SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

Dinner in Honor of the Governors
of the States and Territories
Sunday, February 27, 1983

7:10 p.m. Guests begin to arrive the SouthWest Gate, Diplomatic Reception Room, and are led up the Grand Staircase to the State Floor. They may proceed to the Color Rooms or to the East Room for cocktails. Guests will be announced into the East Room.

7:30 p.m. Social Aides will direct all guests into the East Room to prepare for the receiving line.

7:45 p.m. THE PRESIDENT proceeds to the State Floor via the elevator. He proceeds down the Cross Hall and is announced into the East Room. (Full Honors)

THE PRESIDENT steps just inside the Cross Hall entrance into the East Room and takes his place for the receiving line. The receiving line begins immediately, and will feed from the north end of the East Room, past THE PRESIDENT, through the north door into the Green Room out into the Cross Hall, down the Cross Hall and into the State Dining Room. Guests will then find their seats.

8:10 p.m. After all the guests have gone through the receiving line, THE PRESIDENT will hold briefly in the East Room until all guests are in the State Dining Room; then he will proceed down the Cross Hall and into the State Dining Room.

8:15 p.m. Dinner is served.

9:00 p.m. Dessert is served accompanied by Strolling Strings.

9:30 p.m. Following the toasts, THE PRESIDENT will be escorted to the Blue Room. All other guests will be encouraged by Social Aides to mix and mingle in all Color Rooms. Coffee and liqueurs will be served.

9:40 p.m. The Cross Hall Doors to the East Room will be opened to allow those who wish to stroll in and be seated.

10:00 p.m. All guests but THE PRESIDENT will proceed to the East Room via the Cross Hall for seating. The two side sections should be seated first, then the middle section.

10:10 p.m. THE PRESIDENT enters the East Room via the Cross Hall doors and are seated for entertainment in a specially allocated chair in the first row.

Miss Pearl Bailey will enter the East Room and the entertainment will begin immediately.

10:45 p.m. Miss Bailey's performance ends.

THE PRESIDENT proceeds to the stage to thank Miss Bailey.

After thanking Miss Bailey and the entertainers, THE PRESIDENT will lead the guests out of the East Room via the Cross Hall doors to the Grand Foyer for dancing.

THE PRESIDENT then retires.
