

SUBJECT: Possible Current Active Measures

These are the slim pickings since last memo of Jan. 4.

- 1) Mexico Poland The newspaper Excelsior of Mexico City has printed stories asserting Solidarity has CIA ties and alleging that it was planning armed insurrection against Polish government. We are sending out circular telegram alerting posts to this effort to malign Solidarity. (Mexico 00091)
- 2) China A Japanese newspaper, Yomiuri Shamban, has story which says U.S. servicemen are stationed at base for electronic surveillance near Lop Nor in China. Moscow radio has replayed story with editorial comment. Department press guidance (not used) denied base and refused comment on intelligence matters. (State 1692; FBIS LD 04020)
- 3) Spain In late December there was organized harrassment of Sixth fleet sailors in Barcelona. Consulate reporting says the organized provocations are unprecedented and attributes them to anti-NATO leftists. (Barcelona 1132)
- 4) <u>Spain</u> Visit and lecture by Philip Agee in mid-December provokes several newspaper articles on CIA's activities in Central America. These appear in both communist-oriented and liberal papers. (Madrid 0054)
- 5) <u>Israel</u> Group called the Israeli Committee for Solidarity with El Salvador held demonstration (about 60-70 people) at U.S. Embassy in Tel Aviv on Jan. 7.
- 6) Turkey Tass story quoting Lebanese weekly Al-Sayad that Turkey is providing bases for Rapid Deployment Force is replayed in India. This is parallel to stories in Indian press and replayed by Tass that Pakistan is providing bases for the Force. (New Delhi 23850)
