SUMMARY OF PRESIDENTIAL MEETING WITH AFGHAN

ALLIANCE DELEGATION

1. C - ENTIRE TEXT.

2. IN A FORTY-MINUTE MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT ON JUNE 16, AFGHAN RESISTANCE ALLIANCE SPOKESMAN, BURHANUDDIN RABBANI, APPEALED FOR OFFICIAL USG RECOGNITION OF THE RESISTANCE AND MORE EFFECTIVE WEAPONS, PARTICULARLY FOR AIR DEFENSE. RABBANI DESCRIBED SOVIET ATROCITIES IN SOME DETAIL AND THE RESULTS OF CONCERTED - IF VAIN - SOVIET ATTEMPTS TO BREAK THE WILL OF THE AFGHAN PEOPLE: ONE MILLION MARTYRS, FIVE MILLION REFUGEES, AND A LAND OF BLOOD AND ASHES. RABBANI LAMENTED THAT DESPITE THEIR SUFFERING AND CONTINUED RESISTANCE THEY WERE DENIED REPRESENTATION AT THE UN AND AT THE GENEVA NEGOTIATIONS. RABBANI STRESSED THAT NO AGREEMENTS SHOULD BE REACHED THAT WERE AGAINST THE WILL OF THE AFGHAN PEOPLE. PARTY LEADER GAILANI ADDED THAT THE AFGHAN PEOPLE'S STRUGGLE, WHICH ANTEDATED THE SOVIET INVASION, WAS FOR SELF-DETERMINATION.

3. RABBANI EXPRESSED DEEP SCEPTICISM ABOUT SOVIET

INTENTIONS, NOTING THAT GORBACHEV HAS AN IRON FIST BENEATH HIS VELVET GLOVE AND PROMISES OF GOOD WILL. THE ALLIANCE WAS THEREFORE ANXIOUS ABOUT US WILLINGNESS TO GUARANTEE AN AGREEMENT. LEADER MOHAMED! STRESSED THAT THE SOVIETS WOULD SIGN AN AGREEMENT AND THEN NOT ABIDE BY IT. RABBANI CONCLUDED BY THANKING THE PRESIDENT FOR HIS PERSONAL SUPPORT OF THE AFGHAN STRUGGLE FOR FREEDOM.

3. PRESIDENT REAGAN SAID IT WAS AN HONOR TO SUPPORT THE

AFGHAN STRUGGLE FOR INDEPENDENCE. REFERRING TO THE ALLIANCE LEADERSHIP AS THE TRUE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE AFGHAN PEOPLE, THE PRESIDENT NOTED THE ALLIANCE SHOULD COOPERATE MORE CLOSELY TO MOBILIZE THE ENTIRE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY IN AN EFFORT TO GAIN THE INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION THAT WE BOTH SEEK FOR IT. RECOGNITION OF THE ALLIANCE BY ONLY ONE COUNTRY WOULD NOT BE VERY HELPFUL. IN THE MEANTIME, MAINTAINING A US OFFICIAL PRESENCE IN KABUL WAS USEFUL FOR OTHER REASONS.

- THE PRESIDENT STATED THAT THE US HAD NO ILLUSIONS ABOUT SOVIET GOALS AND METHODS WHICH WAS WHY WE REJECTED SEPARATE DEALS WITH MOSCOW. THE PRESIDENT STRESSED THAT THE US WOULD NEITHER ACCEPT NOR GUARANTEE AN AGREEMENT THAT DID NOT PROVIDE FOR A SHORT - 3 TO 6 MONTH -WITHDRAWAL TIMETABLE AND FOR THE PEOPLE OF AFGHANISTAN TO CHOOSE THEIR OWN GOVERNMENT. THE PRESIDENT SAID THAT A VIABLE SETTLEMENT REQUIRED ALLIANCE CONSULTATIONS AND THE AFGHAN PEOPLE'S SUPPORT OF THE TERMS OF AN AGREEMENT. HE SAID THE US HAD URGED THE UN TO CONSULT THE ALLIANCE. THE PRESIDENT SAID WE WOULD BRIEF THE DELEGATION ON THE STATUS OF THE TALKS AND HOPED THIS MEETING WAS THE BEGINNING OF A CONTINUING DIALOGUE. THE PRESIDENT ASSERTED THAT THE USSR MUST BE MADE TO REALIZE THAT AGGRESSION DOES NOT PAY. THE BRAVE RESISTANCE OF THE MUJAHIDIN WAS AN EMBARRASSMENT TO THE SOVIETS. THE PRESIDENT PLEDGED CONTINUED US SUPPORT OF AND ASSISTANCE TO THE RESISTANCE UNTIL FINAL VICTORY.

PRESIDENT'S STATEMENT MARKING RABBANI VISIT

1. BEGIN WHITE HOUSE TEXT OF PRESIDENT REAGAN'S STATEMENT MARKING THE RABBANI VISIT: (RELEASED JUNE 16)

I MET THIS MORNING WITH LEADERS OF THE AFGHAN RESISTANCE ALLIANCE: PROFESSOR BURHANUDDIN RABBANI, WHO IS THE SPOKESMAN OF THE ALLIANCE, AND HIS COLLEAGUES. THEY SPEAK FOR THE MANY CITIZENS OF AFGHANISTAN WHO ARE BATTLING SOVIET FORCES IN THE NAME OF NATIONAL LIBERATION.

MY MESSAGE TO THE RESISTANCE WAS SIMPLE. IN YOUR STRUGGLE TO REGAIN YOUR NATION'S INDEPENDENCE, THE AMERICAN PEOPLE STAND WITH YOU. THIS POLICY HAS BROAD AND DEEP BIPARTISAN SUPPORT. IT IS AN UNSHAKEABLE COMMITMENT. YOUR GOAL IS OUR GOAL: THE FREEDOM OF AFGHANISTAN. WE WILL NOT LET YOU DOWN.

LIKE THE AFGHAN PEOPLE, WE HOPE FOR A NEGOTIATED END TO THIS WAR. YEAR AFTER YEAR, U.N. RESOLUTIONS HAVE CALLED FOR A TOTAL AND RAPID WITHDRAWAL OF SOVIET TROOPS, AND FOR SELF-DETERMINATION FOR THE AFGHAN PEOPLE.

LET US RENEW THAT CALL TODAY. ONLY AN AGREEMENT THAT HAS THE SUPPORT OF THE AFGHAN PEOPLE CAN WORK. THIS IS A FACT OF LIFE. AND IT IS WHY THE ROLE OF THE RESISTANCE ALLIANCE IS CRUCIAL. THE DIVERSITY OF THE ALLIANCE --ITS ROOTS IN THE FAITH AND TRADITIONS OF AFGHANISTAN --SHOWS THAT THE ALLIANCE IS THE TRUE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE AFGHAN PEOPLE.

PEOPLE EVERYWHERE ADMIRE THE COURAGE OF THE AFGHANS, BUT THE PEOPLE AND GOVERNMENT OF PAKISTAN HAVE ALSO BORNE A LARGE SHARE OF THE BURDEN OF SOVIET PRESSURE AND INTIMIDATION WE ARE HONORED TO JOIN WITH THEM IN SUPPORTING AFGHAN FREEDOM. END TEXT OF STATEMENT

2. BEGIN TEXT OF REMARKS BY LARRY SPEAKES AT WHITE HOUSE BRIEFING:

MR. SPEAKES: WE'RE RELEASING THE TEXT THIS MORNING OF THE PRESIDNT'S MEETING WITH AFGHAN RESISTANCE LEADERS. THE PRESIDENT MET WITH THE LEADERS FOR ABOUT 35 MINUTES THIS MORNING. IN THE MEETING THE PRESIDENT -- AND THESE ARE QUOTES -- TOLD THE LEADERS OF THE AFGHAN RESISTANCE, "OUR GOALS ARE IDENTICAL: THE FREEDOM OF AFGHANISTAN." PUT A COLON IN THERE AFTER "IDENTICAL."

HE SAID, "THE SOVIETS MUST NOT BELIEVE THAT AGGRESSION PAYS." AND HE SAID THAT, "A PEACE AGREEMENT CANNOT WORK UNLESS THE ALLIANCE IS CONSULTED AND THE AFGHAN PEOPLE SUPPORT IT." THE PRESIDENT ALSO STATED THAT, "ANY SETTLEMENT MUST PROVIDE NOT ONLY FOR SOVIET WITHDRAWAL, BUT FOR THE PEOPLE OF AFGHANISTAN TO DETERMINE THE FORM OF GOVERNMENT THEY WANT. "

THE AFGHAN LEADER, RABBANI --

MR. DJEREJIAN: RABBANI.

MR. SPEAKES: RABBANI.

Q. WHAT'S HIS FIRST NAME?

MR. SPEAKES: HIS FIRST NAME IS BURHANUDDIN. (LAUGHTER.)

Q. THAT'S PRETTY GOOD.

MR. SPEAKES: -- SAID THAT -- HE DESCRIBED WHAT HE CALLED "THE SAD STORY OF OUR PEOPLE." HE SAID THAT THE --

Q. BRING BACK DAN RATHER. (LAUGHTER.)

MR. SPEAKES: -- "THE PEOPLE OF AFGHANISTAN DEEPLY SUPPORT THE ASSISTANCE OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE --ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORT OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE." HE DESCRIBED WHAT HE CALLED "SOVIET CASUALTIES AND ATROCITIES" AND SAID, "THE SOVIETS HAVE TURNED OUR COUNTRY INTO A BLOODBATH, BUT THEY WILL NEVER BE ABLE TO BREAK THE WILL OF OUR OWN PEOPLE." HE SAID, "THE SOVIETS HAVE THE POWER TO BURN AND KILL OUR ENTIRE NATION, BUT THEY WILL NEVER BE ABLE TO BEND OUR PEOPLE'S WILL."

THE QUESTION CAME UP, I THINK, EARLIER -- MAYBE IT WAS IN THE PAPER THIS MORNING - ABOUT THE NEED FOR ADDITIONAL ARMAMENTS ON THE PART OF THE RESISTANCE. HE SAID THAT THEY HAVE NO EFFECTIVE WEAPONS -- OR NEED EFFECTIVE WEAPONS FOR AIR AND GROUND DEFENSE, DESCRIBING THAT THE SOVIETS HAVE BURNED VILLAGES. AND HE SAID, "THEY LEAVE AROUND BOMBS DISGUISED AS TOYS," WHICH YOU HAVE HEARD ABOUT BEFORE. HE DESCRIBED MANY OF THE VISTIMS OF THE --"VICTIMS AND MARTYRS," HE CALLED THEM -- OF SOVIET ATTACKS, TALKED OF KIDNAPPING CHILDREN AND OF MANY OF THE BURN VICTIMS OF SOVIET ATTACKS THAT HAD TO BE SENT OUTSIDE THE COUNTRY.

THE PRESIDENT -- IN CONCLUDING, THE LEADER INDICATED TO THE PRESIDENT THAT "SORROWFUL AS IT IS" -- TALKING ABOUT THE SITUATION -- "THE RESISTANCE OF CUR PEOPLE HAS NOT BEEN RECOGNIZED OFFICIALLY." AND AT THE END, HE INDICATED THAT HE WOULD LIKE TO HAVE OFFICIAL DIPLOMATIC RECOGNITION OF THE RESISTANCE EFFORT.

THE PRESIDENT, IN REPLYING TO THAT -- AND I'LL COME BACK TO THE ARMAMENT ISUE -- IS THAT HE INDICATED THAT RECOGNITION WAS AN IMPORTANT ISSUE AND INDICATED THAT WE WILL KEEP DISCUSSING IT, BUT IT IS PREMATURE TO RESOLVE

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ON THE QUESTION OF ARMAMENTS --

Q. WHY IS IT PREMATURE? I MEAN, THEY'VE BEEN FIGHTING FOR --

MR. SPEAKES: THAT'S TRUE, BUT --

Q. -- FIVE YEARS.

MR. SPEAKES: -- WE HAVE SPECIFIC REASONS ON THAT ISSUE. WE DO HAVE REPRESENTATION IN KABUL, AND WE THINK THAT PLAYS A ROLE IN OUR EFFORTS TO BE HELPFUL TO THE RESISTANCE AND OUR EFFORTS TO CONTINUE WORKING WITH THE AFGHAN PEOPLE TO OVERCOME THE SOVIET AGGRESSION.

Q. WAS HE SAYING HE WANTED TO SET UP A GOVERNMENT IN EXILE?

MR. SPEAKES: HE INDICATED -- I DON'T KNOW WHETHER HE WANTS TO SET UP A GOVERNMENT IN EXILE, BUT HE DOES WANT RECOGNITION, DIPLOMATIC RECOGNITION OF THE PEOPLES OF THE RESISTANCE.

Q. SO WE WOULD HAVE TO WITHDRAW OUR RECOGNITION OF --

MR. SPEAKES: OF ONE AND NOT -- THE OTHER -- AND RECOGNIZE THE OTHER. ON THE QUESTION OF ARMAMENTS, THE UNITED STATES HAS ALWAYS PLEDGED TO SUPPORT THE EFFORTS OF THE FREEDOM FIGHTERS IN AFGHANISTAN. I WILL NOT BE MORE SPECIFIC ON ANYTHING ELSE REGARDING SUPPORT, AS IS OUR CUSTOM IN DEALING WITH THAT ISSUE.

Q. WHAT LEADER WAS THIS? I MEAN, WAS HE -- WERE THERE

MR. SPEAKES: YES -- NO. THEY WERE ALL AN UMBRELLA LEADERSHIP GROUP. THAT GROUP IS KNOWN AS THE -- CALLED THE ALLIANCE -- ITS FULL NAME IS THE ISLAMIC UNION OF MUJAHIDIN OF AFGHANISTAN. THEY HAVE A -- THEIR SPOKESMAN FOR THE GROUP ROTATES ON A REGULAR BASIS. IT IS CURRENTLY LEAD BY PROFESSOR RABBINI -- RABBINI. FIRST NAME IS SPELLED, IF YOU NEED IT, B-U-R-H-A-N-U-D-D-I-N.

Q. AND THAT'S R-A-B-B-I-N-I?

MR. SPEAKES: YES. SEVERAL OF HIS COLLEAGUES THAT
REPRESENT DIFFERENT POLITICAL PARTIES WITHIN THE ISLAMIC
-- WITHIN THE AFGHAN RESISTANCE WERE PRESENT. I HAVE
THEIR NAMES IF YOU NEED THEM. THEY ALL SPOKE -- THEY
VIRTUALLY ECHOED WHAT RABBINI HAS SAID.

JOHN?

Q. LARRY, DID ANY OF THESE AFGHAN LEADERS TALK ABOUT THE NEED FOR EFFECTIVE AIR DEFENSE WEAPONS SPECIFICALLY MAKE A REQUEST FOR STINGERS?

MR. SPEAKES: NO.

JIM?

Q. YOU TALK ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF REPRESENTATION IN

KABUL. IS THAT RELATED TO THE EFFORT TO FASHION SOME SORT OF WITHDRAWAL OF SOVIET TROOPS? OR IS THERE SOME OTHER --

MR. SPEAKES: WELL, I THINK IT'S RELATED TO THE OVERALL EFFORT BY THE UNITED STATES TO COME UP WITH A

SATISFACTORY SOLUTION TO THE PROBLEM.

STEVE?

Q. WITHOUT BEING SPECIFIC ABOUT THE NATURE OF OUR SUPPORT TO THEM WITH REGARD TO ARMAMENTS, HAS ANYTHING CHANGED OR IS THERE CONTEMPLATION OF ANY CHANGES AS A RESULT OF THIS MEETING WITH REGARD TO SUPPORT?

MR. SPEAKES: STEVE, I GUESS I WOULD JUST HAVE TO SAY THAT WE WOULD TAKE THE VIEWS OF THE RESISTANCE LEADERS UNDER CONSIDERATION AS WE CONTINUE TO WORK FOR A RESOLUTION OF THE PROBLEM AND LEAVE IT AS FOGGED UP AS THAT.

DAVID?

Q. I'M STILL NOT CLEAR. WE HAVE AN EMBASSY IN MANAGUA AND WE ALSO SUPPORT THE FREEDOM FIGHTERS IN NICARAGUA. WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE -- WHY CAN WE NOT HAVE -- HAVE AN EMBASSY IN KABUL AND ALSO EXTEND SOME KIND OF --

MR. SPEAKES: WE SUPPORT THEM, BUT I -- WE'RE TALKING ABOUT OFFICIAL DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS, I GUESS, DAVID, AND THAT WOULD MEAN A WITHDRAWAL OF ONE AND --

Q. -- TROOPS.

MR. SPEAKES: YES.

Q. HAVE THE CONTRAS EVER ASKED FOR DIPLOMATIC RECOGNITION IN THE SAME FASHION?

MR. SPEAKES: I DON'T THINK SO.

CHARLES?

Q. YES, JOHN'S QUESTION WAS JUST ABOUT THE STINGERS. BUT WAS THERE A GENERAL REQUEST FOR WEAPONS?

MR. SPEAKES: THEY'VE MADE US AWARE OF THEIR NEEDS, IS BASICALLY IT. THE QUOTE WAS WHAT I GAVE YOU -- THT WE NEED EFFECTIVE GROUND AND AIR DEFENSE WEAPONS -- WAS WHAT HE SAID.

MIKE?

Q. DID THEY GET INTO SPECIFICS ABOUT WHAT KINDS THEY NEEDED WITHOUT SPECIFICALLY ASKING FOR THEM?

MR. SPEAKES: NO.

Q. I BELIEVE RABBINI SPEAKS ENGLISH, BUT NONE OF THE OTHERS DO. WAS ANY OF THIS CONVERSATION IN ENGLISH, OR WAS IT ALL --

MR. SPEAKES: NO, RABBINI DID NOT SPEAK ENGLISH. I DON'T KNOW WHAT THE STATUS OF HIS ENGLISH IS, BUT HE DID NOT --GAILANI DID -- G-A-I-L-A-N-I -- AHMAD GAILANI DID SPEAK ENGLISH, I BELIEVE -- HOPEFULLY. LET ME BE SURE I'VE GOT THE RIGHT -- I'M NOT SURE THAT WAS THAT FELLOW'S NAME.

Q. YOU SAID THE SOVIET CASUALTIES --

Q. ALL THE OTHERS SPOKE THROUGH AN INTERPRETER?

MR. SPEAKES: YES.

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MR. SPEAKES: NO, DID NOT DISCUSS NUMBERS.

SUBJECT: USG ROUND TABLE DISCUSSIONS WITH THE AFGHAN

RESISTANCE ALLIANCE

1. (C) - ENTIRE TEXT.

- 2. . THIS IS THE FIRST OF THREE MESSAGES REPORTING ON THREE HOURS OF ROUND TABLE DISCUSSIONS MODERATED BY NEA/DAS PECK BETWEEN THE AFGHAN RESISTANCE ALLIANCE DELEGATION AND MEMBERS OF VARIOUS USG ORGANIZATIONS. THIS MESSAGE WILL COVER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS AND THE AFGHAN MEDIA PROJECT. USG PARTICIPANTS INCLUDED: GERALD HELMAN (P); CHARLES DUNBAR (NEA); ZALMAY KHALILZAD (S/P); WALT RAYMOND, STEVE SESTANOVICH AND VINCE CANNISTRARO (NSC STAFF); CHARLES GREENLEAF (ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR. AID): JIM PURCELL (AID), ROBERT PELLETREAU (OSD/ISA/DAS); ROBERT WOLTHUIS (DOD/DIRECTOR HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE); SAUL GEFTER (USIA MEDIA PROJECT); AND DESIREE MILLIKAN
- 3. DAS PECK OPENED THE MEETING BY PROVIDING A BRIEF . HISTORY OF OUR HUMANITARIAN AID PROGRAM TO THE AFGHANS. HE NOTED THAT, WHEREAS AT THE BEGINNING OF THE WAR THE WORLD HAD

FOCUSSED ITS ATTENTION EXCLUSIVELY ON PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO THE MILLIONS OF AFGHAN REFUGEES, IT HAD BECOME INCREASINGLY CLEAR THAT ASSISTANCE TO THOSE REMAINING INSIDE AFGHANISTAN WAS ALSO NEEDED. BESIDES MEETING THE OVERWHELMING HUMANITARIAN NEEDS OF THE AFGHAN POPULATION, OUR CROSS BORDER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM HAD TWO ADDITIONAL GOALS: (A) TO STEM THE OUTFLUX OF REFUGEES BY PROVIDING ASSISTANCE WHICH WOULD ENABLE! THE POPULACE TO SUSTAIN ITSELF WITHIN THE COUNTRY WHERE IT PROVIDED LOGISTICAL SUPPORT TO THE MUJAHIDIN AND (B) TO BUILD WITHIN THE COUNTRY FREE AFGHAN INSTITUTIONS WHICH COULD

SERVE AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO THE KABUL REGIME. THE PROGRAM HAD BEGUN 1 1/2 YEARS AGO WITH DOLS 2 MILLION; ANOTHER DOLS 6 MILLION HAD BEEN MADE AVAILABLE IN FY 85 THROUGH THE REPROGRAMMING OF FUNDS; THE CURRENT PROGRAM WAS OPERATING WITH A BUDGET OF DOLS 15 MILLION.

- 4. ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR GREENLEAF BRIEFLY OUTLINED THE 3 ELEMENTS OF OUR CBA PROGRAM: MEDICAL, EDUCATIONAL AND COMMODITY SUPPORT. THE FOCUS OF OUR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE WAS ON PARA-MEDIC TRAINING AND THE EXTABLISHMENT OF CLINICS INSIDE AFGHANISTAN; EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE FOCUSSED PRIMARILY ON THE PRINTING OF TEXTBOOKS AND TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR PRIMARY EDUCATION; COMMODITY SUPPORT WAS INTENDED TO PROVIDE THE POPULACE WITH COMMODITIES WHICH WOULD ENABLE THEM TO REMAIN INSIDE THE COUNTRY, E.G. AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS, FERTILIZER AND SEEDS, CLOTHING, HOUSING SUPPLIES ETC. GREENLEAF NOTED DESIGN WORK ON THESE 3 PROGRAMS WAS NEAR COMPLETION AND HE HOPED FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMS WOULD PROGRESS RAPIDLY. GREENLEAF STRESSED THAT IT WAS IMPORTANT TO HAVE A CENTRAL LIAISON ORGANIZATION SUCH AS THE ALLIANCE MEDICAL COMMITTEE WITH WHOM THE AID OFFICE IN PAKISTAN COULD WORK TO IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAMS EFFECTIVELY AND EFFICIENTLY. HE ASKED THE ALLIANCE FOR THEIR VIEWS ON THE CBA PROGRAM.
  - 5. ALLIANCE SPOKESMAN RABBANI SAID THAT ALLIANCE HEALTH AND EDUCATION COMMITTEES, WHICH INCLUDED REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL SEVEN GROUPS, HAD MET WIH AID DESIGN TEAMS. VARIOUS DECISIONS HAD BEEN TAKEN, NOTABLY THE FOLLOWING:
  - A. TRAINING OF MEDICAL PERSONNEL WAS VITAL, BUT THREE

MONTHS WAS TOO SHORT A TRAINING PERIOD. TRAINING SHOULD CONSIST OF MINIMUM 6-12 MONTHS.

- B. SELECTION OF TRAINEES SHOULD BE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE ALLIANCE. GAILANI INTERJECTED THAT THIS WAS ESSENTIAL TO PREVENT "PROBLEMS ON THE FRONT."
- C. TRAINEES SHOULD RECEIVE MONTHLY WAGES AND BE GIVEN THE NECESSARY EQUIPMENT AND MEDICATION TO FULFILL THEIR TASKS. PERIODIC REPORTS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO THE ALLIANCE OFFICE ON THEIR PERFORMANCE AND EFFECTIVENESS IN THE FIELD.
- D. INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION WERE NEEDED IN QUETTA AND PESHAWAR. GAILANI ADDED THAT AFGHAN MEDICAL STUDENTS WHO HAD NOT BEEN ABLE TO COMPLETE THEIR MEDICAL TRAINING IN KABUL BECAUSE OF THE WAR SHOULD BE GIVEN ADDITIONAL MEDICAL TRAINING. AFTER PROVING THEIR WORTH AT THE FRONT FOR TWO YEARS THEY COULD THEN BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO CONTINUE THEIR EDUCATION IN US AND EUROPEAN INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING.
- E. TRANSPORT OF WOUNDED FROM THE BORDER AREAS TO HOSPITALS IN PAKISTAN WAS ANOTHER VITAL CONCERN. SELECTION OF PERSONNEL AND STAGING AREAS FOR THIS PURPOSE HAD BEEN DISCUSSED. MORE AMBULANCES WERE NEEDED (WHEREUPON WOLTHUIS REPORTED THAT SEVEN ADDITIONAL ONES HAD BEEN DELIVERED THAT DAY).
- F. MOJADEDDI ADDED THAT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CLINICS ALONG THE BORDER AS WELL AS DEEP INSIDE AFGHANISTAN WAS ALSO IMPORTANT TO MINIMIZE UNNECESSARY DEATHS. MOJADEDDI SUGGESTED THAT THERE WERE MANY AFGHAN DOCTORS AND SURGEONS IN THE WEST WHO WOULD BE WILLING TO RETURN TO WORK IN PAKISTAN OR EVEN INSIDE AFGHANISTAN IF MONEY WERE

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AVAILABLE TO PAY THEIR SALARIES. HE SAID THE RESISTANCE PLANNED TO MAKE AN APPEAL FOR AFGHAN DOCTORS TO RETURN, BUT DID NOT ELABORATE ON THIS PROPOSED INITIATIVE.

6. AFGHAN MEDIA PROJECT: DAS PECK NOTED THAT ANOTHER ELEMENT OF OUR AFGHAN STRATEGY WAS TO IMPROVE THE RESISTANCE'S CAPABILITY TO TELL THEIR STORY TO THE WORLD. THERE WAS A DELIBERATE SOVIET POLICY TO INTIMIDATE AND TARGET FOREIGN JOURNALISTS WHO ENTERED AFGHANISTAN TO COVER THE WAR. MOREOVER SUCH JOURNALISTS COULD NOT HOPE TO APPROXIMATE AFGHANS' INSIGHT AND KNOWLEDGE OF THE COUNTRY. IT WAS THEREFORE ESSENTIAL TO DEVELOP THE TECHNICAL AND INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK WHICH

WOULD PERMIT AFGHANS TO PROJECT THEIR STRUGGLE MORE EFFECTIVELY IN THE INTERNATIONAL MEDIA. THE US CONGRESS HAD APPROPRIATED FUNDS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN INDEPENDENT AFGHAN MEDIA SERVICE.

7. SAUL GEFTER ADDED THAT USIA WAS COMMITTED TO THIS

PROGRAM AND WAS READY TO BEGIN WORK IMMEDIATELY. HOWEVER, GOP FINAL APPROVAL WAS STILL PENDING. TWO US ORGANIZATIONS WITH WIDESPREAD EXPERIENCE IN COMMUNICATIONS AND JOURNALISM HAD BEEN SELECTED TO HELP IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM: BOSTON UNIVERSITY AND THE HEARST CORPORATION. GEFTER STRESSED THAT THE PROGRAM REQUIRED THE FULL COOPERATION OF THE ALLIANCE, INCLUDING NOMINEES FOR APPROPRIATE TRAINING.

- 8. RABBANI COMMENTED THAT THIS WAS INDEED A USEFUL STEP. HE EMPHASIZED THAT THE PROGRAM SHOULD BE RUN UNDER THE CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE ALLIANCE WHICH COULD PUT NEWS OF THE WAR AT THE DISPOSAL OF THE TRAINEES. HE AGREED THAT AFGHAN JOURNALISTS WOULD BE MORE EFFECTIVE THAN FOREIGN JOURNALISTS BECAUSE THEY WERE USED TO AND UNAFRAID OF THE WAR AND WERE FAMILIAR WITH THE COUNTRYSIDE.
- 9. WITH SOME DISMAY, RABBANI NOTED THAT HE KEPT SEEING THE WORD "REBEL" IN THE US MEDIA. HE RHETORICALLY ASKED HOW THE AFGHANS COULD HOPE TO EDUCATE THE WORLD ABOUT THE WAR, IF THEY HAD BEEN UNABLE IN SIX YEARS TO MAKE THE US UNDERSTAND THAT THEY WEREN'T REBELS. DAS PECK ASSURED THE DELEGATION THAT THEY WOULD NEVER SEE A USG SOURCE USE THAT WORD, BUT THAT THE US MEDIA WAS INDEPENDENT AND ESSENTIALLY DID AND SAID AS THEY WISHED. HE PLEDGED WE WOULD CONTINUE OUR EFFORTS TO EDUCATE THEM ON THIS POINT.
- 1B. PVO ROLE IN CBA: WALT RAYMOND ASKED THE ALLIANCE FOR THEIR VIEWS ABOUT THE PVO ROLE IN ADMINISTERING CBA. RAYMOND NOTED THAT FROM OUR PERSPECTIVE, PVO INVOLVEMENT WAS BENEFICIAL BECAUSE A) IT HELPED SPREAD NEWS ABOUT THE AFGHAN STRUGGLE TO WESTERN EUROPEAN COUNTRIES AND B) A NUMBER OF THE ORGANIZATIONS HAD PROVIDED MEANINGFUL ASSISTANCE FROM THE VERY BEGINNING OF THE WAR.
- 11. RABBANI NOTED THAT ALTHOUGH SOME PVO'S SUCH AS THE

SWEDISH COMMITTEE WERE VERY USEFUL, OTHERS WERE NOT.
THERE WAS OFTEN LACK OF COORDINATION AHONG THE VARIOUS
PVO'S AND DISORGANIZATION WITHIN THE PVO ITSELF. THE
ASSISTANCE EFFORT NEEDED TO BE CENTRALIZED AND
CONTROLLED. (WE NOTED THATOTHIS WOULD REQUIRE THE SECTOR
COMMITTEES TO ACQUIRE THE WECESSARY ATTRIBUTES TO SERVE
IN A COORDINATING ROLE.) WIMDREOVER SOME PVO'S SUCH AS THE

AUSTRIAN COMMITTEE HAD MARXIST AFGHAN MEMBERS WHO WERE MORE INTERESTED IN ENGAGING IN POLITICAL ACTIVITIES AGAINST THE ALLIANCE AND THE RESISTANCE THAN IN PROVIDING HUMANITARIAN AID. MOJADEDI CONFIRMED THIS OBSERVATION, ADDING THAT PVO'S SHOULD TAKE ALLIANCE VIEWS INTO

ACCOUNT. DAS PECK NOTED THAT WE HAD URGED THOSE PVO'S TO WHOM WE PROVIDED AID TO DEAL CLOSELY WITH THE ALLIANGE.

- 12. MCCOLLUM AMENDMENT: THE MCCOLLUM AMENDMENT WAS DISCUSSED BRIEFLY. THE ALLIANCE NOTED THE PATIENT AIRLIFT PROGRAM WAS VERY HELPFUL AND URGED THAT IT BE EXPANDED. DAS PECK STRESSED THAT THE AMENDMENT PROVIDED FUNDS TO TRANSPORT WOUNDED, BUT THAT MEDICAL TREATMENT WAS ALL FREE AND DEPENDED ON VOLUNTEERS. REGARDING COMMODITIES SUPPLIED UNDER THE MCCOLLUM AMENDMENT, PECK URGED THE LEADERS TO CONSIDER CAREFULLY WHAT COMMODITIES THEY NEEDED AND TO COMMUNICATE THEIR SPECIFIC NEEDS TO BOB WOLTHUIS.
- 13. RABBANI ENUMERATED THE FOLLOWING NEEDS:

  A) TRANSPORTATION, PARTICULARLY FOUR WHEEL DRIVE
  VEHICLES. (NOTE: IN ALL HIS PRESENTATIONS, RABBANI
  STRESSED THE NEED FOR ALL FORMS OF TRANSPORT,
  PARTICULARLY MULES AND TRUCKS. TRANSPORT APPEARS TO BE A
  MAJOR RESISTANCE CONCERN.)

  B) EQUIPMENT TO DRILL WELLS AND REPAIR OR CONSTRUCT
- B) EQUIPMENT TO DRILL WELLS AND REPAIR OR CONSTRUCT IRRIGATION SYSTEMS.
- C) IMPLEMENTS TO FACILITATE HARVESTING OF CROPS. RABBANI STRESSED THAT MANUAL HARVESTING WAS SO SLOW THAT THE SOVIETS HAD TIME TO SPOT WORKERS IN THE PROCESS AND BOMB FIELDS BEFORE HARVEST WAS COMPLETE.
- 14. DAS PECK WRAPPED UP THE SESSION BY NOTING THAT IT WAS VITAL THAT OUR CBA PROGRAMS RESPOND TO THE NEEDS OF THE AFGHAN PEOPLE AND THE ALLIANCE. IT WAS EQUALLY IMPORTANT THAT THE ALLIANCE AND ITS SPECIALIZED COMMITTEES CONTINUE TO MATURE AND DEVELOP SO AS TO SERVE AS AN EFFECTIVE LINK IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CBA. SHULTZ

IN ADDITION TO EXPRESSING MUTUAL RESPECT AND ADMIRATION FOR THE COURAGE OF THE FREEDOM FIGHTERS AND THE SUPPORT OF THE U.S. CONGRESS AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, THE CONGRESSMAN AND PROFESSOR RABBANI DISCUSSED BRIEFLY THE NEEDS OF THE AFGHAN MUJAHIDEEN. PROFESSOR RABBANI STRESSED THAT A COMBINATION OF MILITARY AND ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE IS NEEDED. ON THE WEAPONS SIDE SURFACE-TO-AIR MISSILES, LONG-RANGE ARTILLERY, AND LIGHT WEAPONS SUITABLE FOR GUERRILLA WARFARE ARE ESSENTIAL. BUT ALSO ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE IS NEEDED, HE SAID. AT THE BEGINNING, THE MUJAHIDEEN COULD CALL ON THE CIVILIAN POPULATION FOR ASSISTANCE IN MEETING THEIR FOOD AND SHELTER EQUIREMENTS. NOW, HOWEVER, THE CIVILIAN POPULATION REMAINING IN AFGHANISTAN SEEKS OUT THE MUJAHIDEEM TO REQUEST FOOD, CLOTHING, MEDICAL HELP, ETC. MONEY SHOULD ALSO BE PROVIDED TO PAY FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF WEAPONRY INSIDE AFGHANISTAN.
- 4. PROFESSOR RABBANI ASLO MENTIONED THAT HE HAS BEGUN TO RECEIVE COMMUNICATIONS FROM COMMANDERS ASKING WHEN THE STINGERS WILL ARRIVE. THE CONGRESSMAN RESPONDED THAT HE WOULD LOOK INTO "HOW TO NEUTRALIZE AIR POWER" WHEN HE RETURNS TO WASHINGTON AND TRY TO GET AN ANSWER FROM DOD.

- 5. FOR RIYADH AND JEDDAH: WE RECOGNIZE IT MAY NOT BE EASY FOR YOU TO FIND RABBANI ON A FRIDAY BUT URGE YOU TO DO YOUR BEST. IT IS IMPORTANT FOR THE PUBLIC DIPLOMACY ASPECTS OF HIS VISIT THAT THE FOREGOING ANNOUNCEMENT BE MADE BEFORE OUR WEEKEND.
