SEQUENCE OF EVENTS In Performance At The White House Sunday, December 20, 1981

4:30 p.m. Guests begin to arrive the Diplomatic Reception Room. Coats are checked.

Guests are escorted by Social Aides up Grand Staircase to be seated in the East Room to await the performance.

- 4:45 p.m. Social Aides escort Miss Beverly Sills and the eight performers from their dressing rooms (see note below) up the elevator to the State Floor. They proceed to the East Room.
- 4:50 p.m. THE PRESIDENT AND MRS. REAGAN proceed from the elevator to the Blue Room for photograph in front of the Christmas tree.
- 4:58 p.m. THE PRESIDENT AND MRS. REAGAN proceed from the Blue Room and are announced into the East Room, and THE PRESIDENT escorts MRS. REAGAN directly to her microphone. The performance begins.
- 6:00 p.m. The performance terminates. THE PRESIDENT AND MRS. REAGAN go up on the platform to thank the performers and have a quick photograph, then lead Miss Beverly Sills and the eight performers to the Cross Hall to the doors in front of the Blue Room where there will be a White House photo opportunity.

THE PRESIDENT AND MRS. REAGAN and the performers then proceed to the State Dining Room and are joined by the guests in the East Room for an informal reception. The Color Rooms may also be used during the reception by the guests.

6:30 p.m. THE PRESIDENT AND MRS. REAGAN depart the State Floor via the elevator.

All guests depart the Residence.

Before the performance, the four men will utilize the men's mezzanine as their dressing room. Beverly Sills and four women will utilize the women's mezzanine as their dressing room.
