

PRESS ATTACHE CALLED ON NEW DELHI RESIDENT EDITOR OF TIMES OF INDIA INDER MALHOTRA MARCH 9 CONCERNING A MOSCOW-DATELINED TASS ITEM BY PRESS TRUST OF INDIA (PTI) WHICH THE TIMES CARRIED MARCH 9 CHARGING THE U.S. WITH USING PAKISTANIS AS "HUMAN GUINEA PIGS" FOR BACTERIOLOGICAL WEAPONS EXPERIMENTS AT AN AMERICAN MEDICAL RESEARCH CENTER IN LAHORE. (FOR TEXT SEE REFTEL (A).

2. WE EXPRESSED STRONG SURPRISE AND DISAPPOINTMENT THAT A PAPER OF THE TIMES OF INDIA'S REPUTATION COULD BE USED FOR SUCH BLATANT SOVIET DISINFORMATION, POINTING OUT THAT THE ONLY OTHER DELHI PAPER TO CARRY THE ITEM WAS THE PRO-MOSCOW PATRIOT. THE MAJOR POINTS CONTAINED IN REFTEL (B) WERE EMPHASIZED TO MALHOTRA AND A FACT SHEET WAS LEFT WITH HIM.

3. MALHOTRA EXPRESSED CHAGRIN AND EMBARRASSMENT OVER THE MATTER. HE PRODUCED A COPY OF A LETTER FROM TIMES OF INDIA CHIEF EDITOR GIRILAL JAIN WRITTEN TO THE UNITED NEWS OF INDIA (UNI) UPBRAIDING THAT AGENCY FOR CARRYING AN EARLIER MOSCOW-DATELINED VERSION OF THE "KILLER MOSQUITOES" ALLEGATIONS. MALHOTRA SAID HE KILLED THAT EARLIER UNI VERSION BUT WHEN IT LATER REAPPEARED AS A PTI VERSION THE TIMES TOOK THE BAIT. MALHOTRA ADDED THAT HE WAS "SHOCKED" TO SEE IT ON THE FRONT PAGE, EXPRESSED A CLEARER UNDERSTANDING OF SOVIET DISINFORMATION TECHNIQUES AND OFFERED TO DO WHAT HE COULD TO PREVENT A

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
