

### MEMORANDUM FOR MR. ROBERT C. MCFARLANE THE WHITE HOUSE

Subject: Ceremony for Victims of Kuwait Airline Hijacking

Pursuant to earlier conversations with NSC staff, we have made tentative plans for two ceremonies involving the American victims of the Kuwaiti airline hijacking.

### Return of Bodies.

The bodies of the two murdered Agency for International Development employees are scheduled to arrive at Andrews Air Force Base at 0730, Wednesday, December 12. The Vice President has agreed to be at Andrews and make appropriate remarks. Undersecretary Armacost, AID Administrator McPherson, and AID Inspector General Herbert Beckington (the two murdered AID employees were members of the Inspector General's staff) will also be part of the official delegation. The families of the victims and other AID officials will also attend.

### Presidential Meeting With Survivors and Families of Deceased.

We have also discussed with NSC staff the possibility of arranging a meeting with the President for the families of the two deceased AID employees and the two American survivors and their families. We believe such a meeting is important to (a) express our outrage and concern with this barbaric act of terrorism, (b) make a suitable statement of our counter-terrorism programs, and (c) make an appropriate gesture of support and sympathy for the victims of the hijakcing and their families.

The two surviving Americans (Charles Kapar, an AID employee, and John Costa, a New York businessman) will arrive in Frankfurt, Germany tonight. Their departure for the United States will depend on a medical evaluation in Frankfurt. The family of one of the deceased AID employees lives in Virginial The family of the other deceased AID employees will return from Karachi, Pakistan (where the AID employees were stationed) on Thursday evening, December 13. The families of the two surviving Americans reside in the United States (Virginia and New York).

The earliest time that a meeting could be scheduled with all parties would be Friday, December 14.

### Iranian Media Treatment of Kuwait Airways Hijacking

An examination of Iranian media has yielded no direct evidence that Tehran conspired with or supported the hijackers of the Kuwaiti airliner on which two Americans died. The ambivalence of some aspects of Iran's public treatment of the episode, however, may have reflected sympathy for the hijackers or their goals. Attempts to project an image of responsibility in Tehran's handling of the affair often were at odds with a reluctance to condemn the hijackers and their methods or to denounce the hijackers' goals.

Iranian media treatment of the hijacking was characterized from the beginning by an effort to project an image of Iranian authorities acting responsibly and according to prevailing international standards. Soon after the plane landed in Tehran on 4 December, Tehran radio quoted a Foreign Ministry spokesman as stating that Iran was "strongly opposed to any form of hijacking and such inhuman acts are condemned by us." He added that Iran had allowed the plane to land only because it was running out of fuel. Statements over the next several days by the president, prime minister, foreign minister, and other spokesmen condemned air piracy "on the grounds that it endangers the lives of innocent people." No statements supporting the hijackers or their cause were monitored.

Iranian officials were consistently portrayed as acting with humanitarian concern to bring about a negotiated end to the crisis. According to an Islamic Republic News Agency (IRNA) report on 7 December, for example, the Iranian authorities "managed to convince the hijackers to extend their deadline after a great deal of persuasion." It went on: "The attempts of our country's authorities to pacify the hijackers and to restrain them from any further drastic steps continue." Freed passengers were often quoted expressing gratitude for Iran's actions.

Balancing this concern to be seen as rejecting the hijackers' methods and moving responsibly to defuse the situation was an evident reluctance to condemn the hijackers' cause and goals. While Iranian media expressed no support for the hijackers, they also avoided portraying them in a negative or unfavorable light. Iranian media referred to them consistently—as "the hijackers" with no identification of their nationality or affiliation, describing them only as Arabic speakers. No monitored accounts indicated what cause

the hijackers represented, and after the hijackers' demands to free the prisoners in Kuwait were made, Iranian media reports made no mention of why the prisoners were incarcerated or who they were. An Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesman on the 6th condemned the killing of one of the American diplomats, but monitored Iranian media carried no descriptions of how the executions were carried out and therefore conveyed no sense of the brutality of the actions.

As the crisis wore on, the media increasingly adopted a defensive tone in the face of world criticism of Iran's performance. The Iranians specifically expressed irritation with the Kuwaiti Government negotiators, upon whom they blamed the intransigence of the hijackers and the prolongation of the crisis. For example, according to IRNA on the 10th President Khamene'i complained that "if it were not for the negligence of Kuwaiti officials the Iranian Government could have ended the hijacking affair three days earlier." The Iranians took credit for the release of each group of passengers, citing their patience in negotiating a peaceful settlement.

Iranian officials scored U.S. statements, beginning with those of the State Department and President Reagan on 7 December, which criticized Iran for permitting the affair to drag on. Presidential adviser Mir Salim, for example, said in an IRNA interview on 9 December that "the coverage of the incident by the imperialist-dominated media" was meant to "cover up the tragedy of Bhopal, India, the responsibility for which rests directly on the United States."

In a speech broadcast by Tehran radio on the 11th, Iranian leader Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeyni called allegations of Iranian complicity in the hijacking "slander." He criticized Western complaints about Tehran's handling of the incident, saying: "If this hijacking had started in Iran and ended up somewhere else, and then was solved in this way... their propaganda would have said how well it was accomplished, how well it was carried out, and so on."

#### **Air France Incident**

Iran's public treatment of the Kuwait Airways incident bears a number of similarities to its handling of the hijacking of an Air France plane to Tehran on 1 August 1984, when the Iranian authorities allowed the airliner to land for "humanitarian reasons." As in the December crisis, Iranian media portrayed

Iranian officials as acting responsibly during the Air France hijacking and refrained from explicitly denouncing the hijackers.

The August incident came in the wake of a hijacking in June of an Iranian airliner to France, where the hijackers requested asylum. IRNA subsequently reported Foreign Ministry condemnation of the French failure to extradite the hijackers "in violation of international laws and regulations." The ministry spokesman concluded: "Such disregard can create the right to retaliatory action."

The August incident ended, according to Tehran radio, when the hijackers surrendered to the Iranian authorities after releasing the hostages and blowing up the plane's cockpit. IRNA thereafter reported a request by the hijackers for asylum, and on 3 August President Khamene'i condemned France and the Western powers as "the origin and source of the propagation of terrorism in the world." He added that France's "ignorant and stupid leaders gave asylum to the ugliest international terrorists."

France was again criticized in the wake of the Kuwait Airways hijacking. In a Friday prayer sermon on 14 December reported by Tehran radio, Majlis Speaker Hashemi-Rafsanjani complained about lenient treatment of hijackers of the Iranian aircraft to France: "If you want the aircraft hijack terrorists from us . . . then you, too, should hand over to us the fugitive aircraft hijack terrorists who are currently living in France."

There were threatening, if ambiguous, overtones in Rafsanjani's remarks. He told his audience: "Either there should be air security for all airlines—and we would join efforts in this—or there will be no security for airlines of those countries which are the subject of your hatred; there will be absolutely no security for you!" Rafsanjani added that Iran had "not yet deemed it necessary to join the fray," but he suggested a connection between Iran and unidentified terrorist organizations when he said that if necessary, "there are peoples in the world who would embark on such action," and Iran would be willing to "enter the arena." While he stated Iran's willingness to engage in "diplomatic talk," he served notice in the same breath that "if it becomes a matter of actions, then you should act correctly, as we too would act."

## IRAN: KUWAIT AIRLINES HIJACKING

Q: What can you tell us about the return of the American citizens and remains?

two murdered Americans departed Tehran for Frankfurt. The remains will be identified by U.S. military forensic specialists. After identification, tentative plans call for the bodies to be transported to Andrews AFB. I do not have an arrival time for you at this time.

-- Messrs. Kapar and Costa have been flown by a Kuwaiti aircraft to Kuwait where they are being picked up by a USAF aircraft and will be transported to Frankfurt, West Germany. I understand they should be leaving Kuwait just about now, 1200 noon, 12/11. A determination on their onward intinerary has not yet been made.

(NOTE TO BRIEFER: The Medevac crew cannot continue on to the U.S. directly. Therefore a determination will have to be made as to whether they will continue by commercial flight or stay in Frankfurt. Mr. Costa's family have requested that no information be given to the press as to his arrival in the U.S.)

Q: Do we have any opinion yet on the Iranian handling of the hijacking?

A: -- While we have not yet had a chance to fully debrief the survivors, many aspects of the Government of Iran's handling of this situation raise profound and disturbing questions. to which we are sealing assured.

American

murdered by the hijackers, more were tortured and many were brutalized for an extended period of time without any effective measures being taken by the Government of Iran. Granting selective media access, broadcasting statements and screams of tortured passengers, permitting photographers aboard the aircraft, clearly encouraged extreme behavior by the hijackers. The passengers, the families of the murdered passengers, and the world, deserve answers from the Government of Iran.

-- Previous actions by the Government of Iran have shown that it has the capability to act rapidly and effectively to end hijackings when it so wishes. On this occasion, when the lives of innocent American, Kuwaiti and other citizens were at stake, it did otherwise. Two U.S. government employees were murdered. We will probably never know what would have happened had the Iranian Government acted more firmly.

- Government of Iran has x very clear obligations. Under the Hague Convention for Suppression of Unlawful Seizure of Aircraft, to which Iran is a party, the Government of Iran has an obligation to submit the hijackers' case to prosecutorial authorities or to extradite them to another country for trial.
- -- Iran's failure to try or extradite several previous groups of hijackers is clear evidence that it has not met its obligations and reinforced the impression that it is sympathetic to international terrorism and a safehaven for hijackers.
- -- The American attitude and actions toward the Government of Iran in the aftermath of this tragedy will be conditioned by whether it meets its obligations and by our assessment of its role during this tragic incident. We have been and will continue to watch Iranian actions closely.





HOWEVER, HE ADDED, SINCE THE ORDEAL IS NOW IN ITS FIFTH DAY, IT IS OBVIOUS THAT THE PASSENGERS HAVE SUFFERED A GREAT DEAL. ALL THESE PROPAGANDA, HE STRESSED, AIMED AT TARRING THE IMAGE OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN, WHICH HAS NOT FALLEN SHORT OF ANY ACTION TO SOLVE THE ISSUE.

ON THE STATEMENT OF THE AMERICAN PRESIDENT WHO HAS SAID THAT IRAN WAS IN SYMPATHY WITH THE HIJACKERS, MIR-SALIN SAID THAT HE DID NOT CONSIDER IT WORTHY OF ANALYSIS AND ADDED IT SHOWED THAT THE U.S. PRESIDENT HAD BEEN PROVIDED WITH BIASED AND INCOMPLETE INFORMATION.

### NEA PRESS STATEMENT

December 6, 1984

The United States Government received information today,

December 6, that strongly suggests that two of its diplomats

have been murdered aboard the hijacked aircraft at Tehran

Airport. Citizens of other countries have suffered the same

fate. There is strong evidence that those responsible for the

hijacking have abused their captives in a fashion which amounts

to wanton torture. This evidence is available to the

Government of Iran, indeed much of it has appeared in

international media with Iranian Government approval.

Despite these facts, we know of no effective steps the Government of Iran has taken to secure the release of the captives aboard the aircraft and to stop the seriat m executions. The Government of Iran's continued delay in carrying out its international, humanitarian and religious obligations amounts to complicity in this ongoing tragedy. Previous actions by the Iranian Government have demonstrated that it has the capability to act firmly when it so wishes. On this occasion it sadly has chosen otherwise.

The United States Government strongly condemns the failure of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran to live up to its commitments under the Hague Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Seizure of Aircraft. This behavior reflects an

apparent indifference of the Government of Iran to its responsibilities under international law to ensure the safety of the aircraft, its crew and passengers. Aside from its solemn treaty commitment, the Government of Iran has a humanitarian and religious obligation to ensure the safety of individuals located on its territory. The United States has seen no evidence that either obligation has been met.

The United States Government calls upon the Government of Iran, even at this late date, to fulfill its obligations and take effective measures to protect those passengers remaining aboard the hijacked aircraft. We ask the international community to exert every effort toward achieving this same goal.



#### NEA PRESS GUIDANCE

#### KUWAIT AIRLINE HIJACKING DECEMBER 5, 1984

Q: There were news reports during the night that the hijacked Kuwaiti airliner had left Tehran for an unknown destination. Can you confirm this?

- A: As of 0900 EST, the hijacked Kuwaiti airliner was still on the ground in Tehran.
- Q: How many passengers have been released?
- A: We understand from both diplomatic and press reports that the hijackers have released approximately of persons, most of whom are women and children. Two of those released are American citizens. [Not for Release: The two are Pakistani-American dual nationals currently staying in the former Hilton Hotel in Tehran.] In addition, the hijackers reportedly permitted an injured airline security guard to be taken to a hospital. We have seen reports that a medical team has been given access to those passengers remaining on the plane, but we cannot confirm these.
- Q: How many U.S. citizens are involved?
- A: Several U.S. citizens were reportedly on this flight. We are still seeking confirmation of both numbers and identities.

Q: Who are they?

A: Privacy Act constraints prohibit us from identifying any U.S. citizens who may be involved.

Q: News agencies report that one person was killed by the hijackers. Can you confirm claims by the hijackers that he was an American?

A: One person was killed during the hijacking. Because his body was stripped of all identification. It has been impossible to determine his name or nationality.

Q: Some news reports state that the deceased was an American diplomat. Is this true?

CORROBORATIVE EVIDENCE.

A: We have seen this report, but have no information

[aggresting that this is true] [DOTE: WE ARE RECEIVING ADDITIONAL A INFORMATION.]

Q: Were there in fact any U.S. Government officials on board the hijacked plane?

A: I have no further information for you at this time.

EMPLOYEES THE WERE ON THE PLANE.]

(Note to briefer: Three AID officials assigned to the Regional Inspection Office in Karachi are on board the airplane. The three are: William Stanford, Charles Kaper, and Charles Hegna. This information is not to be released. A copy of a cable comparing descriptions of the person killed by the hijackers and the three AID officials is attached for your information.)

### KUWAIT AIRLINES HIJACKING

- Q: What can you tell us about the status of the hijacking Kuwaiti Airliner in Tehran?
- A: -- We have seen various press reports, some of which contain conflicting information.
  - -- A number of passengers released by the hijackers have been transported on an Iranian aircraft to Karachi. We believe at least two Americans, a mother and her daughter, are among those on the plane. Our Consulate in Karachi reports that the plane landed at 0900 EST, and that U.S. officials are in touch with the Americans who were released.
- Q: How many Americans are on board the plane and have they been harmed?
- A: -- At least six Americans were on board the plane. Two of them were released. There is a strong possibility that one of the remaining four was killed. We are attempting to intervene with the Iranians through our Swiss protecting power to secure the release of the remains and to facilitate identification.

Q: Can you now confirm that one of those killed was an American diplomat?

A: -- We still cannot confirm the identity of the deceased person, who may be an American. For this reason, we are asking the Swiss to claim the body from the Iranians so that positive identification can be made. In accordance with our policy, we will not release a name unless positive identification is made and the next of kin informed.

Q: What is being done to end this hijacking?

A: -- The Kuwaitis have sent a team to Tehran to attempt to work for the release of the remaining passengers. Several other countries have urged the Iranians to do whatever they can to end this tragic episode as soon as possible without additional injury to those aboard. Obviously, the United States is strongly opposed to the terrorism which is exemplified by the hijacking of this aircraft. We fully support the efforts of the government of Kuwait and other governments to secure the safe release of those remaining on the aircraft.

Q: How would you characterize the cooperation, attitude, and actions taken by the Iranian authorities to resolve the incident?

A: -- That judgment can best be made when we have full information on the incident. I'm just not going to speculate now.



IT WAS NOT CLEAR WHETHER THE DEAD MAN WAS A PASSENGER OR CREW MEMBER.

THE AIRCRAFT LANDED IN TEHRAN AFTER THE PILOT RADIOED THAT HE WAS RUNNING LOW ON FUEL. ACCORDING TO AIRLINE SOURCES AND LOCAL NEWS AGENCIES.

IT GAVE NO DETAILS OF WHAT HAPPENED IN THE INTERVENING INU HOURS, BUT SAID THE AIRBUS WAS ALLOWED TO FLY TO TEHRAN FOR HUMANITARIAN REASONS. IT WAS UNDER GUARD ON A SIDE RUNWAY AT MEHRABAD.

THERE WAS NO IMMEDIATE INFORMATION ON THE IDENTITIES OR MOTIVES OF THE HIJACKERS OR THE NATIONALITIES OF THE PASSENGERS.

BUT HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF WORKERS FROM PAKISTAN AND OTHER COUNTRIES IN THE INDIAN SUBCONTINENT WORK IN THE GULF, AND FLIGHTS BETWEEN THE TWO AREAS ARE USUALLY FULL.

KUNA SAID THERE WERE 150 PASSENGERS AND 11 CREW ABOARD THE AIRBUS, BUT THE KUWAITI EMBASSY SPOKESMAN IN TEHRAN GAVE THE TOTAL NUMBER AS 155 PASSENGERS AND CREW.

KUNA SAID KUWAITI PRIME MINISTER SHEIKH SAAD AL-ABDULLAH AL-SABAH HAD SENT A CABLE TO IRANIAN PRIME MINISTER MIR HOSSEIN HOUSAVI ASKING FOR HIS URGENT INTERVENTION TO SECURE THE RELEASE OF THE PLANE AND ITS PASSENGERS.
