PRESIDENT/TRIP (Cape Girardeau, Mo./Joseph Mianowany/UPI/adv 1:30 p.m. edt) -- President Reagan, pushing for George Bush in the Midwest, today attacked Democratic leadership as a "Nightmare on Elm Street," boasted of Republican advances since 1981 and warned future generations would "dishonor us if now in a moment of sudden folly we throw it all away." The President, pitching in to help his second-in-command in his campaign against Michael Dukakis, never mentioned the Massachusetts governor by name in prepared remarks, but turned his rhetorical fire on "liberals" and the last Democratic administration of Jimmy Carter. "America has traveled such a remarkable distance in the last eight years that the memory has faded of the economic and foreign policy crises that we faced when Vice President Bush and I took office," Reagan said in remarks prepared for delivery at Southeast Missouri State University. "The truth is that when you take a walk down our opposition's memory lane, it starts to look like a 'Nightmare on Elm Street,'" Reagan, referring to a popular horror movie.

(Cape Girardeau, Mo./Dale Nelson/AP/adv 1:30 p.m. edt) --President Reagan, on a political trip for Vice President Bush, declared today that the national economy is strong and "what we have seen in the last eight years is only the beginning. We intend to ensure this kind of economic prosperity right through the '90s and into the next century by guaranteeing the federal government can never again spend and tax the American people into another economic nightmare," Reagan said.

SESSIONS/CISPES (AP) -- FBI Director Sessions said today he is suspending three bureau employees and censuring three others for mishandling a terrorism investigation into political opponents of the Reagan Administration's Central American policy. "I am disciplining these individuals...because of the managerial or supervisory inadequacies displayed by them" during a bureau investigation of the Committee in Solidarity with the People of El Salvador, Sessions told a congressional committee. "The mistakes in judgment that took place during the CISPES investigation were serious ones, and I cannot emphasize too strongly my firm conviction that there is no place for such mistakes in the work of the FBI," Sessions told the Senate Intelligence Committee.

HODEL/FOREST FIRES POLICY (AP) -- Interior Secretary Hodel said today the government's "let burn" forest fire policy, proven inadequate in the face of this summer's extraordinarily dry conditions, will be revised before next year's fire season. To maintain that the 16-year-old policy is sound "just doesn't make sense," he said in an interview on NBC's "Today" show. "I am confident that before the next fire season, we'll have a revised policy in place which will take into account these kinds of conditions," Hodel said.

SOUTH AFRICA SANCTIONS (UPI) -- The Senate Foreign Relations Committee voted 10-9 today, along party lines, for a bill calling for a virtual trade embargo against South Africa. The measure faces a filibuster on the floor led by Sen. Helms which may well prevent the measure from coming to a vote. "It's going nowhere," Helms said. "In the unlikely event the measure ever gets to the floor of the Senate, there will be a long and hard debate about it." White House News Summary - Wednesday, September 14, 1988 - Page 2 of 2

GULF TALKS (Baghdad/Reuter) -- Iraq on Wednesday accused Iran of abandoning its commitment to seek peace at U.N.-sponsored talks in Geneva. "If negotiations are still at square one, all indications clearly point to the Iranian side as fully responsible," the ruling Baath party daily Al-Thawra said. It said Iran had been procrastinating since the talks opened on August 25 and it had abandoned its "documented commitments" to peace which put a formal cease-fire in place five days earlier.

U.S./LEBANON (Beirut/UPI) -- Assistant Secretary of State Richard Murphy met with Syrian officials in Damascus today to discuss Lebanon's political crisis, Beirut radio reported. The radio said Murphy and U.S. Embassy diplomats met Foreign Minister Farouk Al Sharaa in the Syrian capital. The talks focused on ways to end the crisis, triggered by Parliament's failure last month to elect a new president. The report said Murphy was scheduled to meet with President Assad and Vice President Khaddam, Syria's expert on Lebanese affairs, later today.


