250 TIMES RESPECTIVELY. THIS REPRESENTS AN INCREASE IN

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NATIONALITY QUESTION

6. IN CONTRAST TO THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE REPORT IN 1976. THE REPORT TO THE XXVI PARTY CONGRESS ACK-NOWLEDGES CONTINUING PROBLEMS IN NATIONALITY RE-LATIONS. WHILE IT DOES NOT DEPART FROM THE STANDARD FORMULATIONS ON NATIONALITY RELATIONS. THE REPORT PUTS EMPHASIS ON BALANCE BETWEEN THE FLOURISHING" OF NATIONAL CULTURES AND THE "DRAWING TOGETHER OF DIFFERENT PEOPLES. IT CITES. FOR EXAMPLE. THE NEED TO PAY GREATER ATTENTION AT THE REPUBLICAN LEVEL TO MINORITY SENSITIVITIES. BUT STRONGLY REJECTS ANY CONCESSIONS TO CHAUVISISM AND NATIONALISM. CITING BOTH ANTI-SEMITISM AND ZIONISM AS EXAMPLES OF NATIONALISTIC "ABERRATION". IN AN APPARENT BOW TO RUSSIAN NATIONAL FEELINGS. REPORT LAUDS THE CONTRIBUTION OF THE "RUSSIAN PEOPLE" IN FOSTERING THE ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT OF NON-RUSSIAN AREAS, AND STATES THAT THERE ARE NO LONGER ANY "BACKWARD ETHNIC OUTLYING REGIONS IN THE USSR. THE SPEECH GOES ON TO CALL FOR AN ALL-UNION EFFORT TO SOLVE THE PRESSING PROBLEMS OF THE NON-BLACK EARTH REGIN OF THE RSFSR, WHICH IS SAID TO FIND ITSELF IN MORE DIFFICULT CON-DITIONS THAN SOME OTHER REGIONS.

DEMOGRAPHY AND THE FAMILY.

7. BREZHNEV CONTRASTED LABOR SHORTAGES IN SIBERIA AND THE FAR EAST WITH THE LABOR SURPLUS IN THE CAUCASUS AND CENTRAL ASIA. ACKNOWLEDGING THAT MONEY ALONE WAS NOT PREVENTING OUTMIGRATION FROM SIBERIA. HE CALLED FOR INCREASED HOUSING CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVED SUPPLIES OF CONSUMER GOODS. IN CENTRAL ASIA. HE CALLED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES WHICH WOULD ATTRACT PEOPLE FROM RURAL AREAS TO THE CITIES. IN DEFINING THE PARTY'S "EFFECTIVE DEMOGRAPHIC POLICY" BREZHNEV INDICATED THAT MEASURES WOULD BE ADOPTED FOR PAID MATERNITY LEAVE AND IMPROVED WORK CONDITIONS FOR MOTHERS, BUT WAS VAGUE AS TO SPECIFICS. HIS ANNOUNCE-MENT THAT CHILD ALLOWANCES WOULD BE INCREASING BEGINNING WITH THE SECOND CHILD REPRESENTS A VICTORY FOR DEMOGRAPHERS WHO HAVE URGED SUCH ALLOWANCES AS A MEANS TO INCREASE THE BIRTHRATE IN THE RUSSIAN REPUBLIC. 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FOREIGN POLICY HIGHLIGHTS OF BREZHNEV'S SUBJECT: REPORT TO THE XXVI PARTY CONGRESS

THERE FOLLOWS OUR INITIAL ASSESSMENT OF THOSE PORTIONS OF BREZHNEY'S REPORT TO THE XXVI CPSU CONGRESS ON FOREIGN POLICY ISSUES WHICH WE CONSIDER TO BE SIGNIFICANT. HIS STATEMENTS ON POLAND HAVE BEEN REPORTED REETEL.

U.S. SOVIET RELATIONS: BREZHNEV VIRTUALLY PROPOSED A SUMMIT CONFERENCE WITH PRESIDENT REAGAN. HE DEPLORED THE ACTIONS OF THE FORMER ADMINISTRATION WHICH HE CHARACTERIZED AS "DESTROYING THE POSITIVE ELEMENTS" IN OUR RELATIONSHIP AND THE "BELLICOSE CALLS AND STATEMENTS" FROM THE PRESENT U.S. LEADERSHIP. HE, TYPICALLY, URGED A "REALISTIC" APPROACH BY THE ADMINISTRATION. HE NOTED THE THREAT OF AN ARMS RACE AND LABELED ANY ATTEMPT BY ONE SIDE TO OUTSTRIP THE OTHER AS "DANGEROUS BREZHNEV THEN REFERRED TO THE IMPORTANCE MADNESS. OF THE POLICY OF THE USSR AND THE U.S. IN THE WORLD, CALLED FOR AN "ACTIVE DIALOGUE AT ALL LEVELS. AFFIRMED THAT THE SOVIET UNION IS PREPARED FOR SUCH A DIALOGUE, AND ADDED THAT THE CRUCIAL LINK IS MEETINGS AT THE SUMMIT HE UNDERLINED THE TOPICALITY OF THIS LEVEL. POSITION BY SAYING THAT THIS WAS TRUE YESTERDAY AND "IS STILL TRUE TODAY." IT IS CLEAR FROM THE CONTEXT THAT BREZHNEV'S CALL FOR SUMMITRY WITHIN THE U.S.-SOVIET CONTEXT IS SEPARATE FROM HIS PROPOSAL (SEE BELOW) FOR A MEETING OF THE HEADS OF GOVERNMENT OF THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL. HE CONCLUDED HIS REMARKS ON U.S.-SOVIET RELATIONS BY NOTING THE "USSR WANTS NORMAL RELATIONS WITH THE U.S.A.

SALT: BREZHNEV ATTEMPTED TO CONVEY A FORTH-COMING STANCE ON THE RENEGOTIATION OF SALT II. STATING THAT THE USSR IS READY TO CONTINUE NEGOTIATIONS WITHOUT DELAY. AND THAT MOS NEGOTIATIONS "WITHOUT DELAY," AND THAT MOSCOW CONSIDERS "REDUCTION" AND NOT JUST "LIMITATION" OF STRATEGIC WEAPONS AS A "PARAMOUNT PROBLEM. HE LAID DOWN THE PRECONDITION THAT THE "POSITIVE

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FLEMENTS" OF THE SALT II TREATY MUST BE PRESERVED A REFORMULATION OF THE MARKER LAID DOWN BY GROMYKO IN HIS "KOMMUNIST" ARTICLE (MOSCOW 837) THAT THE SOVIET UNION WILL NOT ENGAGE IN TALKS WHOSE AIM IS TO "RENDER NULL AND VOID" THE SALT II TREATY. HE ALSO MADE THE OBLIGATORY REFERENCE TO "EQUALITY AND EQUAL SECURITY." ANTICIPATING FUTURE U.S. PROPOSALS AIMED AT RESTRICTING THE COUNTERFORCE CAPABILITIES OF SOVIET LAND-BASED ICBMS, BREZHNEV PRESENTED ONE OF THE QUID PRO QUOS LIKELY TO BE RAISED BY THE SOVIET SIDE: QUALITATIVE CONSTTAINTS ON SLBMS; HE EVEN MADE AN UNUSUAL PUBLIC CEFEEENCE TO THE NAME OF A SOVIET STRATEGIC SYSTEM (ALBEIT IN TERMS OF ITS

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FINALLY, HE MADE A PASSING REFERENCE TO THE NEED IN THE LONG RUN TO BROADEN THE SALT TALKS TO INCLUDE "ALL OTHER NUCLEAR POWERS. AN OBLIQUE REMINDER OF THE POSITION THAT MOSCOW CANNOT AGREE TO SUBSTANTIAL REDUCTIONS IN ITS STRATEGIC FORCES UNLESS EUROPEAN AND CHINESE NUCLEAR FORCES ARE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT.

- TNF: BREZHNEV REFERRED FOR THE FIRST TIME IN PUBLIC TO THE SOVIET PROPOSAL FOR A AREEZE ON MEDIUM-RANGE NUCLEAR-MISSILE WEAPONS OF THE NATO COUNTRIES AND THE SOVIET UNION. TABLED AT THE END OF THE FIRST ROUND OF THE TNN PRELIMINARY EXCHANGES IN NOVEMBEE. ALTHOUGH THE EROPOSAL IS PATENTLY ONE-SIDED. GOING GUBLIC MAKES THE SOVIETS LOOK FORTHCOMING FOR THE WEST EUROPEAN AUDIENCE AT A TIME WHEN MOSCOW IS ATTEMPTING TO EXPLOIT U.S .-EUROPEAN DIFFERENCES ON NUCLEAR ISSUES. IN PURSUIT OF ITS LONG-STANDING OBJECTIVE OF OVERTURNING NATO'S THE DEELOYMENT DECISION.
- OTHER ARMS CONTROL ISSUES: WITHOUT PRESENTING ANY NEW INITIATIVES, BREZHNEV, IN A CURSORY MANNER. REAFFIRMED MOSCOW'S SUPPORT FOR A VARIETY OF OTHER NEGOTIATIONS AND OUTSTANDING SOVIET DIS-ARMAMENT PROPOSALS: MBFR, CTB, RW, CW, LIMITING THE MANUFACTURE OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS, BANNING THE "NEUTRON BOMB." HE ALSO MADE PASSING REFERENCE TO THE CONVENTIONAL ARMS TRANSFER TALKS. CITING THEM AS ONE OF THE NEGOTIATIONS UNILATERALLY SUS-PENDED BY THE U.S.
- 7. EXPANSION OF CONFIDENCE-BUILDING MEASURES: IN AN OBVIOUS EFFORT TO TURN THE TABLES ON THE FRENCH CDE PROPOSAL, BREZHNEY STATED THAT MOSCOW IS PREPARED TO APPLY CBM'S TO THE ENTIRE EUROPEAN PART OF THE USSR, PROVIDED THAT WESTERN STATES EXPAND THE CONFIDENCE A ZONE ACCORDINGLY. HE ALSO STATED THAT THE SOVIET UNION IS PREPARED TO HOLD CONCRETE NEGOTIATIONS WITH ALL INTERESTED COUNTRIES ON EXTENSION OF CONFIDENCE-BUILDING MEASURES TO THE FAR EAST. WHERE THE SOVIET UNION, CHINA AND JAPAN BORDER ON EACH OTHER. SPEECH CHARACTERIZES THESE AS "FAR-REACHING PROPOSALS. WE ASSUME THEY ARE TWO SEPARATE INITIATIVES, AND THAT THE IMPLIED SOVIET PRICE FOR EXTENSION OF CBM'S TO THE URALS IS ACCEPTANCE OF CBM APPLICABILITY TO THE

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NORTH AMERICAN CONTINENT. WITH THE FAR EAST INITIATIVE BEING A SEPARATE NEGOTIATION.

8. - AFGHANISTAN AND THE PERSIAN GULF: IN ANOTHER NEW DEPARTURE, BREZHNEY STATED THAT
MOSCOW DOES NOT OBJECT TO THE "QUESTIONS CONNECTED
WITH AFGHANISTAN" BEING DISCUSSED TOGETHER WITH QUESTIONS OF PERSIAN GULF SECURITY, ALTHOUGH HE SAID THE SOVIET UNION ALSO STANDS READY TO DISCUSS EACH PROBLEM SEPARATELY. HE ADDED THE STANDARD SOVIET POSITION THAT THE SOVIETS' WOULD ONLY DISCUSS THE "INTERNATIONAL ASPECTS OF THE AFGHAN PROBLEM" AND NOT INTERNAL AFGHAN AAFAIRS. BT

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C O R R E C T E D COPY-INFO ADDEE ADDED CINCEUR, SHAPE FOR POLAD/INTAFF MADRID FOR CSCE AFGHANISTAN'S SOVEREIGNTY, LIKE ITS NON-ALIGNED STATUS. MUST BE "FULLY PROTECTED." HE SAID.

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THE PLOY OF LINKING AFGHANISTAN TO THE SOVIET PERSIAN GULF SECURITY PROPOSAL CLEARLY IS DESIGNED TO CONVEY THE IMPRESSION OF SOVIET FLEXIBILITY ON AFGHANISTAN, TO INCREASE THE ATTRACTIVENESS OF THE PERSIAN GULF INITIATIVE AND TO TRY TO WEAKEN WESTERN ARGUMENTS THAT SOVIET TROOPS IN AFGHANISTAN ARE THE CHIEF SECURITY PROBLEM IN THE REGION. BREZHNEV AGAIN CLAIMED THAT SOVIET TROOPS WERE SENT INTO AFGHANISTAN IN RESPONSE TO THE DIRECT THREAT ON ITS SOUTHERN BORDER, AND REPEATED THE FORMULA THAT THEY WILL BE WITHDRAWN ONLY WHEN OUTSIDE INFILTRATION IS COMPLETELY STOOPED, AGREEMENTS ARE SIGNED WITH AFGHANISTAN'S NEIGHBORS, AND GUARANTEES AGAINST NEW INTERVENTION ARE IN PLACE.

S. CHINA: BREZHNEV TOOK A FAIRLY UPBEAT APPRRACH TO CHINA, SSOTER THAN GROMYKO'S RECENT ARTICLE IN KOMMUNIST. HE NOTED THE INTERNAL CHANGES IN CHINA ("TIME WILL ONLY SHOW WHAT THEY MEAN"), ADDING, HOWEVER, THAT THERE ARE NO "CHANGES FOR THE BETTER" IN CHINA'S FOREIGN POLICY. HE ACCUSED THE US, JAPAN, AND SOME NATT COUNTRIES OF WANTING TO EXXAND TIES WITH CHINA TO USE ITS HOSTTLITY TOOARD THE SOVIET UNION FOR THEIR OWN INTERESTS AND CALLED THIS A "HAZARDOUS GAME." HE ADVOCATED IMPROVED TIES. BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES ON A "GOOD-NEIGHBOR" BASIS.

10. MIDDLE EAST: BREZHNEV ADVOCATED A "SPECIALLY CONVENED INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE" ON AN ARAB-ISRAELI SETTLEMENT AND RENEWED HIS CALL FOR COLLECTIVE EFFORTS, BUT PHRASING IT THIS TIME IN TERMS OF A "COLLECTIVE SEARCH OF AN ALL-EMBRACING JUST AND REALISTIC SETTLEMENT." HE SPECIFICALLY INCLUDED AS "INTERESTED PARTIES" IN THIS EFFORT, THE ARABS, THE PLO, ISRAEL AND THE UNITED STATES. HE ALLUDED TO THE OCTOBER 1977 JOINT U.S.-USSR COMMUNIQUE BY STATING, "WE ARE PREPARED FOR SUCH A SEARCH JOINTLY WITH THE UNITED STATES - AND I MAY REMIND YOU THAT WE HAVE HAD SOME EXPERIENCE IN THIS REGARD SOME YEARS IN A SECONDARY MANNER, HE GAVE A NOD TO THE EUROPEAN COUNTRIES AND SAID THE SOVIET UNION IS PREPARED TO COOPERATE WITH THEM. THE UN IS ALSO SINGLED OUT TO CONTINUE TO PLAY A USEFUL ROLE. CONCERNING THE SUBSTANCE OF A SETTLEMENT, HE REPEATED THE WELL-KNOWN SOVIET POSITION WITH SPECIFIC REFER-

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ENCE TO THE "INALIENABLE RIGHTS OF THE ARAB PEOPLE OF PALESTINE ... NOT SHORT OF ESTABLISHING THEIR OWN STATE" AND ENSURING "THE SECURITY AND SOVEREIGNTY OF ALL THE STATES OF THE REGION, INCLUDING THOSE OF ISRAEL." THE DETAILS OF A SETTLEMENT, HE CONCLUDED, COULD BE TAKEN UP AT THE NEGOTIATIONS.

11. - WESTERN EUROPE: BREZHNEV INDICATED CONSIDERABLE DIFFERENTIATION IN RELATIONS WITH WESTERN EUROPE. WITH FRANCE AT THE TOP OF THE LIST, THE UK AT THE BOTTOM, AND FRG SOMEWHERE BETWEEN. HE STRESSED THE PRACTICALLY "UNINTERRUPTED" BT

AFTER SPECIFIC POSITIVE MENTION OF ITALY, FINLAND, AND TURKEY, BREZHNEV REGRETTED THAT SOVIET - UK RELATIONS WERE STAGNATING CONTRARY TO THE INTERESTS OF BOTH COUNTRIES.

12. RELATIONS WITH COMMUNIST PARTIES: BREZHNEV TOOK A MIDDLE COURSE HERE BY STRESSING THAT, ALTHOUGH DIFFERENCES OF VIEWPOINTS AMONG PARTIES ARE NATURAL AND FULLY IN ACCORD WITH LENINISM, CRITICISM OF MOSCOW WHICH DISTORTS "SOCIALIST REALITY" AND PLAYS INTO THE HANDS OF IMPERIALIST PROPAGANDA IS UNACCEPTABLE. HE ADMITTED CRITICISM BY OTHER CP'S OF CERTAIN "CONCRETE ASPECTS" OF DEVELOPMENT IN THE USSR AND RESPONDED THAT MOSCOW DOES NOT CLAIM ALL IN ITS POSSESSION TO BE IDEAL. PUTTING THE BURDEN OF DEFENSE ON THE EUROCOMMUNISTS. HOWEVER. BREZHNEV WARNED AGAINST FUNDAMENTAL DIFFER-ENCES BETWEEN REVOLUTIONARIES AND REFORMISTS OR BETWEEN CREATIVE MARXISM AND DOGMATIC SECTARIANISM OR ULTRA-LEFT ADVENTURISM. THE ITALIAN AND SPANISH PARTIES WERE CONSPICUOUSLY ABSENT FROM THE LISTING OF PARTIES WITH WHICH THE CPSU HAS GOOD. FRIENDLY RELATIONS.

13. IRAN-IRAQ: BREZHNEV USED STANDARD LANGUAGE ON THE IRAN-IRAQ CONFLICT, CHARACTERIZING IT AS A SENSELESS WAR" BEING TAKEN ADVANTAGE OF BY IMPERIALISM AND CALLING FOR AN EARLY POLITICAL SETTLEMENT. HIS CLAIM THAT THE SOVIET UNION WAS TRYING TO FACILITATE AN END TO THE WAR IN PRACTICE. MIGHT IMPLY SOME BEHIND-THE-SCENE MEDIATIONOR, MORELIKELY, CONTINUING RESTRAINT IN ARMS SALES TO THE BELLIGERENTS. IN A SEPARATE PASSAGE. BREZHNEV PRAISED THE IRANIAN REVOLUTION AS A MAJOR INTERNATIONAL EVENT, CALLING IT ESSENTIALLY ANTI-IMPERIALIST IN NATURE, NOTING SOVIET INTEREST IN DEVELOPING GOOD RELATIONS. HE BALANCED HIS COMMENTS. HOWEVER. BY NOTING THAT ISLAMIC MOVEMENTS COULD BE EITHER A LIBERATING OR COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCE.

14. JAPAN: BBEZHNEV TTOK A MORE NEGATIVE LINE

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ON JAPAN THAN HE HAD DURING HIS SPEECH AT ALMA ATA LAST AUGUST. REELECTING THE GENERAL DOWNTURN IN RELATIONS (MOSCOW 2444). HE COMMENTED THAT "NEGATIVE ELEMENTS" (PLAYING UP TO WASHINGTON AND PEKING AND MILITAAIZATION) ARE GAINNNG GROMINENCE IN JAPAN'S FOREIGN PPLICY, BUT NOT SURRPISSNGLY, SAID THAT FAR-SIGHTEDNESS WOULD PREVAIL IN TOKYO.

15. INDIA: BREZHNEV PREDICTABLY SINGLED OUT THE SOVIET UNION'S RELATIONS WITH INDIA. PRAISED (HIS OWN) RECENT NEGOTIATIONS IN INDIA, AND ASSERTED THAT "JOINT ACTION" WITH INDIA WOULD CONTINUE TO BE ONE OF THE IMPOTANT AREAS OF SOVIET FOREIGN

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- 16. SOUTHEAST ASIA: BREZHNEV PAID FAIRLY MINIMAL ATTENTION TO VIETNAM AND KAMPUCHEA. THERE WAS NO REFERENCE TO THE RECENT COMMUNIST PROPOSALS FOR INDOCHINA-ASEAN DISCUSSIONS. SURPRISINGLY. HE SINGLED OUT INDONESIA AS A PLACE WHERE THERE WERE "NO OBSTACLES TO FRIENDLY COOPERATION" AS WELL AS OTHER ASEAN MEMBER COUNTRIES.
- 17. SUMMIT OF SECURITY COUNCIL MEMBERS: BREZHNEV PROSED A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ATTENDED BY ITS MEMBERS' TOP LEADERS - AND OTHER LEADERS IF THEY WISH - TO LOOK FOR WAYS TO IMPROVE THE INTERNATIONAL SITUATION AND PREVENT WAR. THIS STRIKES US AS A NEW TWIST ON THE WARSAW PACT'S MAY 1980 PROPOSAL FOR A WORLD SUMMIT CONFERENCE TO DISCUSS INTERNATIONAL CRISIS AREAS.
- 18. LATIN AMERICA: BREZHNEV MADE ONLY PASSING REFERENCE TO LATIN AMERICA. SIGNIFICANTLY, EL SALVADOR RECEIVED NO MENTION. AND CUBA WAS BROUGHT UP ONLY IN THE LISTING OF SOCIALIST NATIONS. LACK OF ELABORATION OF CUBA'S INTERNATIONAL AUTHORITY AND STRUGGLE AGAINST IMPERIALISM (POINTS MADE IN THE 25TH PARTY CONGRESS BY BREZHNEV) STAND IN CONTRAST TO THE RECENT PRO-SOVIET GESTURES AT THE 2ND CUBAN PARTY CONGRESS BY FIDEL CASTRO, WHO IS ATTENDING THE CPSU CONGRESS.AND WHO, CONSPICUOUSLY, EMBRACED BREZHNEV AFTER THE LATTER RETURNED FROM THE PODIUM.
- 19. AFRICA: AFRICA WAS NOT STRESSED IN THE SPEECH, BUT BREZHNEV DID REFER TO THE "MOUNTING INTENSITY" OF THE LIBERATION STRUGGLE IN NAMIBIA AND "NOW ALSO IN THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA. HE ALSO REFERRED TO THE "DEFENSE CAPABILITY" OF ANGOLA AND ETHIOPIA. MATLOCK BT

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2. FOREIGN POLICY ISSUES AT THE SOVIET PARTY CONGRESS

Brezhnev will almost certainly reaffirm the USSR's commitment to detente as a basic foreign policy line, even though the Soviets no longer anticipate an early improvement in US-Soviet relations. While denying the validity of linkage, Moscow presumably recognizes that its relationship with the West for sometime to come will be shaped by the outcome of developments in Poland.

Brezhnev's keynote speech on February 23 will endorse the Party's "peace program," the ideological justification for the policy of detente first adopted in 1971. Long identified personally with the detente line, Brezhnev could hardly turn his back on it now.

The Soviets want Washington to bear the onus for the chill in US-Soviet relations. Professing to have been "insulted" by recent US statements, Moscow has taken the line that it is not going to "give in to provocations," and Brezhnev is likely to stress the USSF readiness to enter into East-West negotiations.

Brezhnev will probably lament Washington's failure to ratify SALT II, but stop short of categorically rejecting renegotiation of any part of it. He will want to appear ready and willing to work on arms control in a variety of forums—talks on TNF, the MBFR negotiations, a new European conference—and his speech may add some new items to the list of familiar Soviet disarmament proposals. While Moscow probably expects no early agreements in the disarmament field it almost certainly will try to generate West European interest in the possibilities of negotiation, hoping thereby to create pressure on Washington.

Brezhnev's public discussion of Poland perhaps may be limito an anodyne paragraph. But with all of the East European leaders: Moscow, Poland undoubtedly will be a major topic of top-level corridor discussion. Moreover, the Congress may provide an opportunity for a multilateral follow-up to the December Warsaw Pact summit.

On other foreign policy issues, the Congress will

- --denounce China for making common cause with imperialism, and Japan for whipping up anti-Soviet hysteria, but profess a desire to normalize relations with both countries; and
- --reaffirm support for national liberation struggles while excoriating the US on the terrorism issue.

- 3. WE DO NOT DOUBT THAT BREZHNEV'S EMPHASIS ON AN "ACTIVE DIALOGUE" WITH THE US REFLECTS A REAL DESIRE ON THE PART OF THE SOVIETS. HOWEVER, WE SEE HIS REFERENCES TO SUMMITRY AS BASICALLY A TACTICAL. PROPAGANDISTIC MOVE TO IMPROVE ATMOS-PHERICS WITHOUT DEALING REALISTICALLY WITH SPECIFIC ISSUES. IF IT WERE INTENDED AS A SERIOUS INITIATIVE, THE SOVIETS WOULD HAVE MOST LIKELY FIRST FLOATED IT WITH US IN PRIVATE. BREZHNEV'S SALT STANCE MAY BE INTENDED AS CONDUCIVE TO ENCOURAGING A HIGH LEVEL DIALOGUE, BUT WE FIND VERY LITTLE ELSE POSITIVE IN HIS VARIOUS "INITIATIVES". AS WE READ THE SPEECH. BREZHNEV HAS GIVEN NO GROUND ON THE BASIC INTERNA-TIONAL ISSUES THAT DIVIDE US. NOR DOES HE GIVE ANY INDICATION THAT THEY WOULD CONSIDER NEGOTIATING A REAL CHANGE IN THEIR POLICIES THAT HAVE BROUGHT ABOUT THE STRAINED INTERNATIONAL CLIMATE.

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8. - AFGHANISTAN AND THE PERSIAN GULF: IN ANOTHER NEW DEPARTURE, BREZHNEV STATED THAT MOSCOW DOES NOT OBJECT TO THE "QUESTIONS CONNECTED WITH AFGHANISTAN" BEING DISCUSSED TOGETHER WITH QUESTIONS OF PERSIAN GULF SECURITY, ALTHOUGH HE SAID THE SOVIET UNION ALSO STANDS READY TO DISCUSS EACH PROBLEM SEPARATELY. HE ADDED THE STANDARD SOVIET POSITION THAT THE SOVIETS' WOULD ONLY DISCUSS THE "INTERNATIONAL ASPECTS OF THE AFGHAN PROBLEM" AND NOT INTERNAL AFGHAN AAFAIRS.

CINCEUR, SHAPE FOR POLAD/INTAFF MADRID FOR CSCE AFGHANISTAN'S SOVEREIGNTY. LIKE ITS NON-ALIGNED STATUS. MUST BE "FULLY PROTECTED." HE SAID. THE PLOY OF LINKING AFGHANISTAN TO THE SOVIET PERSIAN GULF SECURITY PROPOSAL CLEARLY IS DESIGNED

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TO CONVEY THE IMPRESSION OF SOVIET FLEXIBILITY ON AFGHANISTAN, TO INCREASE THE ATTRACTIVENESS OF THE PERSIAN GULF INITIATIVE AND TO TRY TO WEAKEN WESTERN ARGUMENTS THAT SOVIET TROOPS IN AFGHANISTAN ARE THE CHIEF SECURITY PROBLEM IN THE REGION. BREZHNEV AGAIN CLAIMED THAT SOVIET TROOPS WERE SENT INTO AFGHANISTAN IN RESPONSE TO THE DIRECT THREAT ON ITS SOUTHERN BORDER, AND REPEATED THE FORMULA THAT THEY WILL BE WITHDRAWN ONLY WHEN OUTSIDE INFILTRATION IS COMPLETELY STOOPED, AGREEMENTS ARE SIGNED WITH AFGHANISTAN'S NEIGHBORS, AND GUARANTEES AGAINST NEW INTERVENTION ARE IN PLACE.

9. CHINA; BREZHNEV TOOK A FAIRLY UPBEAT APPRRACH TO CHINA, SSOTER THAN GROMYKO'S RECENT ARTICLE IN KOMMUNIST. HE NOTED THE INTERNAL CHANGES IN CHINA ("TIME WILL ONLY SHOW WHAT THEY MEAN"), ADDING, HOWEVER, THAT THERE ARE NO "CHANGES FOR THE BETTER" IN CHINA'S FOREIGN POLICY. HE ACCUSED THE US, JAPAN, AND SOME NATT COUNTRIES OF WANTING TO EXXAND TIES WITH CHINA TO USE ITS HOSTTLITY TOOARD THE SOVIET UNION FOR THEIR OWN INTERESTS AND CALLED THIS A "HAZARDOUS GAME." HE ADVOCATED IMPROVED TIES BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES ON A "GOOD-NEIGHBOR" BASIS.

10. MIDDLE EAST: BREZHNEV ADVOCATED A "SPECIALLY CONVENED INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE" ON AN ARAB-ISRAELI SETTLEMENT AND RENEWED HIS CALL FOR COLLECTIVE EFFORTS. BUT PHRASING IT THIS TIME IN TERMS OF A COLLECTIVE SEARCH OF AN ALL-EMBRACING JUST AND REALISTIC SETTLEMENT. HE SPECIFICALLY INCLUDED AS "INTERESTED PARTIES" IN THIS EFFORT, THE ARABS. THE PLO. ISRAEL AND THE UNITED STATES. HE ALLUDED TO THE OCTOBER 1977 JOINT U.S.-USSR COMMUNIQUE BY STATING, WE ARE PREPARED FOR SUCH A SEARCH JOINTLY WITH THE UNITED STATES - AND I MAY REMIND YOU THAT WE HAVE HAD SOME EXPERIENCE IN THIS REGARD SOME YEARS IN A SECONDARY MANNER, HE GAVE A NOD TO THE EUROPEAN COUNTRIES AND SAID THE SOVIET UNION IS PREPARED TO COOPERATE WITH THEM. THE UN IS ALSO SINGLED OUT TO CONTINUE TO PLAY A USEFUL ROLE. CONCERNING THE SUBSTANCE OF A SETTLEMENT. HE REPEATED THE WELL-KNOWN SOVIET POSITION WITH SPECIFIC REFER-ENCE TO THE "INALIENABLE RIGHTS OF THE ARAB PEOPLE OF PALESTINE...NOT SHORT OF ESTABLISHING THEIR OWN

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STATE" AND ENSURING "THE SECURITY AND SOVEREIGNTY OF ALL THE STATES OF THE REGION, INCLUDING THOSE OF ISRAEL." THE DETAILS OF A SETTLEMENT, HE CONCLUDED, COULD BE TAKEN UP AT THE NEGOTIATIONS.

11. - WESTERN EUROPE: BREZHNEV INDICATED
CONSIDERABLE DIFFERENTIATION IN RELATIONS WITH
WESTERN EUROPE, WITH FRANCE AT THE TOP OF THE
LIST, THE UK AT THE BOTTOM, AND FRG SOMEWHERE BETWEEN.
HE STRESSED THE PRACTICALLY "UNINTERRUPTED"

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CINCEUR, SHAPE FOR POLAD INTAFF MADRID FOR CSCE POLITICAL DIALOGUE WITH FRANCE AS A "MAJOR FACTOR" IN DETENTE. IT IS SIGNIFICANT IN TERMS OF SOVIET ATTITUDE TOWARD BERLIN THAT, WHILE PRAISING FRG-SOVIET RELATIONS AND INCREASED TRADE, HE ALSO RAPPED

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BONN ON THE KNUCKLES FOR "OCCASIONAL" ATTEMPTS TO CIRCUMVENT THE QUADRIPARTITE AGREEMENT AND DISREGARD THE SOVEREIGNTY OF THE GDR. AFTER SPECIFIC POSITIVE MENTION OF ITALY. FINLAND. AND TURKEY, BREZHNEV REGRETTED THAT SOVIET - UK RELATIONS WERE STAGNATING CONTRARY TO THE INTERESTS OF BOTH COUNTRIES.

12. RELATIONS WITH COMMUNIST PARTIES: BREZHNEV TOOK A MIDDLE COURSE HERE BY STRESSING THAT, ALTHOUGH DIFFERENCES OF VIEWPOINTS AMONG PARTIES ARE NATURAL AND FULLY IN ACCORD WITH LENINISM, CRITICISM OF MOSCOW WHICH DISTORTS "SOCIALIST REALITY" AND PLAYS INTO THE HANDS OF IMPERIALIST PROPAGANDA IS UNACCEPTABLE. HE ADMITTED CRITICISM BY OTHER CP'S OF CERTAIN "CONCRETE ASPECTS" OF DEVELOPMENT IN THE USSR AND RESPONDED THAT MOSCOW DOES NOT CLAIM ALL IN ITS POSSESSION TO BE IDEAL. PUTTING THE BURDEN OF DEFENSE ON THE EUROCOMMUNISTS. HOWEVER. BREZHNEV WARNED AGAINST FUNDAMENTAL DIFFER-ENCES BETWEEN REVOLUTIONARIES AND REFORMISTS OR BETWEEN CREATIVE MARXISM AND DOGMATIC SECTARIANISM OR ULTRA-LEFT ADVENTURISM. THE ITALIAN AND SPANISH PARTIES WERE CONSPICUOUSLY ABSENT FROM THE LISTING OF PARTIES WITH WHICH THE CPSU HAS GOOD. FRIENDLY RELATIONS.

13 IRAN-IRAQ; BREZHNEV USED STANDARD LANGUAGE ON THE IRAN-IRAQ CONFLICT. CHARACTERIZING IT AS A "SENSELESS WAR" BEING TAKEN ADVANTAGE OF BY IMPERIALISM AND CALLING FOR AN EARLY POLITICAL SETTLEMENT. HIS CLAIM THAT THE SOVIET UNION WAS TRYING TO FACILITATE AN END TO THE WAR "IN PRACTICE." MIGHT IMPLY SOME BEHIND-THE-SCENE MEDIATIONOR, MORELIKELY, CONTINUING RESTRAINT IN ARMS SALES TO THE BELLIGERENTS. IN A SEPARATE PASSAGE, BREZHNEV PRAISED THE IRANIAN REVOLUTION AS A MAJOR INTERNATIONAL EVENT, CALLING IT ESSENTIALLY ANTI-IMPERIALIST IN NATURE, NOTING SOVIET INTEREST IN DEVELOPING GOOD RELATIONS. HE BALANCED HIS COMMENTS, HOWEVER, BY NOTING THAT ISLAMIC MOVEMENTS COULD BE EITHER A LIBERATING OR COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCE.

JAPAN: BBEZHNEV TTOK A MORE NEGATIVE LINE ON JAPAN THAN HE HAD DURING HIS SPEECH AT ALMA ATA LAST AUGUST. REELECTING THE GENERAL DOWNTURN IN

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RELATIONS (MOSCOW 2444). HE COMMENTED THAT
"NEGATIVE ELEMENTS" (PLAYING UP TO WASHINGTON
AND PEKING AND MILITAAIZATION) ARE GAINNNG GROMINENCE
IN JAPAN'S FOREIGN PPLICY, BUT NOT SURRPISSINGLY,
SAID THAT FAR-SIGHTEDNESS WOULD PREVAIL IN TOKYO.

15. INDIA: BREZHNEV PREDICTABLY SINGLED OUT THE SOVIET UNION'S RELATIONS WITH INDIA, PRAISED (HIS OWN) RECENT NEGOTIATIONS IN INDIA, AND ASSERTED THAT "JOINT ACTION" WITH INDIA WOULD CONTINUE TO BE ONE OF THE IMPORTANT AREAS OF SOVIET FOREIGN BT

16. SOUTHEAST ASIA: BREZHNEV PAID FAIRLY MINIMAL

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ATTENTION TO VIETNAM AND KAMPUCHEA. THERE WAS NO REFERENCE TO THE RECENT COMMUNIST PROPOSALS FOR INDOCHINA-ASEAN DISCUSSIONS. SURPRISINGLY, HE SINGLED OUT INDONESIA AS A PLACE WHERE THERE WERE "NO OBSTACLES TO FRIENDLY COOPERATION" AS WELL AS OTHER ASEAN MEMBER COUNTRIES.

17. SUMMIT OF SECURITY COUNCIL MEMBERS: BREZHNEV PROSED A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ATTENDED BY ITS MEMBERS' TOP LEADERS - AND OTHER LEADERS IF THEY WISH - TO GMOK FOR WAYS TO IMPROVE THE INTERNATIONAL SITUATION AND PREVENT WAR. THIS STRIKES US AS A NEW TWIST ON THE WARSAW PACT'S MAY 1980 PROPOSAL FOR A WORLD SUMMIT CONFERENCE TO DISCUSS INTERNATIONAL CRISIS AREAS.

18. LATIN AMERICA: BREZHNEV MADE ONLY PASSING REFERENCE TO LATIN AMERICA. SIGNIFICANTLY, EL SALVADOR RECEIVED NO MENTION, AND CUBA WAS BROUGHT UP ONLY IN THE LISTING OF SOCIALIST NATIONS. LACK OF ELABORATION OF CUBA'S INTERNATIONAL AUTHORITY AND STRUGGLE AGAINST IMPERIALISM (POINTS MADE IN THE 25TH PARTY CONGRESS BY BREZHNEV) STAND IN CONTRAST TO THE RECENT PRO-SOVIET GESTURES AT THE 2ND CUBAN PARTY CONGRESS BY FIDEL CASTRO, WHO IS ATTENDING THE CPSU CONGRESS.AND WHO, CONSPICUOUSLY, EMBRACED BREZHNEV AFTER THE LATTER RETURNED FROM THE PODIUM.

19. AFRICA: AFRICA WAS NOT STRESSED IN THE SPEECH, BUT BREZHNEV DID REFER TO THE "MOUNTING INTENSITY" OF THE LIBERATION STRUGGLE IN NAMIBIA AND "NOW ALSO" IN THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA. HE ALSO REFERRED TO THE "DEFENSE CAPABILITY" OF ANGOLA AND ETHIOPIA. MATLOCK BT

BREZHNEY'S SPEECH TO THE XXVI CPSU CONGRESS INDICATES THAT THE SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY LEADERSHIP STILL BELIEVES THAT THE PILLARS OF SOCIALISM ARE IN JEOPARDY" IN POLAND, AND EMPHASIZES THE CONTINUING DANGER OF ALLEGED "IMPERIALIST SUBVERSION," THEREBY MAINTAINING THE POLITICAL GROUNDWORK FOR THE CON-TINGENCY OF SOVIET INTERVENTION. THE CPSU CENTRAL COMMITTEE'S REPORT SUGGESTS THAT MOSCOW HAS NOT YET GIVEN UP ON THE POLISH REGIME'S OWN EFFORTS TO PULL THE COUNTRY OUT OF THE CRISIS. POINTING APPROVINGLY TO THE RECOVERY PROGRAM LAUNCHED AT THE RECENT POLISH COMMUNIST PARTY PLENUM. BUT IN REAFFIRMING THE GENERAL LINE ADOPTED AT THE DECEMBER 5 WARSAW PACT SUMMIT, BREZHNEV CONSPICUOUSLY OMITS A CITATION OF THE SUMMIT COMMUNIQUE'S EX-PRESSION OF CONFIDENCE IN THE POLES' OWN ABILITY TO SURMOUNT THE CRISIS, EMPHASIZING INSTEAD THAT THE SOVIETS AND THE OTHER WARSAW PACT ALLIES ARE PREPARED TO DEFEND THE SOCIALIST GAINS OF THE POLISH PEOPLE BY WHATEVER MEANS NECESSARY. NONE-THELESS. BREZHNEV'S REPORT INDIRECTLY ACKNOWLEDGES THE LEGITIMACY OF SOME OF THE POLISH WORKERS' COM-PLAINTS AGAINST THE SYSTEM, CALLING ON THE CPSU. TO PAY CLOSER HEED TO THE "VOICE OF THE MASSES," TO COMBAT "BUREAUCRATISM AND VOLUNTARISM," AND TO BE CAUTIOUS FOREIGN ECONOMIC POLICY. IT ALSO CONCEDES THAT NATIONAL FEATURES CAN AFFECT THE FORMS OF SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC ORGANIZATION EMPLOYED TO REACH A SOCIALIST WAY OF LIFE.

AND WORKING ON A CONCRETE PROGRAM TO RESTORE TO HEALTH THE POLISH ECONOMY: -- THE DECEMBER WARSAW PACT SUMMIT "HAS RENDERED

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THAT BREZHNEV DELIVERED A THREE HOUR AND FORTY MINUTE SPEECH AT THE OPENING SESSION OF THE CONGRESS. THE EVENING NEWS PROGRAM VREMYA'S TELECASTING. IN EDITED FORM. OF MANY PORTIONS OF THE SPEECH WHICH WERE NOT CARRIED LIVE HAS LARGELY SUBSTANTIATED ZAMYATIN'S CLAIM. BREZHNEV IN FACT LOOKED STRONG IN VREMYA'S EDITED VERSION. THE EXCISION OF ALL BUT THE OPENING AND CLOSING OF BREZHNEV'S SPEECH FROM THE LIVE TELEVISION AND RADIO COVERAGE UNDER-SCORES, HOWEVER, THE SOVIET REGIME'S CONCERN THAT BREZHNEV'S UNEDITED SPEAKING PERFORMANCE WOULD NOT DO HIM CREDIT, BUT WOULD HEIGHTEN THE PUBLIC'S CONCERN ABOUT HIS LEADERSHIP CAPABILITIES. THE AWKWARD HANDLING -- FROM A PUBLIC RELATIONS PER-SPECTIVE -- OF THE COVERAGE OF BREZHNEV MAY ADD TO SUCH CONCERN ANYWAY. END SUMMARY.

- (U) AT A LATE AFTERNOON PRESS CONFERENCE FEBRUARY 23. CENTRAL COMMITTEE PRESS SPOKESMAN ZAMYATIN SOUGHT TO THROW COLD WATER ON SPECULA-TION ABOUT LIMITED LIVE COVERAGE OF BREZHNEV'S SPEECH. HE CLAIMED THAT BREZHNEV HAD DELIVERED THE ENTIRE SPEECH "AT A VERY GOOD PACE AND WITH HIGH ENTHUSIASM". SPEAKING FOR THREE HOURS AND FORTY MINUTES WITH ONLY TWO BRIEF INTERMISSIONS.
- 3. (U) IN ANSWER TO PRESS QUERIES, ZAMYATIN ARGUED THAT THERE IS NOT A "TRADITION" FOR TELEVISION BROADCAST OF THE SPEECHES. WHEN REMINDED THAT THE 1976 CONGRESS SPEECH HAD BEEN COVERED LIVE (AT THE OPENING SESSION OF THE 1976 CONGRESS, BREZHNEV SPOKE FOR FIVE HOURS, WITH TWO BREAKS), ZAMYATIN CLAIMED THAT THE "TRADITION" HE MENTIONED WAS THAT EACH CONGRESS DETERMINES ITS OWN RULES AND THE NATURE OF THE BROADCASTS IT PROVIDES OF THE PROCEEDINGS. IN THIS CASE. "LEADING BODIES OF THE PARTY" HAD DECIDED IN FAVOR OF THE LIMITED BROADCAST.
- 4. (U) THE EVENING NEWS PROGRAM VREMYA IN A SPECIAL EXPANDED. TWO-HOUR. VERSION DEVOTED TO THE CONGRESS. LARGELY SUBSTANTIATED ZAMYATIN'S CONTEN-TION. VREMYA CARRIED LONG FILM CLIPS OF PORTIONS OF THE BREZHNEV SPEECH -- INCLUDING THE VAST BULK OF THE FOREIGN POLICY SECTION AND MORE SELECTIVE PORTIONS OF THE SECTION ON INTERNAL POLICY --WHICH WERE NOT CARRIED LIVE EARLIER. THE FILM

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CLIPS WERE EDITED, DELETING ANY MAJOR GAFFES AND SHOWING BREZHNEV SPEAKING SMOOTHLY AND WITH ONLY OCCASIONAL SLURRING. (IN CONTRAST, BREZHNEV MADE SEVERAL MISTAKES AND TOOK FOUR DRINKS IN THE LESS THAN EIGHT MINUTES OF LIVE COVERAGE OF THE OPENING OF THE SPEECH.)

5. (6) COMMENT: THE EXCISION OF ALL BUT THE OPENING AND CLOSING PORTIONS OF THE BREZHNEV SPEECH FROM LIVE TELEVISION AND RADIO COVERAGE APPEARS TO REFLECT THE REGIME'S FEAR THAT BREZHNEV'S HEALTH WOULD NOT PERMIT A GOOD SPEAKING PERFORMANCE, AND ET

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SOVIET UNION, A LACK OF FOREIGN POLICY SUCCESSES, AND DOMESTIC IMMOBILITY. BREZHNEV ATTEMPTED TO PAINT AN OPTIMISTIC PICTURE OF THE SOVIET UNION'S POSITION AND POLICIES. HIS EMPHASIS WAS ON THE SOVIET UNION'S PEACEFUL" APPROACH AND, FOR CONSISTENCY, HE AVOIDED MUCH OF THE RECENT STRONG POLEMICS IN THE SOVIET PRESS. HE ALSO GENERALLY DEEMPHASIZED SOVIET INVOLVE-MENT IN THE WORLD'S TROUBLE SPOTS AND TREADED LIGHTLY ON SUPPORT FOR NATIONAL LIBERATION MOVEMENTS. HE DID NOT, HOWEVER, MAKE ANY CONCESSIONS ON SUCH KEY ISSUES AS POLAND AND AFGHANISTAN, LEAVING LITTLE DOUBT ON POLAND THAT THE SOVIETS WOULD NOT ALLOW THE SITUATION TO DETERIORATE TO A POINT THAT THREATENED PRIMARY SOVIET CONTROL AND INFLUENCE.

- 3. WE DO NOT DOUBT THAT BREZHNEY'S EMPHASIS ON AN "ACTIVE DIALOGUE" WITH THE US REFLECTS A REAL DESIRE ON THE PART OF THE SOVIETS. HOWEVER, WE SEE HIS REFERENCES TO SUMMITRY AS BASICALLY A TACTICAL. PROPAGANDISTIC MOVE TO IMPROVE ATMOS-PHERICS WITHOUT DEALING REALISTICALLY WITH SPECIFIC ISSUES. IF IT WERE INTENDED AS A SERIOUS INITIATIVE. THE SOVIETS WOULD HAVE MOST LIKELY FIRST FLOATED IT -WITH US IN PRIVATE. BREZHNEV'S SALT STANCE MAY BE INTENDED AS CONDUCIVE TO ENCOURAGING A HIGH LEVEL DIALOGUE, BUT WE FIND VERY LITTLE ELSE POSITIVE IN HIS VARIOUS "INITIATIVES". AS WE READ THE SPEECH, BREZHNEV HAS GIVEN NO GROUND ON THE BASIC INTERNA-TIONAL ISSUES THAT DIVIDE US, NOR DOES HE GIVE ANY INDICATION THAT THEY WOULD CONSIDER NEGOTIATING A REAL CHANGE IN THEIR POLICIES THAT HAVE BROUGHT ABOUT THE STRAINED INTERNATIONAL CLIMATE.
- 4. ONE CAN READ INTO THE BREZHNEV SPEECH THE SUG-GESTION THAT THERE SHOULD BE A TACIT RECOGNITION OF SOVIET AND US SPHERES OF INFLUENCE. BREZHNEV WAS QUITE RESERVED ON LATIN AMERICA AND OTHER AREAS (SOUTHEAST ASIA, AFRICA) FAR FROM SOVIET BORDERS. HE WAS. HOWEVER. RIGID ON POLAND AND AFGHANISTAN. IN FACT, IT IS POSSIBLE TO READ THE ENTIRE SPEECH AS LITTLE MORE THAN AN EFFORT TO POSITION THE SOVIETS IN THE BEST POSSIBLE WAY. IF THEY DECIDE TO INVADE OR ENCOURAGE A TOUGH INTERNAL CRACKDOWN IN POLAND. THE SPHERE OF INFLUENCE CONCEPT HAS DEEP ROOTS IN MOSCOW AND WE MAY HEAR MORE OF IT AS WE TAKE A TOUGH STAND ON LATIN AMERICAN ISSUES.
- BREZHNEV IN HIS SPEECH WAS, OF COURSE, SPEAKING TO OTHER AUDIENCES IN ADDITION TO THE US. HIS

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EFFORT TO DRIVE A WEDGE BETWEEN THE US AND THE WESTERN EUROPEANS WAS PREDICTABLE; DETENTE IS POSSIBLE IF THE EUROPEANS COOPERATE. BUT POLAND IS NOT A SUBJECT OF DISCUSSION. THE DOOR IS LEFT OPEN FOR THE CHINESE AND THE JAPANESE IF THEY WILL MEND THEIR WAYS. AND BREZHNEV LEFT NO DOUBT THAT

THE SOVIET UNION AS REASONABLE AND PURSUING INITIATIVES FOR PEACE AS WELL AS THE AFGHANISTAN-PERSIAN
GULF PROPOSAL PLOY WERE DIRECTED TOWARD THE WORLD
AT LARGE AND WERE CLEARLY DESIGNED TO RECOUP SOME
OF THE INTERNATIONAL PRESTIGE THE SOVIET UNION HAS
LOST OVER THE PAST YEAR ESPECIALLY IN THE NAM AND

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AMONG THE ISLAMIC COUNTRIES. IN NONE OF THESE CASES IS THE SPEECH LIKELY TO REALLY CHANGE THE BASIC ATTITUDES OF THOSE TO WHOM IT WAS INTENDED.

6. PERHAPS THE MOST INNTERESTED AUDIENCE. HOWEVER. WAS THE ONE AT HOME IN THE SOVIET UNION. OVER THE PAST MONTH. WE HAVE PICKED UP SOME INDICATIONS THAT THE HARSH SOVIET PROPAGANDA ON THE US AND THE PER-CEIVED DETERIORATION IN SOVIET-US RELATIONS HAS RAISED APPREHENSIONS AMONG SOME SECTIONS OF THE SOVIET ELITE. WHILE A "WAR SCARE" WOULD BE AN OVERLY DRAMATIC CHARACTERIZATION. THERE HAS SEEMED TO BE A REAL WORRY THAT A RETURN TO THE COLD WAR. OR WORSE. IS A SERIOUS POSSIBILITY. BREZHNEV'S TONE MAY WELL HAVE BEEN INTENDED TO DAMPEN SUCH CONCERNS. HE NOTED EARLY IN HIS SPEECH THE IMPORTANCE TO THE MAN IN THE STREET OF THE PARTY'S "MANAGING TO PRESERVE PEACE," AND THE THRUST OF HIS COMMENTS WERE CLEARLY INTENDED TO SUGGEST THE CHANCES FOR CONTINUING ON THIS PATH WERE GOOD.

7. IN SUM AND IN LOOKING BEYOND THE RHETORIC, WE SEE BREZHNEY'S REPORT AS BASICALLY A SIGN THAT THE SOVIET UNION HAS REACHED AN IMPASSE ON SEVERAL FOREIGN POLICY FRONTS, ESPECIALLY AFGHANISTAN AND POLAND. THE SOVIET PROPOSALS ARE AN ATTEMPT TO MOVE THE OVERALL SITUATION THEY FIND THEMSELVES IN OFF DEAD CENTER ON A LEAST-COST BASIS TO SOVIET INTERESTS AND NEGOTIATING POSITIONS. WE DETECT AN ELEMENT OF THEIR SEARCHING FOR SOLUTIONS, BUT WITH TRADITIONAL RIGIDITY ON GUT ISSUES. INDEED, THE INITIATIVES SHOULD BE NOTED MORE FOR THEIR QUANTITY THAN FOR THEIR SUBSTANCE. MATLOCK

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
