

Threat to the US in the Wake of the Achille Lauro

We believe radical PLO elements are planning reprisals against the US to retaliate for seizure of the Achille Lauro hijackers. Earlier in the month PLO hardliners almost certainly pressed Yassir Arafat to approve reprisals against the US for its alleged complicity in the Israeli raid on PLO headquarters in Tunis. While Arafat probably resisted then, he may now feel compelled to yield to hardliner pressure to reverse his 1974 ban on international terrorism and attack both Israeli and US interests worldwide. The PLO leader seemed to echo the hardliner position in a press conference in Baghdad over the weekend when he stated that the Arab world would soon "witness extremely important events and developments directed against US interests in the region." Fatah has not attacked US interests since 1973, when the Black September Organization kidnapped and killed the US Ambassador and Deputy Chief of Mission in Khartoum.

Moreover, Palestinian leaders have grown increasingly frustrated with Washington for what they view as unquestioning support for Israel. The PLO may conclude that the only way to draw attention to its grievances with Israel and to demonstrate its viability as a national liberation movement is to stage more frequent and spectacular attacks, not only against Israel, but Israel's prime benefactor—the United States. Even if Arafat resists pressure to approve attacks against the US, PLO splinter groups will likely conduct freelance operations against the US.

Several threats have been made and some evidence of targeting uncovered:

- -- In Cyprus, the PLO reportedly has cased the Birds Nest Restaurant at Akrotiri Village, which is heavily frequented by American military personnel, for possible assassination targets.
- -- A PLO spokesman has stated that an American or Italian aircraft would be hijacked, or another American killed, to force the release of the Achille Lauro hijackers.
- On 11 October, a caller threatened to blow up the U.S. Consul General's office in Naples because the US had "captured four of our brothers."
- In an interview in Yugoslavia on 14 October, Abu Abbas, leader of the group which hijacked the Achille Lauro, claimed the US had committed an act of "state terrorism" in intercepting the Egyptian plane, thus giving Palestinians the right to use "any means available" to achieve liberation.

Other Middle Eastern terrorists will probably try to take advantage of the current atmosphere and attack US and Israeli interests for their own reasons:

--It is likely that Syrian-supported Palestinian radicals will carry out operations in their own name to enhance their position within the Palestinian movement. At the same time they will probably also carry out attacks in the name of the PLO in an effort to further discredit Arafat and the peace process.

--Radical Lebanese Shia and Iranian-backed terrorist groups may also plan operations. Islamic Jihad has already claimed it executed William Buckley in retaliation for alleged US complicity in the Tunis raid--although other evidence suggests he may have been executed earlier this summer.

--Libya may also attempt to exploit opportunities available to it.

ALibya, working in conjunction with radical PLO elements and dissident Tunisians, is planning an operation against the US The US ambassador or military attache as well as US commercial flights to the Middle East are considered possible targets. Libya reportedly wants to demonstrate Libyan willingness to defend the Arab cause, as well as to enhance its image in the eyes of other Arab countries.

Dear General Saulnier:

I want to alert you and the highest levels of the French Government urgently to an opportunity for meaningful, precise action against one of the worst of the terrorists who have caused our two countries so much pain in Lebanon. Given the great importance which the President attaches to this case, I urge that action be taken at once.

We have learned from very reliable sources in three different countries that the senior Hizballah terrorist leader Imad Mugniyah has recently arrived in France.from Lebanon; he apparently did so without the knowledge of the French Government. We do not know what he has in mind, how long he might stay, or where he might go next, but we have every reason to believe that he is presently staying in the Paris area. Therefore, he is accessible to law enforcement and judicial authorities of the civilized world.

This individual has previously been the subject of considerable exchange of information between our respective intelligence services, and ample evidence exists of his direct involvement in the deadly 1983 bombings of the US Embassy and the headquarters of the US and French contingents of the Multinational Forces in Beirut. In addition, he has been identified as either responsible for or directly involved in other serious criminal activities of a terrorist nature, including the murder in Beirut of two French military truce observers in January, 1985, the kidnapping of several US and French citizens who are still held hostage, and the hijacking of TWA flight 847.

As you have observed in the case of Abu Abbas, whose arrest and extradition my government has vigorously sought, the United States places the greatest importance upon lawful pursuit of terrorists known to be responsible for crimes against US citizens, crimes which are now punishable under US laws adopted by the last session of our Congress. As was the case of Abu Abbas, a US court has issued a warrant for the arrest of Mugniyah. The enormity of Mugniyah's criminal actions makes us determined to see that he is brought to

justice. Given his criminal activities against French citizens, I would expect your government shares our strong views.

Mugniyah's arrest and prosecution and a United States

warrant for his arrest, with an official request for his provisional arrest, with an official request for his detention pending extradition by the Government of France to the United States, are in the hands of Ambassador Rodgers and the legal attache of our Embassy in Paris. We are confident of our evidence. However, before officially either making a request, we wish to ensure that President

Mitterrand is informed of the matter and of the views of the US Government. Of course, if the Government of France were to choose informally to deport Mugniyah into our hands, we would accept him on that basis.

Time is of the essence, given the danger that Mugniyah might suddenly disappear before action could be taken against him. There is also the possibility that knowledge of his presence in France might leak in this country. Either of these possibilities would be most unfortunate, as I am sure you understand.

The preference of your government for quiet, bilateral cooperation in combatting terrorism has been made very clear to us at all levels. The case of Mugniyah is the perfect occasion to demonstrate such cooperation in practice. I urge you and your government to act urgently and decisively to bring him to justice or allow us to do so. Given our common interest in pursuing the fight against terrorism, I am sure you would agree that the highest authorities and public opinion in our two countries could not understand our failure to act.



We do not know what he has in mind, how long he might stay, or where he might go next, but we have every reason to believe that he is presently staying in the Paris area. Therefore, he is accessible to law enforcement and judicial authorities of the civilized world.

This individual has previously been the subject of considerable exchange of information between our respective intelligence services, and ample evidence exists of his direct involvement in the deadly 1983 bombings of the US Embassy and the headquarters of the US and French contingents of the Multinational Forces in Beirut. In addition, he has been identified as either responsible for or directly involved in other serious criminal activities of a terrorist nature, including the murder in Beirut of two French military truce observers in January, 1985, the kidnapping of several US and French citizens who are still held hostage, and the hijacking of TWA flight 847.

As you have observed in the case of Abu Abbas, whose arrest and extradition my government has vigorously sought, the United States places the greatest importance upon lawful pursuit of terrorists known to be responsible for crimes against US citizens, crimes which are now punishable under US laws adopted by the last session of our Congress. As was the case of Abu Abbas, a US court has issued a warrant for the arrest of Mugniyah. The enormity of Mugniyah's criminal actions makes us determined to see that he is brought to

justice. Given his criminal activities against French citizens, I would expect your government shares our strong views.

Both an official request to the Government of France for Mugniyah's arrest and prosecution and a United States warrant for his arrest, with an official request for his detention pending extradition by the Government of France to the United States, are in the hands of Ambassador Rodgers and the legal attache of our Embassy in Paris. We are confident of our evidence. However, before officially making a request, we wish to ensure that President Mitterrand is informed of the matter and of the views of the US Government. Of course, if the Government of France were to choose informally to deport Mugniyah into our hands, we would accept him on that basis.

Time is of the essence, given the danger that Mugniyah might suddenly disappear before action could be taken against him. There is also the possibility that knowledge of his presence in France might leak in this country. Either of these possibilities would be most unfortunate, as I am sure you understand.

The preference of your government for quiet, bilateral cooperation in combatting terrorism has been made very clear to us at all levels. The case of Mugniyah is the perfect occasion to demonstrate such cooperation in practice. I urge you and your government to act urgently and decisively to bring him to justice or allow us to do so. Given our common interest in pursuing the fight against terrorism, I am sure you would agree that the highest authorities and public opinion in our two countries could not understand our failure to act.

He soon established himself as an independent Hizballah paramilitary official, however, and began to attract a following of young radical Shia fighters. Despite his youth, Mughniyah by 1983 had become widely known in Beirut as a key Hizballah "security" official in the southern suburbs of the city, based in the Burj al-Barajinah area.

In December 1983, Mughniyah sent his brother-in-law and close associate Mustafa Badr-al-Din to Kuwait to participate as an explosives expert in the Da'wa car-bombings of the US and French Embassies. Mughniyah's terrorist activities since December 1983 have focused on securing the release of these prisoners.

PARIS — Two newspapers have accused the Socialist government of allowing a key Arab terrorist to leave France and return to his base in the Middle East despite an official U.S. request that he be detained for possible extradition to the United States.

France-Soir said President Francois Mitterrand was personally warned in a top-priority telex from President Reagan last November that Imad Mugniyah, an associate of the Abu Nidal suspected of having organized the 1963 combing of the U.S. Marines and French peratroop berracks in Beirut, was en route to Paris.

In a different version, Le Figaro said the telex was pent in December to the French Foreign Ministry with a request that Mr. Mugniyah be detained. Both papers said French counterintelligence quickly located the reputed leader of a Hezbollah "action group," but President Mitterrand's staff prevented an arrest for fear of derailing efforts to obtain the release of four Frenchmen kidnapped in Lebanon.

The Foreign Ministry denied both accounts.

2. PLEASE PASS THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE TO GENERAL SAULNIER FROM ADM POINDEXTER:

DEAR GENERAL SAULNIER:

BECAUSE OF MY HIGH REGARD AND RESPECT FOR YOU AND BECAUSE YOUR GOVERNMENT AND OURS HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR MEANINGFUL, PRECISE ACTION AGAINST ONE OF THE WORST OF THE TERRORISTS WHO HAVE CAUSED OUR TWO COUNTRIES SO MUCH PAIN IN

LEBANON.

WE HAVE RECENTLY LEARNED

THAT THE SENIOR HIZBALLAH TERRORIST LEADER,

IMAD MUGNIYAH, IS SECRETLY HIDING IN FRANCE FROM LEBANON. WE

SECRET

BELIEVE MUGNIYAH IS IN PARIS AT AN ADDRESS ASSOCIATED WITH ONE OR BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING TELEPHONE NUMBERS: "43 88 27 00" OR "43 47 33 27." WE HAVE CONFIRMED INFORMATION FROM OUR EMBASSY IN BEIRUT INDICATING THAT MUGNIYAH'S DEPUTY, KHUDR SALAMAH, HAS BEEN RELEASED BY THE SOVIET EMBASSY AND THAT MUGNIYAH NOW FEELS FREE TO RETURN TO BEIRUT. HE MAY BE PLANNING TO DO SO THIS WEEKEND AS REASONS FOR HIM TO REMAIN IN PARIS NO LONGER EXIST.

MUGNIYAH HAS BEEN DISCUSSED

IN THE PAST, AND AMPLE EVIDENCE EXISTS OF HIS DIRECT INVOLVEMENT IN THE DEADLY 1983 BOMBINGS OF THE U.S. EMBASSY AND THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE U.S. AND FRENCH CONTINGENTS OF THE MULTINATIONAL FORCES IN BEIRUT. IN ADDITION, HE HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS EITHER RESPONSIBLE FOR OR INDIRECTLY INVOLVED IN OTHER SERIOUS CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES OF A TERRORIST NATURE, INCLUDING THE MURDER IN BEIRUT OF TWO FRENCH MILITARY TRUCE OBSERVERS IN JANUARY 1985, THE KIDNAPPING OF SEVERAL U.S. AND FRENCH CITIZENS WHO ARE STILL HELD HOSTAGE, AND THE HIJACKING OF TWA FLIGHT 847.

AS YOU HAVE OBSERVED IN THE CASE OF ABU ABBAS, WHOSE ARREST AND EXTRADITION MY GOVERNMENT HAS VIGOROUSLY SOUGHT, THE UNITED STATES PLACES THE GREATEST IMPORTANCE UPON LAWFUL PURSUIT OF TERRORISTS KNOWN TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CRIMES AGAINST U.S. CITIZNES, CRIMES WHICH ARE NOW PUNISHABLE UNDER U.S. LAWS ADOPTED





BY THE LAST SESSION OF OUR CONGRESS. AS WAS THE CASE OF ABU
ABBAS, A U.S. COURT HAS ISSUED A WARRANT FOR THE ARREST OF
MUGNIYAH. THE ENORMITY OF MUGNIYAH'S CRIMINAL ACTIONS MAKES US
DETERMINED TO SEE THAT HE IS BROUGHT TO JUSTICE. GIVEN HIS
CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES AGAINST FRENCH CITIZENS, I HOPE THAT YOUR
GOVERNMENT SHARES OUR STRONG VIEWS.

BOTH AN OFFICIAL REQUEST TO THE GOVERNMENT OF FRANCE FOR MUGNIYAH'S ARREST AND PROSECUTION, AND AN OFFICIAL REQUEST FOR HIS PROVISIONAL ARREST PENDING EXTRADITION BY THE GOVERNMENT OF FRANCE TO THE UNITED STATES, WILL BE IN THE HANDS OF OUR EMBASSY IN PARIS. WE ARE CONFIDENT OF OUR EVIDENCE. HOWEVER, BEFORE OFFICIALLY MAKING EITHER REQUEST, WE WISH TO ENSURE THAT PRESIDENT MITTERRAND IS INFORMED OF THE MATTER AND OF THE VIEWS OF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT. OF COURSE, IF THE GOVERNMENT OF FRANCE WERE TO CHOOSE EITHER FORMALLY OR INFORMALLY TO DELIVER MUGNIYAH INTO OUR HANDS, WE WOULD ACCEPT HIM ON THAT BASIS.

TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE, GIVEN THE DANGER THAT MUGNIYAH MIGHT SUDDENLY DISAPPEAR BEFORE ACTION COULD BE TAKEN AGAINST HIM.

THERE IS ALSO THE POSSIBILITY THAT DESPITE OUR EFFORTS TO KEEP IT CONFIDENTIAL KNOWLEDGE OF HIS PRESENCE IN FRANCE MIGHT LEAK IN THIS COUNTRY. EITHER OF THESE POSSIBILITIES WOULD BE MOST UNFORTUNATE, AS I AM SURE YOU UNDERSTAND.
