I. PURPOSE: To open a dialogue with Black church leaders and to motivate them to become active in exploring ways in which churches can work with this Administration.

II. BACKGROUND: During the campaign you received a measure of support from Black clergy. Black religious leaders have lately expressed concern regarding the short term dislocations caused by the difficult economic conditions. They have special interests in Black colleges, Head Start programs and housing for senior citizens, and represent millions of Black Americans. Many feel the Black Church leaders are the foundation in the Black community. Every civil rights organization must tap the resources of the Black churches for their membership.

After the luncheon, your guests will be briefed on PSI and food banks, the latter a special briefing by Susan Baker. The Vice President will close the briefing session.




