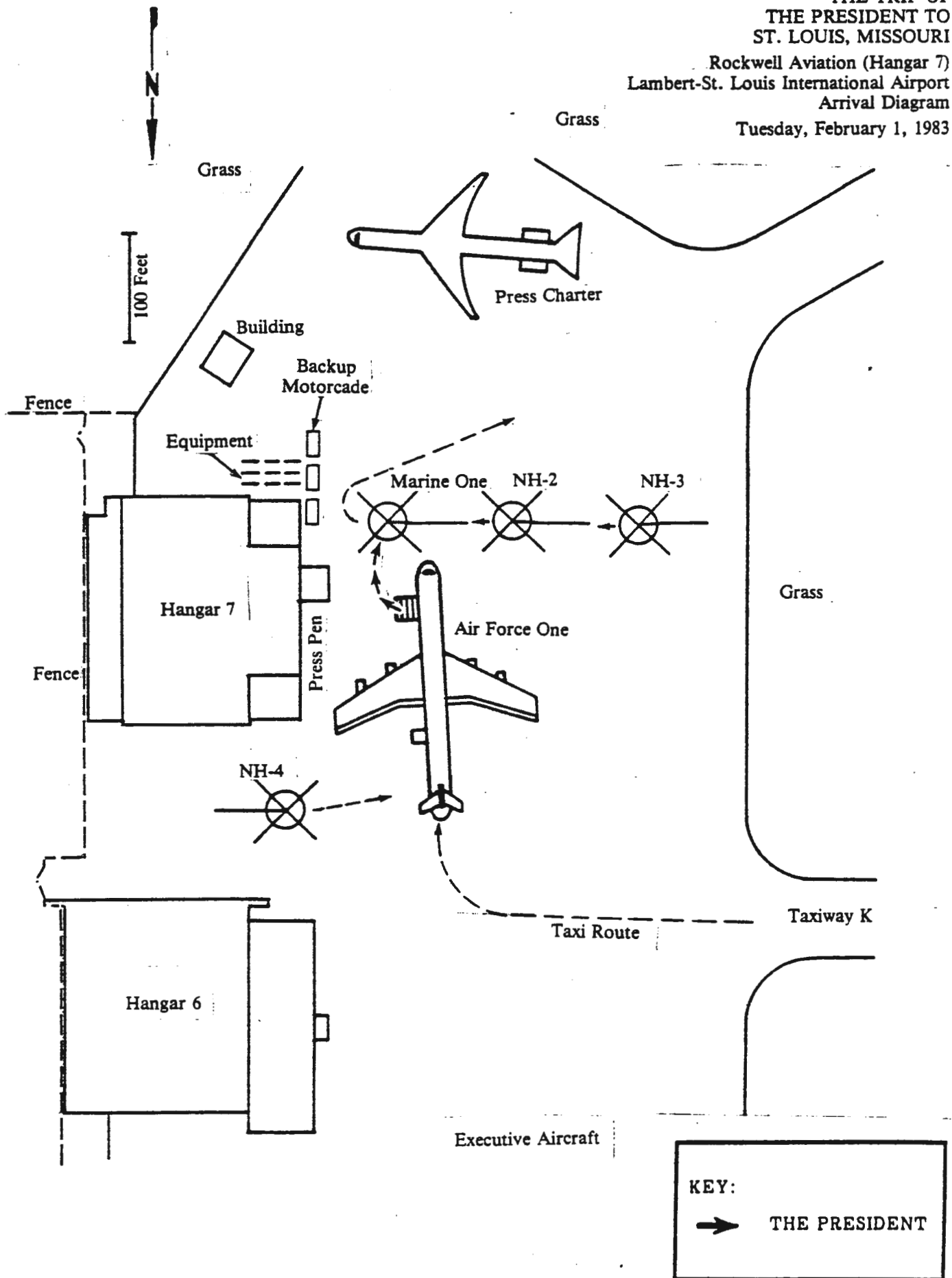

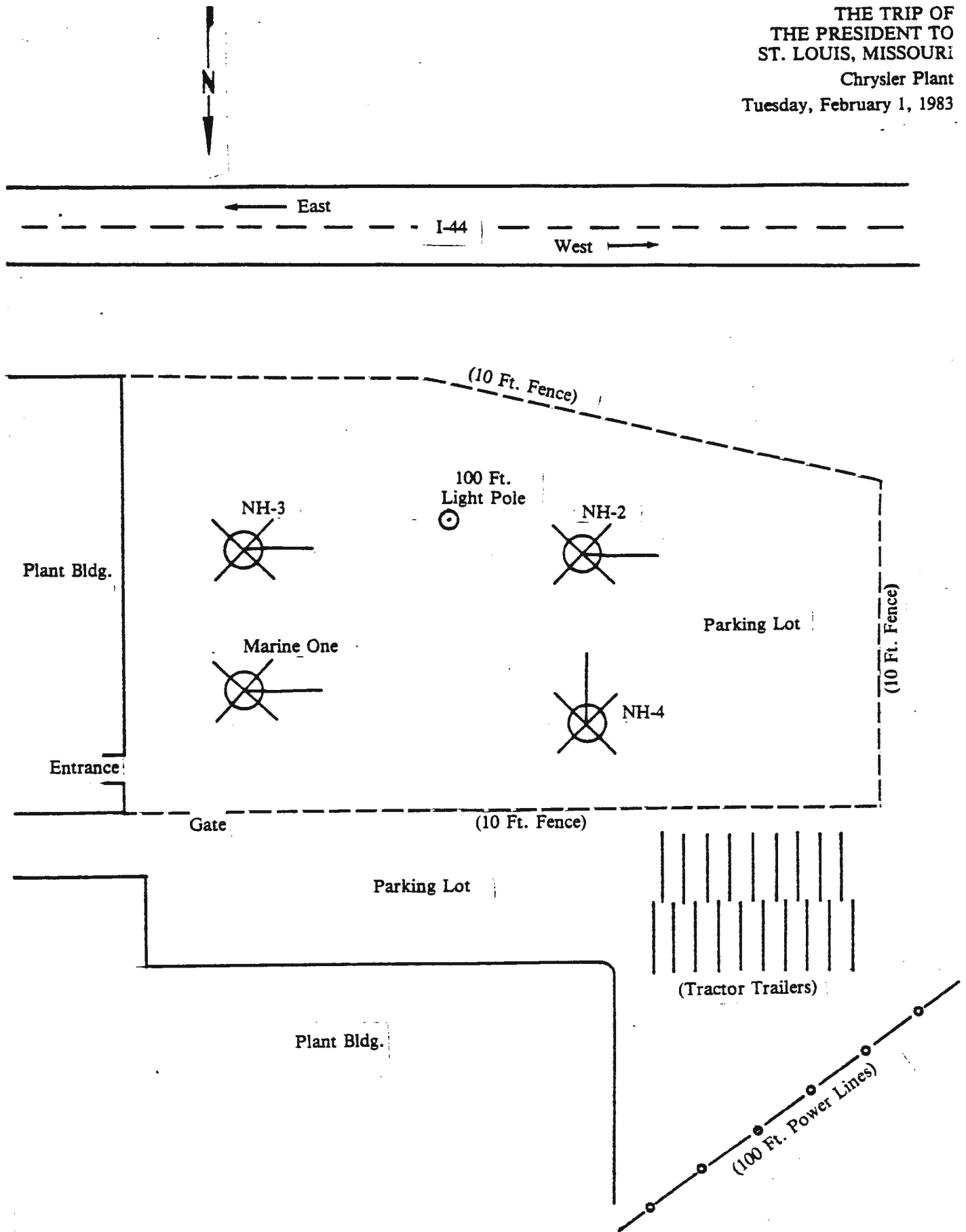

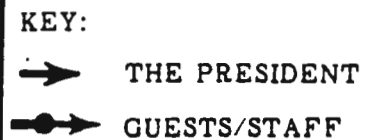
Chrysler Plant

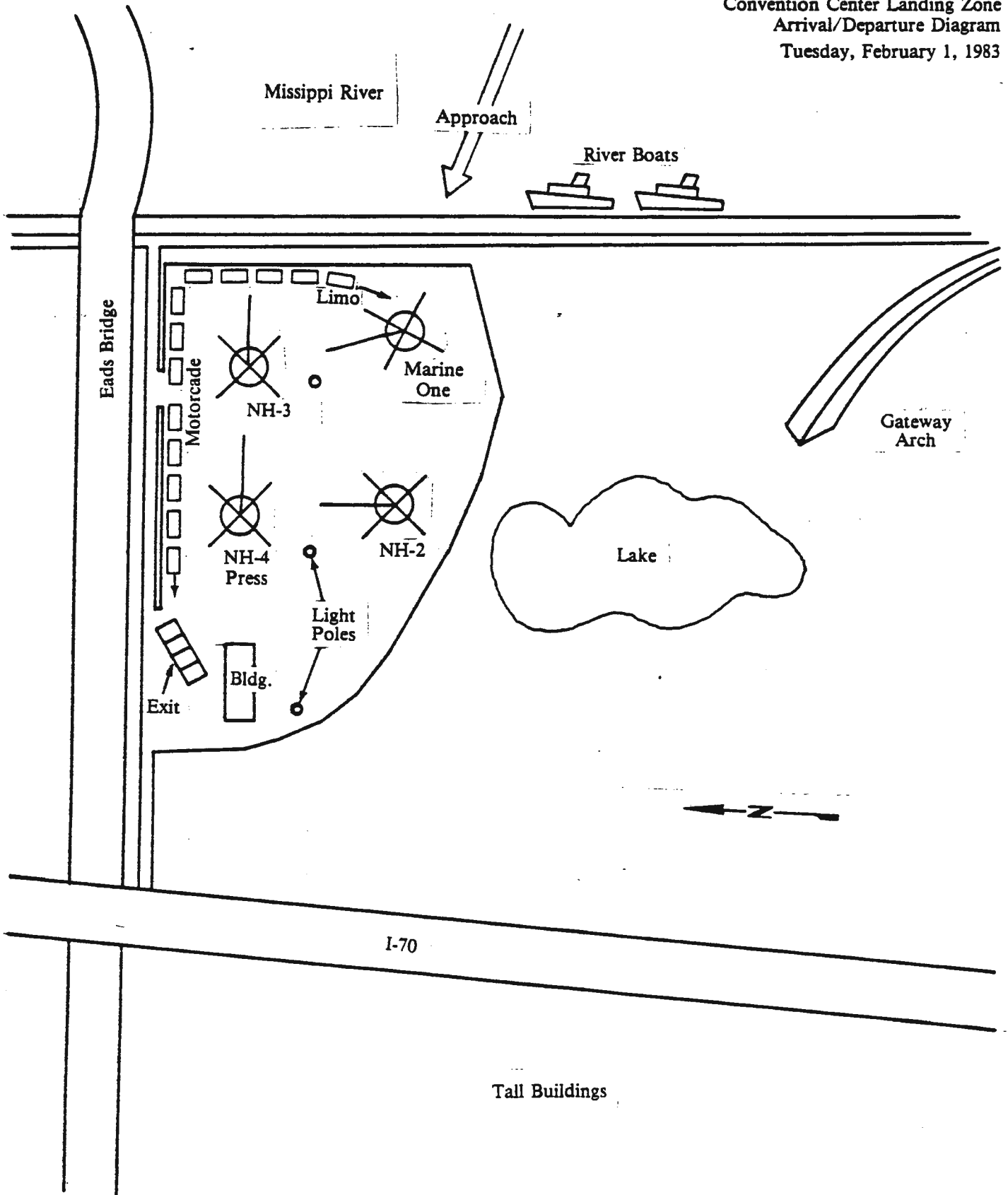

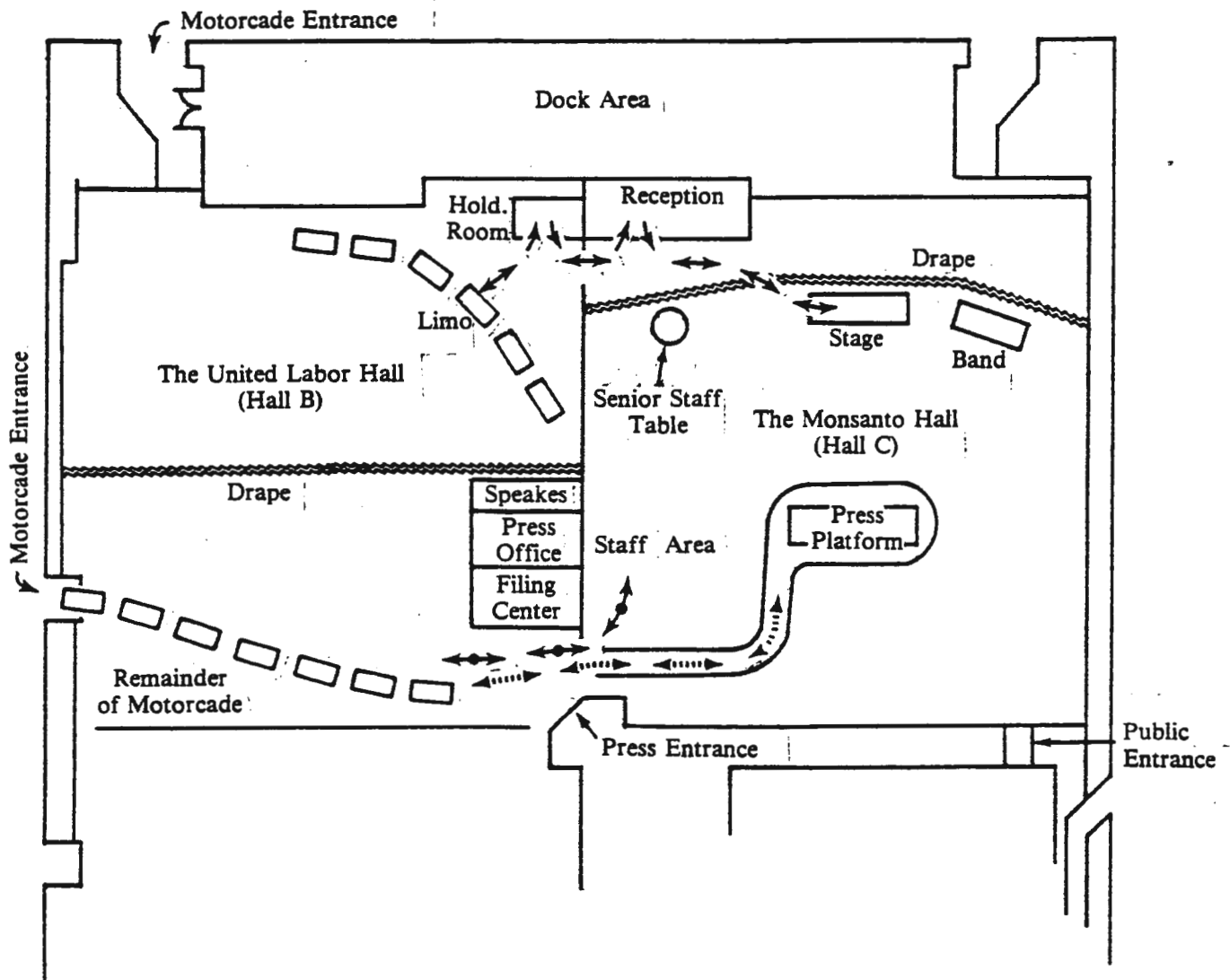
